## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

## From the 24 Inch Farm Panel - Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (1) $221 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Polka Dots - Navy (B), cut:

- (2) 2 " $\times 40 \frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
-(2) 2 " x $25 \frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (3) 1" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 " $\times 46^{1 / 2 "}$ strips.
- (2) 1 " $\times 311 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Delicate Tossed Vines - Beige/Navy (C), cut:

- (1) $51 / 2 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) $51 / 2 "$ squares.
- (2) $31 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) $21 / 2 " \times 301 / 2 "$ WOF strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (D), cut:

- (5) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) $21 / 2 " \times 51 / 2 "$ strips.
- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $21 / 2 " \times 71 / 2 "$ strips.
- (6) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (26) $11 / 2 " \times 71 / 2 "$ strips.
-(4) $11 / 2>\times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 611 / 2 "$ strips.
-(3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 471 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Allover Sheep - Beige (E), cut:

- (1) $51 / 2 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) $51 / 2 "$ squares.


## From the Tossed Pigs - Beige (F), cut:

- (1) $51 / 2 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) $51 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Baby Chicks Allover - Beige (G), cut:

- (1) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) $51 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Geese - Light Gray (H), cut:

- (1) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) $51 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Tiny Barn on Check Ground - Beige (I), cut:

- (1) $51 / 2 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) $51 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Stripe - Beige/Navy (J), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " x $631 / 2$ " strips.
- (3) $2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 501 / 2$ " strips.

From the Tiny Words - Beige/Navy (K), cut:

- (1) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $51 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Tossed Cows - Cream (L), cut:

- (4) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $51 / 2 " \times 66^{1 / 2 "}$ strips.
-(3) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $51 / 2 " \times 501 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Tossed Cows - Cream (Backing), cut:

- (2) 68 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 68 " $\times 84$ " back.


## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 401 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the $221 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) $2 " \times 251 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure $24^{1 / 2 "} \times 42 \frac{1}{2}$ ".

2. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 5 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the right side of (1) $51 / 2 "$ Fabric C square lengthwise to make (1) Block One rectangle (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (5) Block One rectangles total.

3. Repeat Step 2 and refer to Figures 3-9 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (3) Block Two rectangles, (5) Block Three and Block Four rectangles, (2) Block Five rectangles, (1) Block Six rectangle, (1) Block Seven rectangle and (1) Block Eight rectangle.

4. Sew (1) $2^{1 / 2 "} \times 5^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric D strip to the bottom of (1) $51 / 2 "$ Fabric I square lengthwise to make (1) Block Nine rectangle. Repeat to make a second Block Nine rectangle.
5. Repeat Step 4 and refer to Figure 11 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (1) Block Ten rectangle.

7. Repeat Step 6 and refer to Figures 13-15 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (1) Block Twelve square, (1) Block Thirteen square and (1) Block Fourteen square.

8. Follow Figure 16 for component identification, placement and orientation and sew together (8) assorted blocks and (7) $11 / 2 " \times 71 / 2 "$ Fabric D strips to make the Left Side Border.
9. Repeat Step 8 and refer to Figures 17-19 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the Right Side Border, the Top Border and the Bottom Border.

Quilt Top Assembly (Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 10. Sew (1) $31 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 301 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) $1 " \times 461 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1 " \times 311 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
12. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.
13. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
14. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} " \times 61 \frac{1}{2} "$ Fabric $D$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 471 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
15. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 631 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $501 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
16. Sew (1) $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 66 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric L strip to each side of the Center Block.
17. Sew (1) $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K square to each end of (1) $51 / 2 " \times 501 / 2 "$ Fabric L strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
18. Layer and quilt as desired.
19. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
20. Bind as desired.
