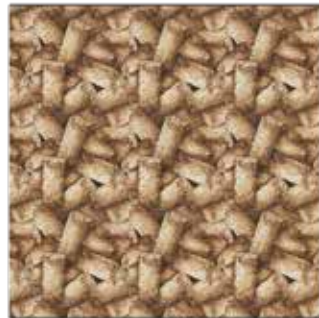

Runner Materials

1 ¼ yards	Border Stripe - Multi (A)	347-98
½ yard	Modern Melody Basics - Black (B)	1063-99
⅜ yard	Bottle Toppers - Black (C)	340-94
⅜ yard	Packed Corks - Brown (D)	342-33
¼ yard	Tossed Wine Bottles - Multi (E)	341-48
¼ yard	Tossed Grapes - Multi (F)	343-86
¼ yard	Tossed Corks and Corkscrews - Multi (G)	346-98
⅝ yard	Word Texture - Burgundy (H)	344-88*
1 ⅞ yards	Wine Labels - Multi (Backing)	339-48

Runner Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Border Stripe - Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 9 ¾" x 42 ½" LOF strip, centered on the stripe.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Black (B), cut:

- (3) 1 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ⅞" x 44 ½" strips.
- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 ½" x 9 ¾" strips.

From the Bottle Toppers - Black (C), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2 ½" squares.

From the Packed Corks - Brown (D), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2 ½" squares.

From the Tossed Wine Bottles - Multi (E), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 ½" squares.

From the Tossed Grapes - Multi (F), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 4 ½" squares.

From the Tossed Corks and Corkscrews - Multi (G), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 ½" squares.

From the Word Texture - Burgundy (H), cut:

- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 ½" x 20 ½" WOF strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 54 ½" strips.
- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Wine Labels - Multi (Backing), cut:

- (1) 62" x 30" WOF strip for the backing.

Runner Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 9 ¾" Fabric B strip to each end of the 9 ¾" x 42 ½" Fabric A strip. Sew (1) 1 ⅞" x 44 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A strip to make the Unit 1 strip (Fig. 1).

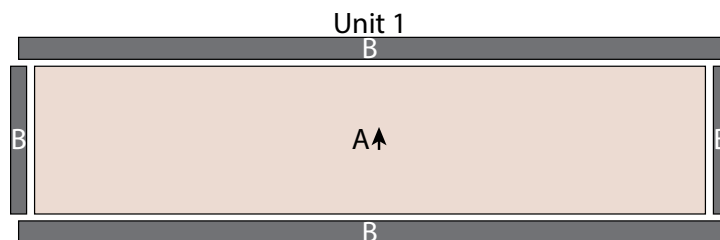

2. Place (1) 2 ½" Fabric D square on the left side of (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance (Fig. 3).

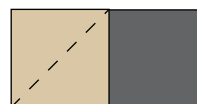

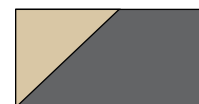

3. Place another 2 ½" Fabric D square on the right side of the 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 5).

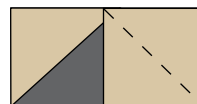

4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (16) Unit 2 strips total.

5. Repeat Steps 2-3 and refer to Figure 6 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (16) Unit 3 strips.

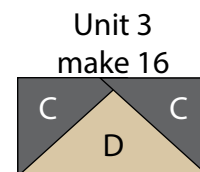

6. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to the top of (1) Unit 3 strip lengthwise to make (1) 4 ½" Unit 4 square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (16) Unit 4 squares total.

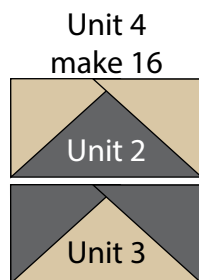

7. Sew (1) Unit 4 square to each side of (1) 4 ½" Fabric F square to make (1) Block One strip (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (8) Block One strips total.

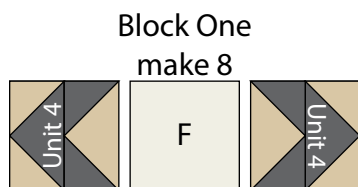

8. Sew together (3) Block One strips and (2) 4 ½" Fabric E squares, alternating them from left to right. Sew (1) 4 ½" Fabric G square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Top Border (Fig. 9 below). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

