





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Materials

²/₃ yard (0.61m) Patchwork Vintage Santas - Multi (A) 1406-86 $\frac{1}{3}$ yard (0.31m) Ditsy Allover - Green (B) 1408-66 2³/₄ yards (2.52m) Double Border Santas and Chimney - Multi (C) 1409-86 1 yard (0.92m) Holly - Green (D) 1402-66* Vintage Christmas Morning Scene - Red (E) ⁷/₈ yard (0.81m) 1407-88 3 ¹/₂ yards (3.21m) Vintage Santa Wreaths - Multi (Backing) 1405-68 *Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Patchwork Vintage Santas - Multi (A), cut:

• (2) 10" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 10" x 16" strips.

From the Ditsy Allover - Green (B), cut:

- (1) 1 ¹/₂" x 20 ¹/₂" WOF strip.
- (1) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 16" strips.
- (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 32 ¹/₂" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 22 ¹/₂" WOF strips.

From the Double Border Santas and Chimney - Multi (C), fussy cut:

- (2) 8 ¹/₂" x 54" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips, centered on border stripe.
- (2) 8 ¹/₂" x 42" LOF strips, centered on border stripe.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 2 ¹/₂" x 52 ¹/₂" LOF strips and (2) 2 ¹/₂" x 44 ¹/₂" LOF strips.

From the Holly - Green (D), cut:

- (3) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 50 ¹/₂" strips.
- (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 40 ¹/₂" WOF strips.
- (3) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 56 ¹/₂" strips.
- (3) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ¹/₂" x 46 ¹/₂" strips.
- (6) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Vintage Christmas Morning Scene - Red (E), cut:

- (3) 4 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ¹/₂" x 58 ¹/₂" strips.
- (3) 4 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ¹/₂" x 54 ¹/₂" strips.


From the Vintage Santa Wreaths - Multi (Backing), cut:

• (2) 62" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 62" x 74" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 10" x 16" Fabric A rectangle to each side of (1) 1 ½" x 16" Fabric B strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) newly sewn strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) 1 ½" x 20 ½" Fabric B strip to make the 20 ½" x 32 ½" Center Block (Fig. 1).



Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 2. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

3. Center (1) 8 ¹/₂" x 54" Fabric C strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a ¹/₄" from the top edge of the block and stop a ¹/₄" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.

4. Repeat Step 3 to sew (1) 8 ¹/₂" x 42" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start ¹/₄" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 2).

5. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 2), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.



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6. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

7. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 52 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ x 44 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.


8. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 56 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

9. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 58 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 54 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

10. Layer and quilt as desired.

11. Sew the (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ x WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

12. Bind as desired.



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
