## MATERIALS

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

One 1459-43 24" Block Panel - Multi
$1 / 4$ yard 1461-43 Bunny Toss - Cream
$1 / 4$ yard 1468-28 Abstract Garden - Dk. Rose
$1 / 4$ yard 1470-40 Bees - Cream
$2 / 3$ yard 1464-40 Hopping Bunnies - Cream
$3 / 4$ yard 1463-02 Tossed Rainbows - Multi
$3 / 4$ yard 1465-40 Delicate Vines - Cream
23/4 yards 1463-02 Tossed Rainbows - Multi
for backing
$48 "$ x 58 " piece of batting

## CUTTING

Note: All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise indicated.

From 1459-43 24" Block Panel - Multi:
*Trim 6 blocks into $91 / 2$ " squares.

## From 1461-43 Bunny Toss - Cream, cut:

*(1) 5 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 5 " squares.
From 1468-28 Abstract Garden - Dk. Rose, cut:
*(5) 11122 x WOF strips:

- Set aside (4) strips for border 2.
- Sub-cut 1 strip into (6) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ cornerstone squares.


## From 1470-40 Bees - Cream, cut:

*(2) $2^{33 / 4}$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $23 / 4$ squares.
From 1464-40 Hopping Bunnies - Cream, cut: *(5) 4" x WOF strips border 3.

From 1463-02 Tossed Rainbows - Multi, cut:
*(4) $23 / 4 / 4$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) $23 / 4$ squares.
*(9) $11 / 2$ " x WOF strips:

- Set aside 4 strips for border 1.
- Sub-cut 5 strips into (17) $11 / 2$ " x 91⁄2" sashing rectangles.


## From 1465-40 Delicate Vines - Cream, cut:

*(2) 5 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $23 / 4$ " x 5 " rectangles.
*(5) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for binding.
From 1463-02 Tossed Rainbows - Multi, cut: *(2) 48" x WOF panels, pieced horizontally.

## BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the $23 / 4$ " 1463-02 Tossed Rainbows - Multi squares. Noting the line orientation and with right sides together, layer a marked Tossed Rainbows square on the left short end of a 23/4" x 5" 1465-40 Delicate Vines - Cream rectangle and stitch on the drawn line. Trim $1 / 4$ " away from the seam line and press open. Similarly, stitch another square to the opposite end of the same rectangle (Figure 1). Repeat to make (24) $23 / 4$ " x 5 " flying-geese units.

2. Sew 2 flying geese to opposite sides of a $5^{\prime \prime}$ 1461-43 Bunny Toss - Cream square. Press the seams toward the center (Figure 2). Repeat to make 6 center rows.

3. Sew (2) $23 / 4$ " $1470-40$ Bees - Cream squares to opposite sides of the remaining flying geese to make the top/bottom rows. Press the seams toward the squares. Sew a row to the top and one to the bottom of the center rows to make (6) $91 / 2$ " blocks (Figure 3). Press the seams open.

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## QUILT ASSEMBLY

4. Referring to the quilt photo for block placement, lay out the blocks and the $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 91 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} 1463-02$ Tossed Rainbows - Multi sashing rectangles in 4 rows. Join the blocks and sashing rectangles together in each row. Press the seams toward the sashing.
5. To make the horizontal sashing rows, sew together 3 sashing rectangles and (2) $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ 1468-28 Abstract Garden - Dk Rose cornerstone squares. Repeat to make 3 sashing rows. Press the seams toward the sashing.
6. Matching adjacent seams, sew the block and sashing rows together. Press the seams in one direction.
7. For border 1, measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and trim (2) 1½" 1463-02 Tossed Rainbows - Multi that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top and press the seams away from the center. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Trim 2 border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.
8. For border 2, sew the (4) $11 / 2$ " 1468-28 Abstract Garden - Dk. Rose border strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and cut two border strips that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top and press the seams away from the center. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut two border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.
9. Repeat step 8 with the (5) 4 " $1464-40$ Hopping Bunnies - Cream strips to make and add border 3.

## FINISHING

10. Create a quilt sandwich with the batting between the quilt top and the backing. Pin or baste layers together, mark the quilting design, and quilt by hand or machine. When the quilting is complete, remove pins or basting, and trim batting and backing even with the raw edges of the quilt top.
11. Join the (5) $2^{1 ⁄ 2}$ " 1465-40 Delicate Vines Cream binding strips together end to end using a diagonal seam to make one long strip. Trim the seams to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ and press them open. With wrong sides together, fold the strip in half lengthwise and press. Sew the binding to the edges of the quilt top, mitering corners and overlapping ends. Fold the binding to the back of the quilt and hand stitch in place.

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
