

- Batting 39" x 59" (99.06cm x 149.86cm)
- · Thread and sewing supplies



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Cutting Instructions

Notes:

- Please make sure to check henryglassfabrics.net for pattern updates prior to starting the project.
- All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.
- *Strips cut Length of Fabric (LOF).

Fabric A, cut:

- (3) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end-to-end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $45\frac{1}{2}$ " strips
- (2) 31/2" x 311/2" WOF strips

Fabric B, cut:

- (2) 2" x 42½" WOF strips, piece as needed
- (2) 2" x 251/2" WOF strips
- (5) 21/2" x WOF strips for the binding

Fabric C, fussy cut:

(1) 22½" x 42½" rectangle, centered on the panel

Backing, cut:

(1) 59" x 39" WOF strip



Sewing

- Sew using a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Press seams towards the darker fabric, unless otherwise indicated.
- The arrows in the figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

Quilt Top Assembly

Follow the Quilt Layout (Page 5) while assembling the quilt top.

- Sew (1) Fabric B 2" x 42½" strip to each side of the Fabric C 22½" x 42½" rectangle. Sew (1) Fabric B 2" x 25½" strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric C rectangle.
- 2. Sew (1) **Fabric A** 3½" x 45½" strip to each side of the **Fabric C** rectangle. Sew (1) **Fabric A** 3½" x 31½" strip to the top and bottom of the **Fabric C** rectangle to complete the quilt top which should measure 31½" x 51½".

Layering, Quilting and Finishing

3. Create a quilt sandwich with the batting between the quilt top and the backing. Pin or baste layers together, mark the quilting design, and quilt by hand or machine. When quilting is complete, remove pins or basting and trim batting and backing even with raw edges of the quilt top.

Binding

- 4. Sew (5) **Fabric B** 2½" x WOF strips together, end-to-end with 45-degree diagonal seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 5. Sew binding to the edges of the quilt top, mitering corners, and overlapping ends. Fold binding to the back of the quilt and stitch it in place by hand to finish.
