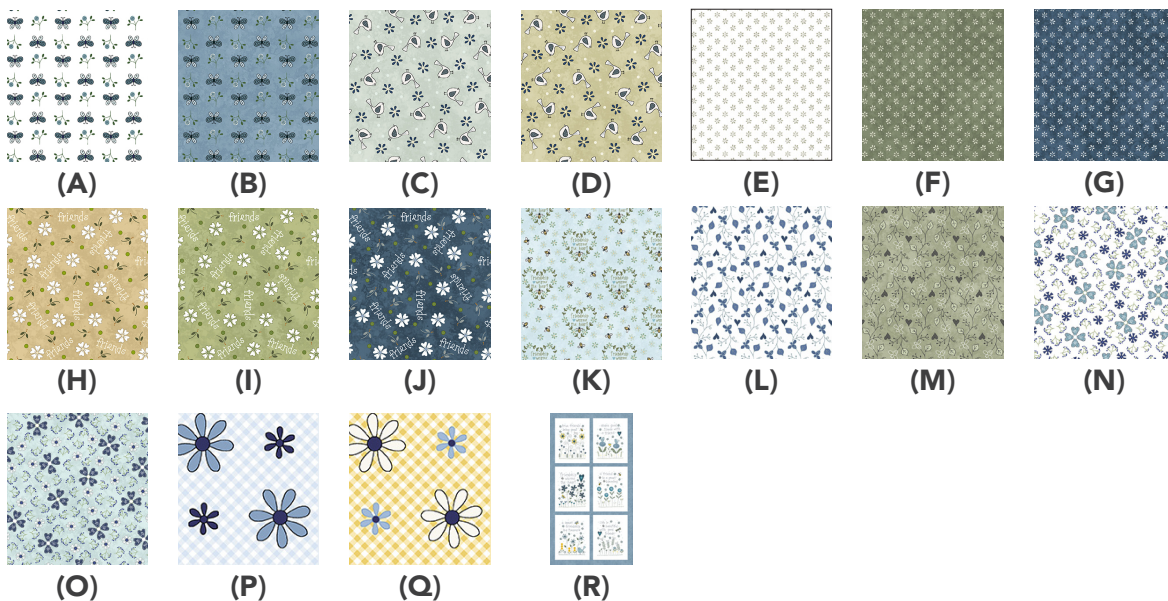

- 100% cotton thread and basic sewing supplies

## Cutting Instructions

### Notes:

- Please make sure to check [henryglassfabrics.net](http://henryglassfabrics.net) for pattern updates prior to starting the project.
- All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvedge to selvedge edge unless otherwise noted.
- Label all fabric pieces for ease of assembly

### Fabrics A and E, from each cut:

(1) 6" x WOF; subcut (4) 6" x 4½" rectangles

### Fabrics B and K, from each cut:

(1) 6" x WOF; subcut:

(5) 6" x 4½" rectangles

(1) 2½" x 12½" rectangle

(1) 2½" x WOF; subcut (3) 2½" x 12½" rectangles

(1) 11½" x WOF; subcut:

(4) 11½" x 2½" rectangles

### Fabric C, cut:

(1) 4½" x WOF; subcut (4) 4½" x 6" rectangles

(3) 2½" x WOF; subcut:

(4) 2½" x 11½" rectangles

(4) 2½" x 12½" rectangles

### Fabrics D, F, and P, cut:

(1) 4½" x WOF; subcut:

(4) 4½" x 6" rectangles

(2) 2½" squares

(3) 2½" x WOF; subcut:

(4) 2½" x 11½" rectangles

(4) 2½" x 12½" rectangles

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**Fabric G, cut:**

- (1) 4½" x WOF; subcut (4) 4½" x 6" rectangles
- (15) 2½" x WOF

Set aside (8) strips for the quilt binding

Set aside (4) strips for the table runner binding

From (3) strips, subcut:

- (4) 2½" x 11½" rectangles
- (4) 2½" x 12½" rectangles

**Fabric H, cut:**

- (1) 4½" x WOF; subcut (4) 4½" x 6" rectangles
- (4) 2½" x WOF; subcut:
  - (6) 2½" x 11½" rectangles
  - (6) 2½" x 12½" rectangles

**Fabric I, cut:**

- (2) 4½" x WOF; subcut:
  - (9) 4½" x 6" rectangles
  - (2) 2½" squares
- (4) 2½" x WOF; subcut:
  - (6) 2½" x 11½" rectangles
  - (6) 2½" x 12½" rectangles

