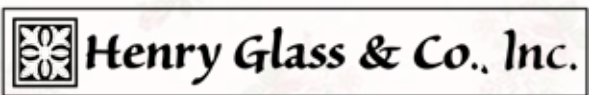

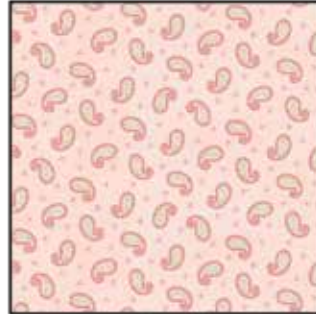

3/8 yard	Master Floral - Blush (A)	8690F-22
3/8 yard	Paisley - Green (B)	8693F-66
3/8 yard	Small Floral - Blush (C)	8696F-22
3/8 yard	Astilbe - Green (D)	8692F-66
1 yard	Astilbe - Blush (E)	8692F-22*
3/8 yard	Small Floral - Green (F)	8696F-66
3 1/8 yards	Dot - Cream/Pink (G)	8695F-42
2 1/4 yards	Border Stripe - Cream (H)	8697F-44
1 1/8 yards	Master Floral - Cream (I)	8690F-44
5 1/8 yards	Master Floral - Green (Backing)	8690F-66

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Master Floral - Blush (A), cut:

- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

From the Paisley - Green (B), cut:

- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

From the Small Floral - Blush (C), cut:

- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

From the Astilbe - Green (D), cut:

- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

From the Astilbe - Blush (E), cut:

- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.
- (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Small Floral - Green (F), cut:

- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips.

From the Dot - Cream/Pink (G), cut:

- (4) 8 1/2" x WOF strips.
- (4) 4 1/2" x WOF strips.
- (15) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (60) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.
- (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (60) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

From the Border Stripe - Cream (H), fussy cut:

- (2) 2" x 79" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips each centered on the pink stripe.
- (2) 2" x 67" LOF strips each centered on the pink stripe.

From the Master Floral - Cream (I), cut:

- (4) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 1/2" x 75 1/2" strips.
- (4) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 1/2" x 71 1/2" strips.

From the Master Floral - Green (Backing), cut:

- (2) 91" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 79" x 91" back.

Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric E strip to the left side of (1) 8 1/2" x WOF Fabric G strip lengthwise. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric F strip to the right side of the Fabric G strip to make (1) Strip Set 1 (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (4) Strip Set 1's total.
2. Cut the (4) Strip Set 1's into (60) 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" Unit 1 strips (Fig. 2).

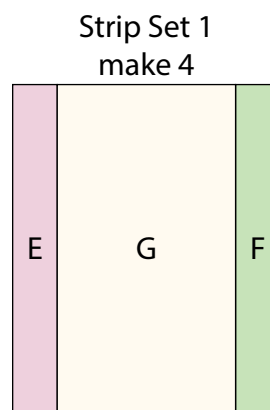

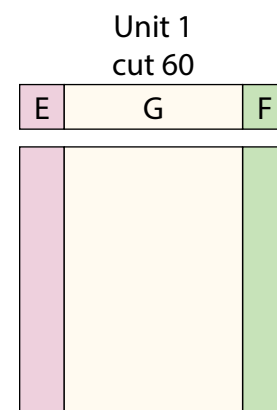

3. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric C strip to the left side of (1) 4 1/2" x WOF Fabric G strip lengthwise. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric D strip to the right side of the Fabric G strip to make (1) Strip Set 2 (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (4) Strip Set 2's total.
4. Cut the (4) Strip Set 2's into (60) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" Unit 2 strips (Fig. 4).

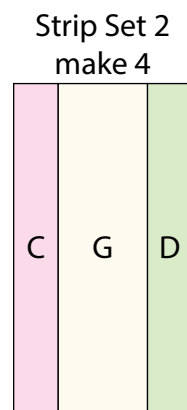

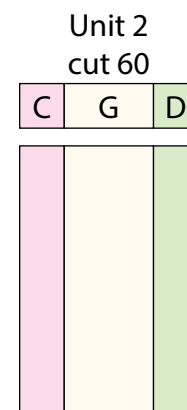

5. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric A strip to the left side of (1) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric B strip to make (1) Strip Set 3 (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (4) Strip Set 3's total.

6. Cut the (4) Strip Set 3's into (60) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Unit 3 strips (Fig. 6).

7. Sew (1) Unit 3 strip to the top of a second Unit 3 strip, paying attention to the orientation of the strips, to make (1) Unit 4 square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (30) Unit 4 squares total.

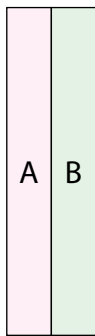

cut 60

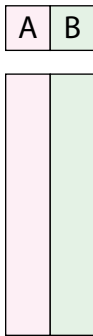

cut 30

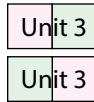

8. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric G strip to each side of (1) Unit 4 square. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 4 square. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric G strip to each side of the newly sewn block. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to the top and to the bottom of the new block to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (30) Block One squares total.

