Cutting Instructions

Notes:

- Please make sure to check henryglassfabrics.net for pattern updates prior to starting the project.
- All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.
 - *Fabric cut length of fabric

Fabric A, cut:

(2) 10½" x WOF strips; subcut (6) 10½" squares

Fabric B, cut:

(3) 8½" x WOF strips; subcut

(12) 8½" squares and then cut each square diagonally in half twice to make (48) QSTs

Fabric C, cut:

(2) 10½" x WOF strips; subcut (6) 10½" squares

Fabric D, cut:

- (1) 4" x WOF strip; subcut
 - (4) 4" squares

(5) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end-to-end with 45-degree diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x $56\frac{1}{2}$ " and (2) 2" x $45\frac{1}{2}$ " strips

Fabric E, fussy cut*:

(2) 4" x 59½" LOF strips, centering on a chameleon row
(2) 4" x 45½" LOF strips, centering on a chameleon row

Fabric F, cut:

(1) 8½" x WOF strip; subcut
(3) 8½" squares and then cut square diagonally in half twice to make (12) QSTs

Fabric G, cut:

(1) 8½" x WOF strip; subcut

(3) 8½" squares and then cut square diagonally in half twice to make (12) QSTs

Fabric H, cut:

- (1) 8½" x WOF strip; subcut
 (3) 8½" squares and then cut square diagonally in half twice to make (12) QSTs
- (7) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding

Fabric I, cut:

- (1) 8¹/₂" x WOF strip; subcut
 - (3) 8½" squares and then cut square diagonally in half twice to make (12) QSTs

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
Block Assembly

 Sew (1) Fabric G QST to (1) Fabric B QST along short sides, noting orientation (Fig. 1). Make a total of (12) BG triangle units.



 In the same way, make a total of (12) each BH, BI, and BF triangle units (Fig. 2).



 Finger press (1) Fabric A 10½" square in half in both directions to mark center points along each edge. Align the center of (1) BG triangle unit with the center of the edge of the Fabric A 10½" square, pin in place, and stitch (Fig. 3). Repeat on the opposite corner with (1) BF unit (Fig. 4).



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 In the same way, add the BH and BI triangle units to the remaining sides of the Fabric A square (Fig. 5). Square up ¼" past Fabric A square corners. Block should measure 14½" square. Make a total of (6) Block One.





 In the same way, make a total of (6) Block Two using Fabric C 10½" squares (Fig. 6).







Quilt Top Assembly

Follow the **Quilt Layout** while assembling the quilt top.

- Lay out (2) Block One and (1) Block Two into a row, noting block orientation, and sew into a row. Make (2) Row One. Rows will measure 42½" x 14½".
- 7. Lay out (2) Block Two and (1) Block One into a row, noting block orientation, and sew into a row. Make (2) Row Two.
- Sew rows together, alternating Row One and Row Two, to make Quilt Center which will measure 42½" x 56½".
- Sew (1) 2" x 56½" Fabric D strip to each side of Quilt Center. Sew (1) 2" x 45½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Quilt Center.
- Sew (1) 4" x 59½" Fabric E strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew Fabric D 4" squares to short ends of both 4" x 45½" Fabric E strips and sew to the top and to the bottom of the Quilt Center to make the quilt top which measures 52½" x 66½".

Layering, Quilting and Finishing

11. Create a quilt sandwich with batting between quilt top and backing. Pin or baste layers together, mark quilting design, and quilt by hand or machine. When quilting is complete, remove pins or basting, trim batting and backing even with raw edges of quilt top.

Binding

- 12. Sew (7) 2½" x WOF **Fabric H** strips together, end-to-end with 45-degree diagonal seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 13. Sew binding to edges of quilt top, mitering corners, and overlapping ends. Fold binding to back of quilt and stitch it in place by hand to finish.
