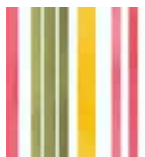

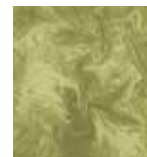

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Cutting Instructions

Notes:

- Please make sure to check henryglassfabrics.net for pattern updates prior to starting the project.
- All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

Fabric A, cut:

- (1) 10½" x WOF; subcut
- (3) 10½" squares

Fabric B, cut:

- (1) 10½" x WOF; subcut
- (3) 10½" squares

Fabric C, cut:

- (4) 1½" x WOF. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut
- (2) 1½" x 76½"
- (4) 1½" x WOF. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut
- (2) 1½" x 64½"

Fabric D, cut:

- (2) 10½" x WOF; subcut
- (4) 10½" squares

Fabric E, cut:

- (4) 4½" x WOF. Sew the strips together end to end and cut (2) 4½" x 78½"
- (4) 4½" x WOF. Sew the strips together end to end and cut (2) 4½" x 72½"

Fabric F, cut:

- (4) 2½" x WOF. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut
- (2) 2½" x 72½"
- (4) 2½" x WOF. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut
- (2) 2½" x 62½"

Fabric G, cut:

- (7) 1½" x WOF; subcut
- (20) 1½" x 10½"
- (7) 1½" x WOF; subcut
- (20) 1½" x 11½"

Fabric H, cut:

- (17) 2½" x WOF; subcut
- (49) 2½" x 12½"

Fabric I, cut:

- (2) 10½" x WOF; subcut
- (4) 10½" squares

Fabric J, cut:

- (1) 2½" x WOF; subcut
- (15) 2½" squares

Fabric K, cut:

- (1) 2½" x WOF; subcut
- (15) 2½" squares
- (9) 2½" x WOF for binding

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Fabric L, cut:

- (1) 10½" x WOF; subcut
- (3) 10½" squares

Fabric M, cut:

- (1) 10½" x WOF; subcut
- (3) 10½" squares

Fabric N, cut:

- (7) 1½" x WOF; subcut
- (20) 1½" x 11½"
- (7) 1½" x WOF; subcut
- (20) 1½" x 12½"

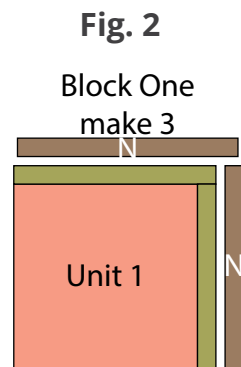
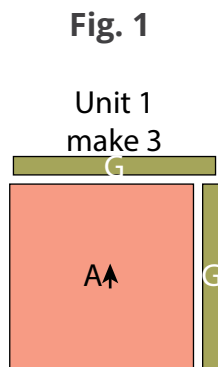
Backing, cut:

- (2) 94" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 80" x 94"

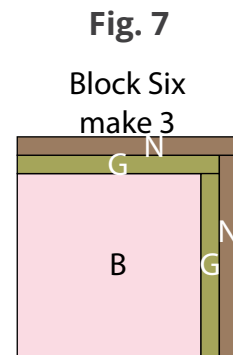
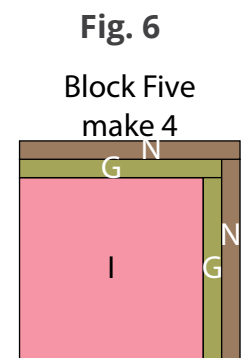
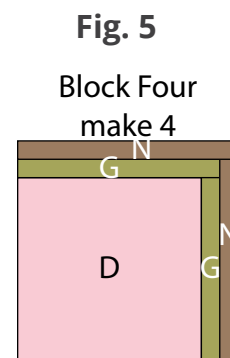
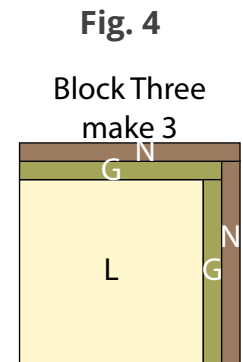
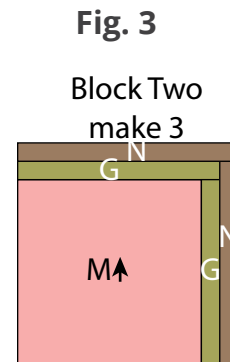
Sewing

- Sew using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Press seams towards the darker fabric, unless otherwise indicated.
- The arrows in the figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric G** strip to the right side of (1) $10\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric A** square. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $11\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric G** strip to the top of the **Fabric A** square to make (1) $11\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 1 square (**Fig. 1**). Repeat to make an additional (2) Unit 1 squares.
2. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $11\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric N** strip to the right side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric N** strip to the top of the Unit 1 square to make (1) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Block One square (**Fig. 2**). Repeat to make an additional (2) Block One squares.



3. Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to **Figures 3-7** for identification, placement and orientation to make the indicated number of block squares for Block Two through Block Six.



4. Sew together (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric K** square, (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric H** strip, (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric J** square, (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric H** strip, (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric K** square, (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric H** strip, (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric J** square, (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric H** strip and (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric K** square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One (**Fig. 8**). Repeat to make Row Five and Row Nine.
5. Sew together (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric H** strip, (1) Block One square, (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric H**

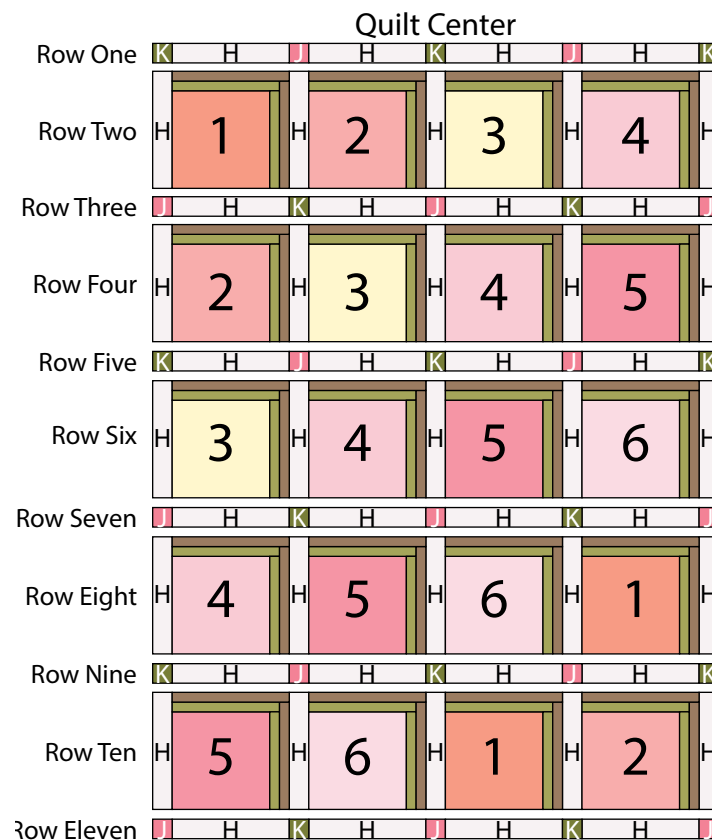
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- strip, (1) Block Two square, (1) 2½" x 12½" **Fabric H** strip, (1) Block Three square, (1) 2½" x 12½" **Fabric H** strip, (1) Block Four square and (1) 2½" x 12½" **Fabric H** strip, in that order from left to right, to make Row Two (**Fig. 8**)
- Repeat Step 5 and refer to **Figure 8** for fabric/unit identification, placement and orientation to make Row Four, Row Six, Row Eight and Row Ten.
 - Sew together (1) 2½" **Fabric J** square, (1) 2½" x 12½" **Fabric H** strip, (1) 2½" **Fabric K** square, (1) 2½" x 12½" **Fabric H** strip, (1) 2½" **Fabric J** square, (1) 2½" x 12½" **Fabric H** strip, (1) 2½" **Fabric K** square, (1) 2½" x 12½" **Fabric H** strip and (1) 2½" **Fabric J** square, in that order from left to right, to make Row Three (**Fig. 8**) Repeat to make Row Seven and Row Eleven.
 - Sew together the (11) pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 58½" x 72½" Quilt Center (**Fig. 8**).

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Quilt Top Assembly

Follow the Quilt Layout (Page 8) while assembling the quilt top.

9. Sew (1) 2½" x 72½" **Fabric F** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew (1) 2½" x 62½" **Fabric F** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center.
10. Sew (1) 1½" x 76½" **Fabric C** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew (1) 1½" x 64½" **Fabric C** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center.
11. Sew (1) 4½" x 78½" **Fabric E** strip to each side of the Quilt Center. Sew (1) 4½" x 72½" **Fabric E** strip to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center to complete the quilt top which should measure 72½" x 86½".