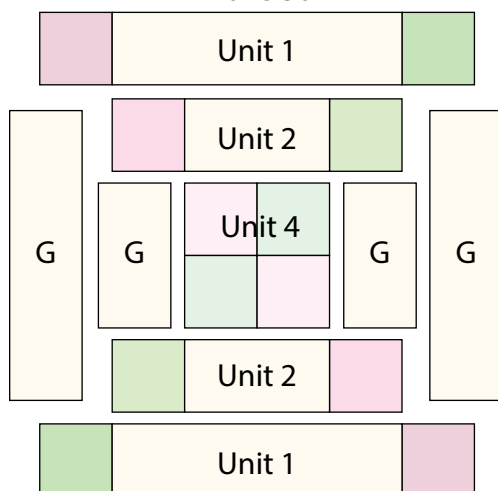

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

9. Sew (5) Block One squares together to make (1) row. Repeat to make (6) rows total.

10. Sew the (6) rows together to make the Center Block.

11. Center (1) 2" x 79" Fabric H strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a 1/4" from the top edge of the block and stop a 1/4" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.

12. Repeat Step 11 to sew (1) 2" x 67" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start 1/4" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 9).

13. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 9), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners. The Center Block should measure 63 1/2" x 75 1/2".

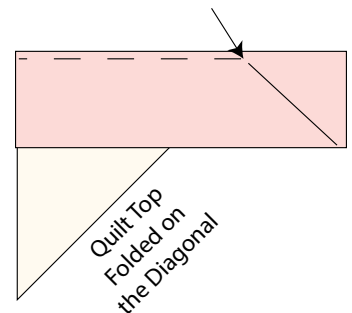

14. Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 75 1/2" Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 71 1/2" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

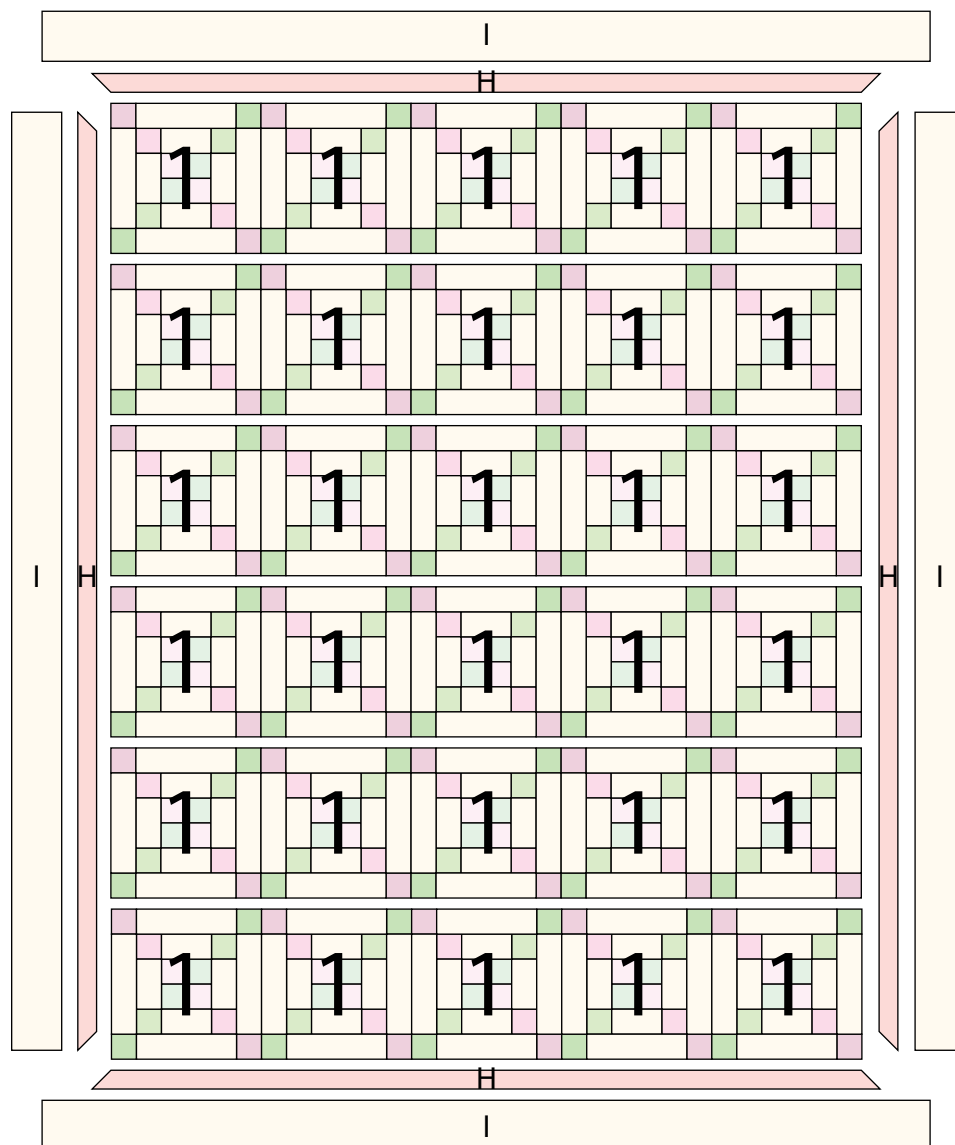
15. Layer and quilt as desired.

16. Sew the (8) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

17. Bind as desired.