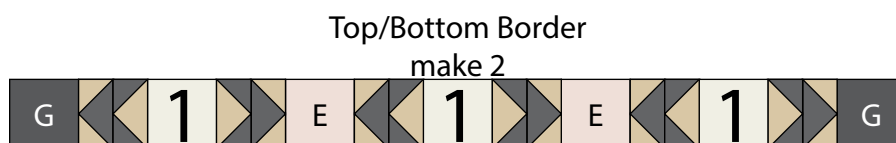

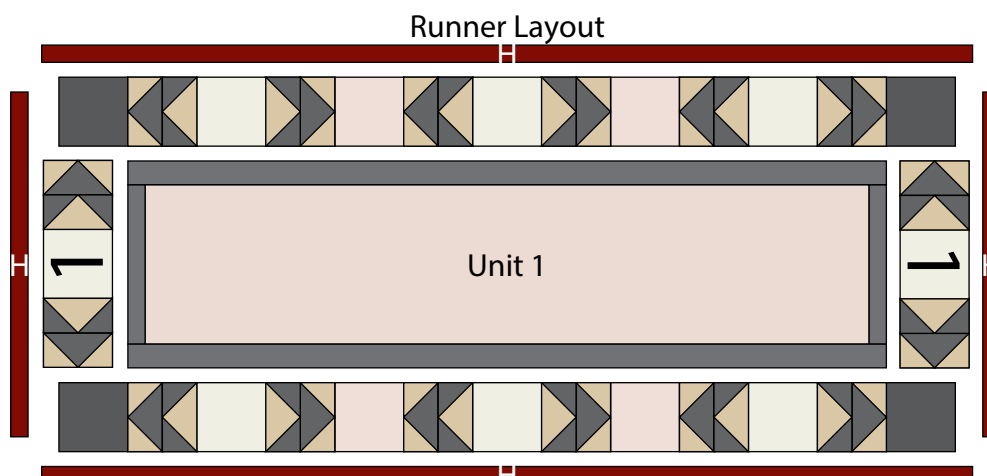

Runner Assembly

(Follow the Runner Layout in Figure 10 while assembling the runner.)

9. Sew (1) Block One strip to each end of the Unit 1 strip.
10. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 strip.
11. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 20 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the Unit 1 strip. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 54 ½" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 strip to make the Runner Top.
12. Layer and quilt as desired.
13. Sew the (4) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric H strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
14. Bind as desired.

Runner Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Wine Bottle Blocks - Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (6) 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{4}$ " rectangles, each centered on a block.

From the Word Texture - Burgundy (B), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 10 $\frac{1}{4}$ " strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (10) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Tossed Corks and Corkscrews - Multi (C), cut:

- (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Packed Corks - Brown (D), cut:

- (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Bottle Toppers - Black (E), cut:

- (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Wine Labels - Multi (Backings), cut:

- (3) 16" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 16" x 20" strips for the backings.

Place Mat Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

15. Sew (1) 2" x 10 $\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make (1) Block Two (Fig. 11). **Trim the block to measure 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.**

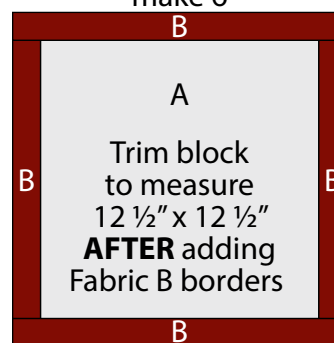

16. Place (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square on the left side of (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 12). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 12). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance (Fig. 13).

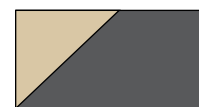

17. Place another 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square on the right side of the 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 14). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 14). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 5 strip (Fig. 15).

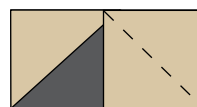

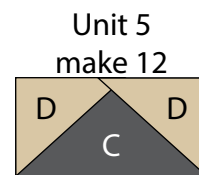

18. Repeat Steps 16-17 to make (12) Unit 5 strips total.

19. Repeat Steps 16-17 and refer to Figure 16 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (12) Unit 6 strips.

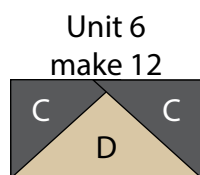

20. Sew (1) Unit 5 strip to the top of (1) Unit 6 strip lengthwise to make (1) 4 1/2" Unit 7 square. Repeat to make (12) Unit 7 squares total.

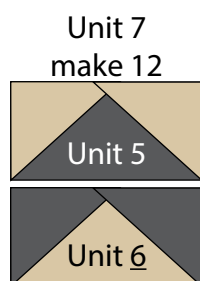

21. Sew (1) Unit 7 square to the top and to the bottom of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric E square to make (1) Block Three strip (Fig. 18). Repeat to make (6) Block Three strips total.

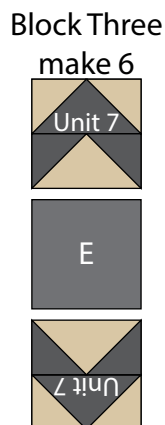

22. Sew (1) Block Three strip to the right side of (1) Block Two square lengthwise to make (1) Place Mat Top (Fig. 19). Repeat to make (6) Place Mat Tops total.

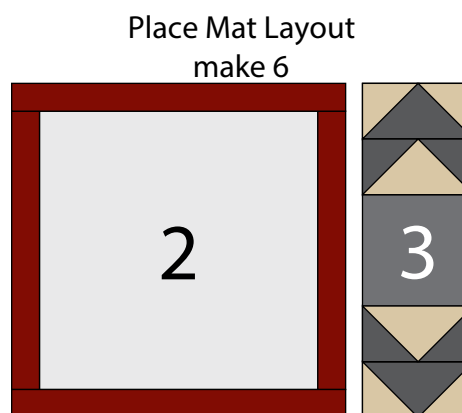

23. Layer and quilt as desired.

24. Sew the (10) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

25. Bind as desired.