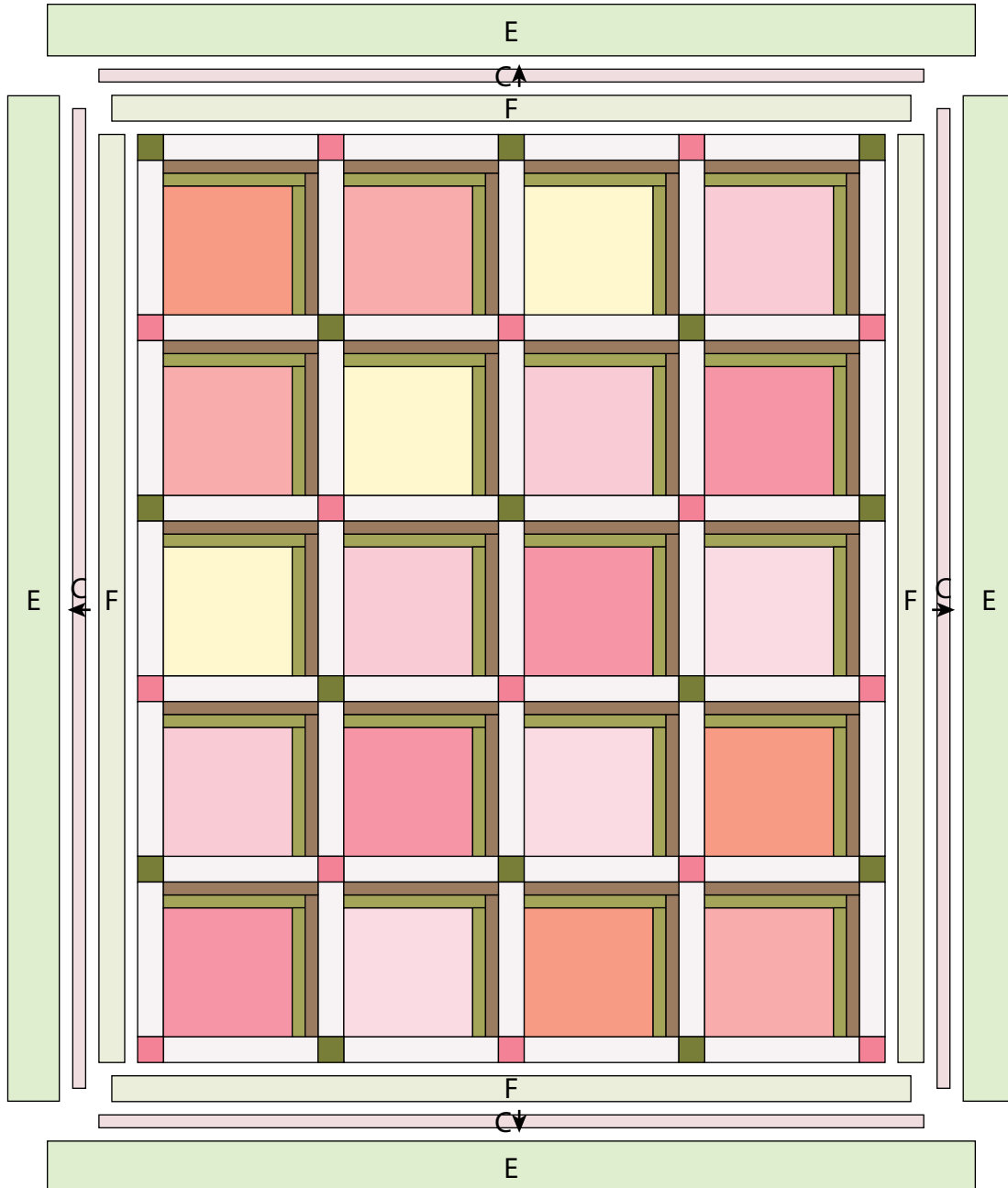
Layering, Quilting and Finishing

12. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top of the quilt.

Binding

13. Sew together (9) 2½" x WOF **Fabric K** binding strips end to end with diagonal seams. Press the seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
14. Leaving an 8" tail of binding and beginning along an edge of the quilt top, match raw edges of the binding to the raw edges of the quilt top. Sew the binding to the outside edge around all four sides and miter corners. Stop sewing approximately 12" from where you started and backstitch.
15. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along the quilt edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back onto themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together, right sides matching. Trim seam to ¼" and press seam open. Finish sewing the binding to the quilt top.
16. Turn the binding over the raw edge to the back of the quilt and hand or machine stitch in place.
