$2 / 3$ yard ( 0.61 m ) Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (C) 1063-01W
$3 / 8$ yard ( 0.35 m )
$3 / 8$ yard ( 0.35 m )
$1 / 4$ yard ( 0.23 m )
1 yard ( 0.92 m )
$1 / 2 \operatorname{yard}(0.46 \mathrm{~m})$

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Six Farm Blocks 24 Inch Repeat - Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (6) $101 / 2$ " squares, centered on blocks.

From the Folio Basics - Green Grape (B), cut:

- (2) $51 / 4 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) $51 / 4 "$ squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (40) $51 / 4$ " triangles.
- (3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2" x 5 " strips.
- (2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2" x $31 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $11 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $11 / 2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (C), cut: - (2) $51 / 4 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) $51 / 4 "$ squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (40) $51 / 4$ " triangles.

- (3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2" x $41 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $11 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Allover Sheep - Beige (D), cut:

- (1) $101 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $101 / 2 "$ squares.


## From the Geese - Light Gray (E), cut:

- (1) $101 / 2 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $101 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Tossed Pigs - Beige (F), cut:

- (1) $41 / 2 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Polka Dots - Navy (G), cut:

- (3) $51 / 4 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) $51 / 4 "$ squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (80) $51 / 4 "$ triangles.
- (7) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Delicate Tossed Vines - Beige/Navy (H), cut:

- (5) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (80) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Tossed Cows - Cream (I), cut:

- (5) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (80) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Baby Chicks Allover - Beige (J), cut:

- (1) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Stripe - Beige/Navy (K), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 601 / 2$ " strips.
- (3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 511 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Goats and Sheep Allover - Green (L), cut:

- (4) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $41 / 2 " \times 631 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $41 / 2 " \times 591 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Trucks and Barn Allover - Multi (Backing), cut:
-(2) 79 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 67 " x 79 " back.

## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) 2 " $\times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip end to end. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) newly sewn strip to each side of (1) $101 / 2$ " Fabric A square (Fig. 1).
2. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 5$ " Fabric B strip to each end of (1) 2 " $\times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip end to end. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the newly sewn strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square from Step 1 to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 12 \frac{1}{2}$ ".
3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (6) Block One squares total.

4. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) $11 / 2 " \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C strip end to end. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) newly sewn strip to each side of (1) $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D square (Fig. 2).
5. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each end of (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C strip end to end. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the newly sewn strips to the top and to the bottom of (1) $101 / 2$ " Fabric D square from Step 4 to make (1) $121 / 2 "$ Block Two square (Fig. 2).
6. Repeat Steps 4-5 to make a second Block Two square.
7. Repeat Steps $4-5$ and refer to Figure 3 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (2) Block Three squares.

8. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ Fabric I square to the left
side of (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric H square to make the top row. Sew (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H square to the left side of (1) $21 / 2$ " Fabric I square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) $41 / 2$ " Unit 1 square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (40) Unit 1 squares total.

9. Sew (1) $5 \frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric G triangle and (1) $51 / 4$ " Fabric C triangle together along short sides. Sew (1) $51 / 4 "$ Fabric G triangle and (1) $5 \frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric B triangle together along short sides. Sew the (2) newly sewn triangles together along their long sides to make (1) $41 / 2 "$ Unit 2 square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (40) Unit 2 squares total.
10. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each side of (1) Unit 2 square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to each side of (1) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric F square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) $121 / 2 "$ Block Four square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (6) Block Four squares total.

11. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each side of (1) Unit 2 square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to each side of (1) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric J square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) $121 / 2 "$ Block Five square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (4) Block Five squares total.

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12. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Block Four square, (1) Block One square and (1) Block Four square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One (Fig. 8). Repeat to make Row Three and Row Five.
13. Sew together (1) Block Five square, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Five square and (1) Block Three square, in that order from left to right, to make Row Two (Fig. 8).
14. Sew together (1) Block Five square, (1) Block Three square, (1) Block Five square and (1) Block Two square, in that order from left to right, to make Row Four (Fig. 8).
15. Sew together the (5) pieced Rows Steps 13-14, lengthwise and in numerical order from the top to the bottom, to make the $481 / 2 " \times 601 / 2 "$ Center Block (Fig. 8).

Quilt Top Assembly
(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
16. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 601 / 2$ " Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $511 / 2 "$ Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
17. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 631 / 2 "$ Fabric L strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 591 / 2 "$ Fabric L strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
18. Layer and quilt as desired.
19. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
20. Bind as desired.