**Fabric J, cut:**

- (1) 4½" x WOF; subcut:
  - (5) 4½" x 6" rectangles
  - (2) 2½" squares
- (4) 2½" x WOF; subcut:
  - (6) 2½" x 11½" rectangles
  - (6) 2½" x 12½" rectangles

**Fabric L, cut:**

- (2) 4½" x WOF; subcut (8) 4½" x 6" rectangles

**Fabric M, cut:**

- (1) 4½" x WOF; subcut:
  - (4) 4½" x 6" rectangles
  - (1) 2½" x 12½" rectangle
- (1) 2½" x WOF; subcut:
  - (2) 2½" x 11½" rectangles
  - (1) 2½" x 12½" rectangle

**Fabric N, cut:**

- (1) 4½" x WOF; subcut (5) 4½" x 6" rectangles

**Fabric O, cut:**

- (1) 4½" x WOF; subcut (5) 4½" x 6" rectangles
- (4) 2½" x WOF; subcut:
  - (6) 2½" x 11½" rectangles
  - (6) 2½" x 12½" rectangles

**Fabric Q, cut:**

- (2) 4½" x WOF; subcut:
  - (10) 4½" x 6" rectangles
  - (2) 2½" squares
- (2) 2½" x WOF; subcut:
  - (2) 2½" x 11½" rectangles
  - (2) 2½" x 12½" rectangles

**Fabric R:**

- Fussy cut (6) 8½" x 11½" rectangles

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## SEWING

### Notes:

- All seam allowances are  $\frac{1}{4}$ " (0.64cm). Sew pieces with right sides together. Press seam allowances open unless otherwise indicated.
- Please refer to the quilt diagram on page 7 for fabric combinations for each block.

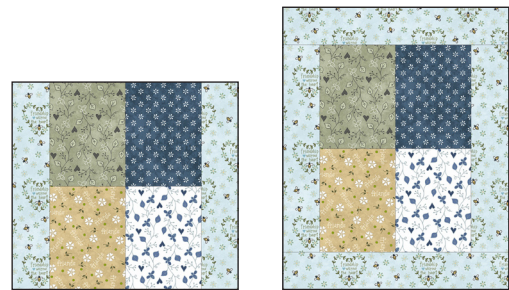
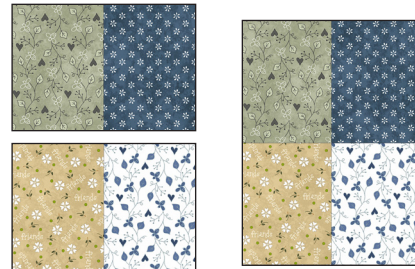
1. Sew a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $11\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric D** rectangle to either side of an  $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $11\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric R** rectangle. Press the seams away from the center. Sew a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric D** rectangle to the top and bottom and press as before. Make (6)  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $15\frac{1}{2}$ " panel blocks total, framing each with a different fabric (**Fig. 1**).

2. Gather (4)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6" assorted rectangles and arrange them into a 4-patch. Sew the rectangles in rows, press the seams in opposite directions, then sew the rows together. Press the seam open. Sew a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $11\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric K** rectangle to either side of the block center. Press the seams away from the center. Sew a  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric K** rectangle to the top and bottom and press as before. Make (22)  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $15\frac{1}{2}$ "

assorted blocks total, framing each with a different fabric. Set (3) blocks aside for the table runner (**Fig. 2**).

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

**Note:** Follow the quilt Layout Diagram (page 7) while assembling the top.

3. Arrange (25) blocks in (5) rows of (5) blocks each. Sew the blocks together in rows and press the seams in opposite directions. Nest the seams and sew the rows together to complete the quilt.

## FINISHING

4. Sew together the (8)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " **Fabric G** binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Press the seams open. Press the binding strip in half with the wrong sides together.

