Cutting Instructions

Notes:

- Please make sure to check henryglassfabrics.net for pattern updates prior to starting the project.
- All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

Fabric A, cut:

(2) 6" x WOF strips; subcut (4) 6" x 12½" strips

Fabric B, cut:

(2) 4½" x WOF strips; subcut (4) 4½" x 11½" strips

Fabric C, cut:

(1) 12½" x WOF strip; subcut (4) 12½" x 6" strips

Fabric D, cut:

264" of 2½" bias strips for binding (4) Place Mats

Backing, cut:

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
(2) 15" x WOF strips; subcut (4) 15" x 20" strips



Sewing


- Sew using a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Press seams towards the darker fabric, unless otherwise indicated.
- The arrows in the figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.
- 1. Sew (1) **Fabric A** 6" x 12½" strip to the top of (1) **Fabric C** 6" x 12½" strip lengthwise. Sew (1) **Fabric B** 4½" x 11½" strip to the left side of the newly sewn strip to make (1) 16½" x 11½" Block One rectangle (**Fig. 1**). Repeat to make (4) Block One rectangle.

2. Using the curve template provided, round each of the (4) corners of (1) Block One rectangle to make (1) Place Mat top (**Fig. 2**). Repeat to make (4) Place Mat tops total.


Layering, Quilting and Finishing

3. Create a quilt sandwich with the batting between the place mat top and the backing. Pin or baste layers together, mark the quilting design, and quilt by hand or machine. When quilting is complete, remove pins or basting and trim batting and backing even with raw edges of the place mat top.

Binding

- 4. Sew **Fabric D** 2½" bias strips together, endto-end with 45-degree diagonal seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 5. Sew binding to the edges of the quilt top, mitering corners, and overlapping ends. Fold binding to the back of the quilt and stitch it in place by hand to finish.





This square should measure 1" x 1" (2.54cm x 2.54cm) when printed.
