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

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Main Print - Dove Gray (A):

• Fussy cut (52) 5 ³/₄" squares, centered on blocks.

From the Leaf & Berry - Orange (B), cut:

(1) 5 ³/₄" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) 5 ³/₄" squares.
(2) 2 ¹/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 2 ¹/₄" squares.

From the Leaf & Berry - Cream/Lilac (C), cut:

(1) 5 ³/₄" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) 5 ³/₄" squares.
(2) 2 ¹/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 2 ¹/₄" squares.

From the Seedling - Orange (D), cut:

• (3) 2 ¹/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2 ¹/₄" squares.

From the Seedling - Cream (E), cut:

• (4) 2 ¹/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (56) 2 ¹/₄" squares.

From the Seedling - Green (F), cut:

• (4) 2 ¹/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (69) 2 ¹/₄" squares.

From the Daisy Love - Pink (G), cut:

(2) 5 ³/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 5 ³/₄" squares.
(3) 2 ¹/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (45) 2 ¹/₄" squares.

From the Daisy Love - Cream (H), cut:

(2) 5 ³/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 5 ³/₄" squares.
(4) 2 ¹/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (62) 2 ¹/₄" squares.

From the Flower Field - Pink (I), cut:

• (3) 2 ¹/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 2 ¹/₄" squares.

From the Flower Field - Green (J), cut:

• (2) 2 ¹/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) 2 ¹/₄" squares.

From the Flower Field - Blue (K), cut:

• (3) 2 ¹/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (54) 2 ¹/₄" squares.

From the Scattered Flowers - Dove Gray (L), cut:

• (1) 5 ³/₄" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) 5 ³/₄" squares.

• (4) 2 ¹/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (56) 2 ¹/₄" squares.

From the Scattered Flowers - Taupe (M), cut:

• (1) 5 ³/₄" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 5 ³/₄" squares.

• (4) 2 ¹/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (63) 2 ¹/₄" squares.

From the Scattered Flowers - Mist (N), cut:

• (2) 5 ³/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 5 ³/₄" squares.

• (4) 2 ¹/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (56) 2 ¹/₄" squares.

From the Daisy Chain - Cream (O), cut:

• (4) 2 ¹/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (56) 2 ¹/₄" squares.

From the Daisy Chain - Lilac (P), cut:

• (4) 2 ¹/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (64) 2 ¹/₄" squares.

• (8) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Flower Field - Pink (Backing), cut:

• (2) 82" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 82" x 82" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2 ¹/₄" Fabric I square to each side of (1) 2 ¹/₄" Fabric L square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) 2 ¹/₄" Fabric L square to each side (1) 2 ¹/₄" Fabric I square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 5 ³/₄" Block One square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make a second Block One square.

2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figures 2 through 64 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make the indicated number of block squares for Block Two through Block Sixty-Four.

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout on Page 6 while assembling the quilt top.)

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3. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) 5 ³/₄" Fabric A square, (1) Block Two square, (1) 5 ³/₄" Fabric A square, (1) 5 ³/₄" Fabric B square, (1) Block Three square, (1) Block Four square, (1) 5 ³/₄" Fabric A square, (1) Block Five square, (1) 5 ³/₄" Fabric G square, (1) Block Six square, (1) 5 ³/₄" Fabric L square, (1) Block Seven square and (1) Block Eight square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One.

4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to the quilt layout for component identification, placement and orientation to Row Two through Row Fourteen.

5. Sew together the (14) Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from the top to the bottom, to make the quilt top.


6. Layer and quilt as desired.

7. Sew the (8) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric P strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

8. Bind as desired.
