



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### **Cutting Instructions**

#### Notes:

- Please make sure to check henryglassfabrics.net for pattern updates prior to starting the project.
- All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.
- \*Strips cut Length of Fabric (LOF)

#### Fabric A, fussy cut:

- (1) 22½" x 20½" rectangle, centered on large block
- (4) 10 1/2" squares, centered on small blocks

#### Fabric B, cut:

- (2) 3" x 251/2" WOF strips
- (1) 2" x WOF strip; subcut
- (2) 2" x 20½" strips
- (2) 1½" x 32½" WOF strips (2) 1½" x 34½" WOF strips

#### Fabric C, cut:

(1) 4½" x WOF strip; subcut (4) 4½" squares and (8) 1½" x 6½" strips

#### Fabric D, fussy cut:

- (2) 6½" x 60½" LOF strips, centered on poinsettias
- (4) 24½" x 4½" LOF strips, centered on snow globes

#### Fabric E, cut:

- (3) 1½" x WOF strips; subcut (16) 1½" x 6½" strips
- (2) 11/2" x 341/2" WOF strips
- (2) 11/2" x 361/2" WOF strips
- (3) 1½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end-to-end with diagonal seams and cut
   (2) 1½" x 60½" strips
- (3) 1½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end-to-end with diagonal seams and cut
  (2) 1½" x 50½" strips

#### Fabric F, cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips; subcut (8) 2" x 10½" strips
- (3) 2" x WOF strips; subcut (8) 2" x 13½" strips
- (7) 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips for the binding

#### Fabric G, cut:

(1) 3½" x WOF strip; subcut (8) 3½" squares

#### Fabric H, cut:

(1) 6½" x WOF strip; subcut (2) 6½" squares

#### Backing, cut:

(2) 70" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 58" x 70" back

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
#### Sewing

Sew using a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Press seams towards the darker fabric, unless otherwise indicated.


The arrows in the figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

#### **Block Assembly**


1. Sew (1) 2" x 20½" Fabric B strip to each side of the  $22\frac{1}{2}$ " x 20½" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 3" x 25½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 24½" x 24½".** 




2. Sew (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square to each end of (1)  $24\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to make the Inner Top Border (Fig. 2).



3. Sew (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square to each end of (1)  $24\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to make the Inner Bottom Border (Fig. 3).




4. Sew (1)  $2'' \times 10\%''$  Fabric F strip to each side of (1) 10%'' Fabric A square. Sew (1)  $2'' \times 13\%''$  Fabric F strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A square. Trim the block to measure  $12\%'' \times 12\%''$  to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (4) Block One squares total.



5. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to the top and bottom of (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip lengthwise to make (1)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 1 strip (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (8) Unit 1 strips total.

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6. Sew (1) 3½" Fabric G square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of (1) 6½" Fabric H square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 12½" Block Two square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make a second Block Two square.





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7. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two Square to make the Outer Top Border (Fig. 7). Repeat to make the Outer Bottom Border.

### Quilt Top Assembly

Follow the Quilt Layout (Page 6) while assembling the quilt top.

8. Sew (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $24\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block.

9. Sew the Inner Top Border and the Inner Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

10. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $32\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $34\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block.

11. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $34\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $36\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block.

12. Sew the Outer Top Border and the Outer Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

13. Sew (1)  $6\frac{1}{2}$  x  $60\frac{1}{2}$  Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block.

14. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $60\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $50\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top which should measure  $50\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $62\frac{1}{2}$ ".

### Layering, Quilting and Finishing

15. Press the quilt top and 58" x 70" backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.


### Binding

16. Cut the ends of the (7) **Fabric F** binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to zend to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.

17. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.
