Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Book Panel - Aqua (A):

- Fussy cut (8) $73 / 4$ " small panels.

From the Bird Vine - Aqua (B), cut:

- (1) $93 / 4 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) $11 / 2 " \times 93 / 4 "$ strips.
- (1) $73 / 4 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) $11 / 2 " \times 73 / 4 "$ strips.
-(2) $47 / 8 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) $47 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Mini Hexies - Aqua (C), cut:
- (1) $47 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) $47 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Mini Bunny Toss - Green (D), cut:
-(1) $47 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $47 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Dots - Yellow (E), cut:
-(1) $47 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) $47 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Bird \& Bunny Allover - Pink (F), cut: -(1) $47 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $47 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Dots - Aqua (G), cut:

- (2) $47 / 8 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (11) $47 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Modern Melody Basics - True Blue (H), cut:
-(1) $47 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $47 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Modern Melody Basics - Grass Green (I), cut:
-(1) $47 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $47 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Bird \& Bunny Allover - Aqua (J), cut:
-(1) $47 / 8 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) $47 / 8 "$ squares.

- (4) 4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 " $\times 641 / 2 "$ strips.
-(3) $4 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $4 " \times 57 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strips.

From the Dots - Pink (K), cut:
-(1) $47 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) $47 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Mini Hexies - Pink (L), cut:
-(1) $47 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (9) $47 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Melody Basics - Fuchsia (M), cut:
-(2) $47 / 8 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (11) $47 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Folio - Peony Pink (N), cut:
-(1) $47 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (9) $47 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Folio - Jade (O), cut:
-(1) $47 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) $47 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Bird Vine - Pink (P), cut:
-(1) $47 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) $47 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Mini Bunny Toss - Aqua (Q), cut:
-(1) $47 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) $47 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Folio - Rose (R), cut:
-(1) $47 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $47 / 8 "$ squares.
-(7) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Folio - Lt. Pink (S), cut:
-(1) $47 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) $47 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Modern Melody Basics - Pink (T), cut:

- (1) $47 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $47 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Teal (U), cut:
-(1) $47 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $47 / 8 "$ squares.

- (3) $1 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1" x $571 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) 1" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 " \times 561 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Orange (V), cut:

- (1) $47 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) $47 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Bird Vine - Yellow (W), cut:
-(1) $47 / 8 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) $47 / 8 "$ squares.

## Cutting Instructions - Continued

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Folio - Powder Pink (X), cut:
-(2) $47 / 8 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $47 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Folio - Powder Blue (Y), cut:
-(2) $47 / 8 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $47 / 8 "$ squares.
From the Folio - Silver (Z), cut:

- (2) $47 / 8 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $47 / 8 "$ squares.


## From the Folio - White on White (AA), cut:

- (2) $4^{7 / 8 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $47 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Turquoise (BB), cut: - (1) $47 / 8 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $47 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Bird \& Bunny Allover - Yellow (Backing), cut:

- (2) 72 " $\times$ WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 72 " x 72 " back.


## Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 7 \frac{3 / 4 "}{}$

Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $73 / 4$ " Fabric A small panel. Sew (1) $11 / 2$ " x $93 / 4$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A small panel. Trim the block to measure $81 / 2$ " square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (8) Block One squares total.

2. Place (1) $47 / 8 "$ Fabric C square on top of (1) $47 / 8 "$ Fabric D square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Sew $1 / 4$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 3) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the blocks to measure $41 / 2$ " square to make (2) DC squares (Fig. 4). Note: Only 1 square will be used.

3. Repeat Step 2 and refer to Figure 5 on Page 3 for fabric identification and seam direction to make the number of units listed. There should be 212 units total. Also refer to Figure 5 for the number of units actually used. You will use 164 units.
4. Sew (1) DC unit, (1) EF unit, (1) HB unit and (1) IG unit together as shown in Figure 6 on Page 4 to make (1) Block Two square.
5. Repeat Step 4 and refer to Figures 7-31 on Page 4 to make the designated number of squares for Block Three through Block Twenty-Seven.

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
6. Sew (1) Block Twenty-Seven square, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Twenty-Seven square, (1) Block Three square, (1) Block Twenty-Seven square, (1) Block Four square and (1) Block Twenty-Seven square together in that order to make Row One.
7. Repeat Step 6 and refer to the Quilt Layout for block identification, placement and orientation to make Rows Two through Seven.
8. Sew the (7) Rows together in numerical order to make the Center Block.
9. Sew (1) 1 " $\times 561 / 2 "$ Fabric U strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1" x $571 / 2 "$ Fabric U strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Sew (1) 4 " $\times 57^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4 " x $641 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
11. Layer and quilt as desired.
12. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric R strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
13. Bind as desired.