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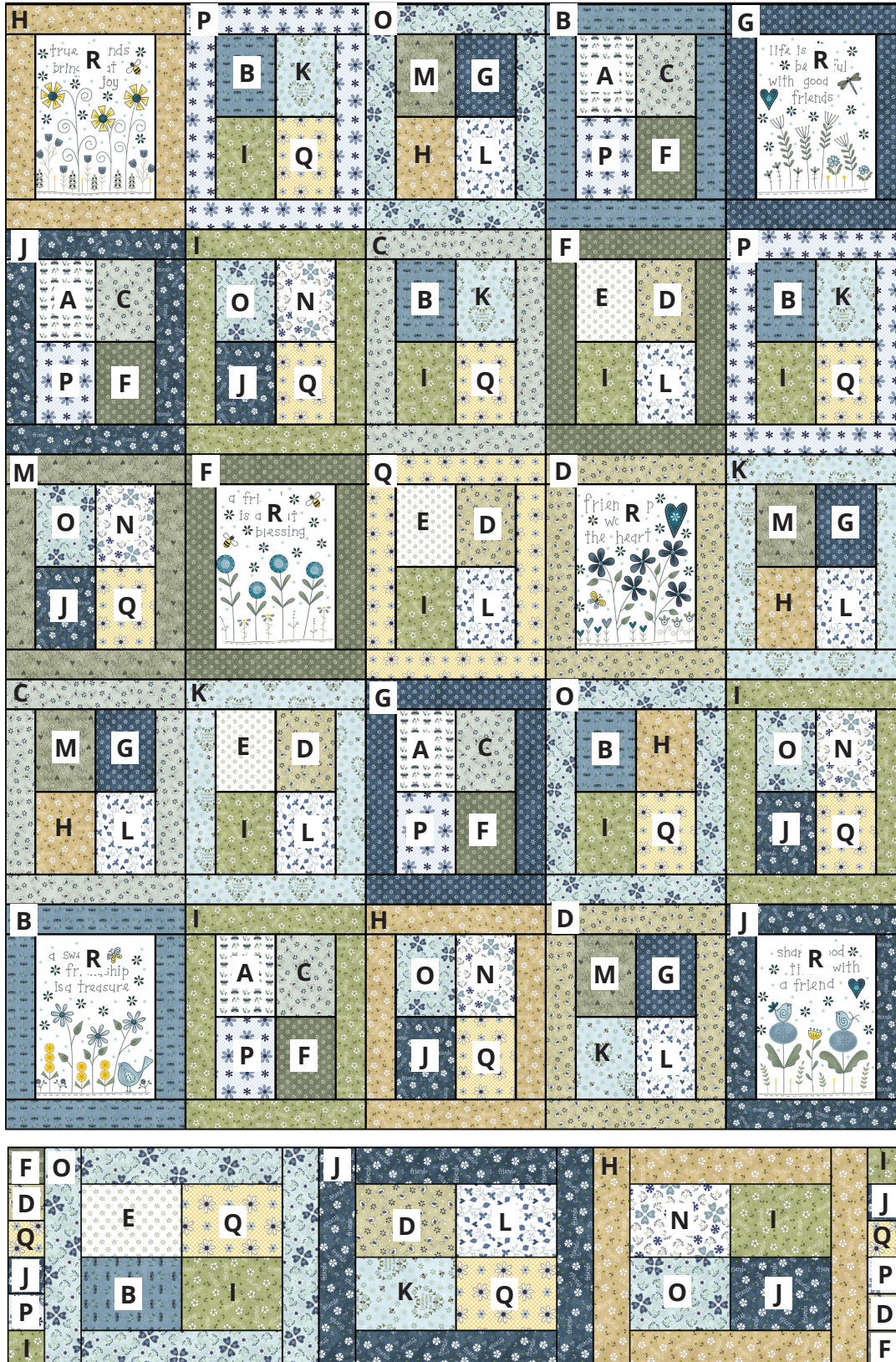
5. Layer the backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top of the quilt.
6. Leaving an 8" tail of binding and beginning along an edge of the quilt, match the raw edges of the binding to the raw edges of the quilt. Sew the binding to the outside edge around all four sides and miter corners. Stop sewing approximately 12" from where you started and backstitch.
7. Lay both loose ends of the binding flat along the quilt's edge. Where these two loose ends meet, fold them back onto themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding together, with the right sides matching. Trim the seam to ¼" and press it open. Finish sewing the binding to the quilt.
8. Turn the binding over the raw edge to the back of the quilt and hand or machine stitch in place.

## TABLE RUNNER ASSEMBLY

**Note:** Follow the table runner Layout Diagram (page 7) while assembling the runner.

9. Sew the 2½" assorted squares in (2) columns of (6) squares each. Press the seams in one direction.
10. Sew together the (3) blocks set aside earlier, noting block orientation. Press the seams in one direction. Sew a column of squares to each side of the runner center, and press.
11. Sew together the (4) 2½" **Fabric G** binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Press the seams open. Press the binding strip in half with the wrong sides together.
12. Refer to the Finishing Instructions for the quilt (Steps 4-8) to add the binding to the table runner.
