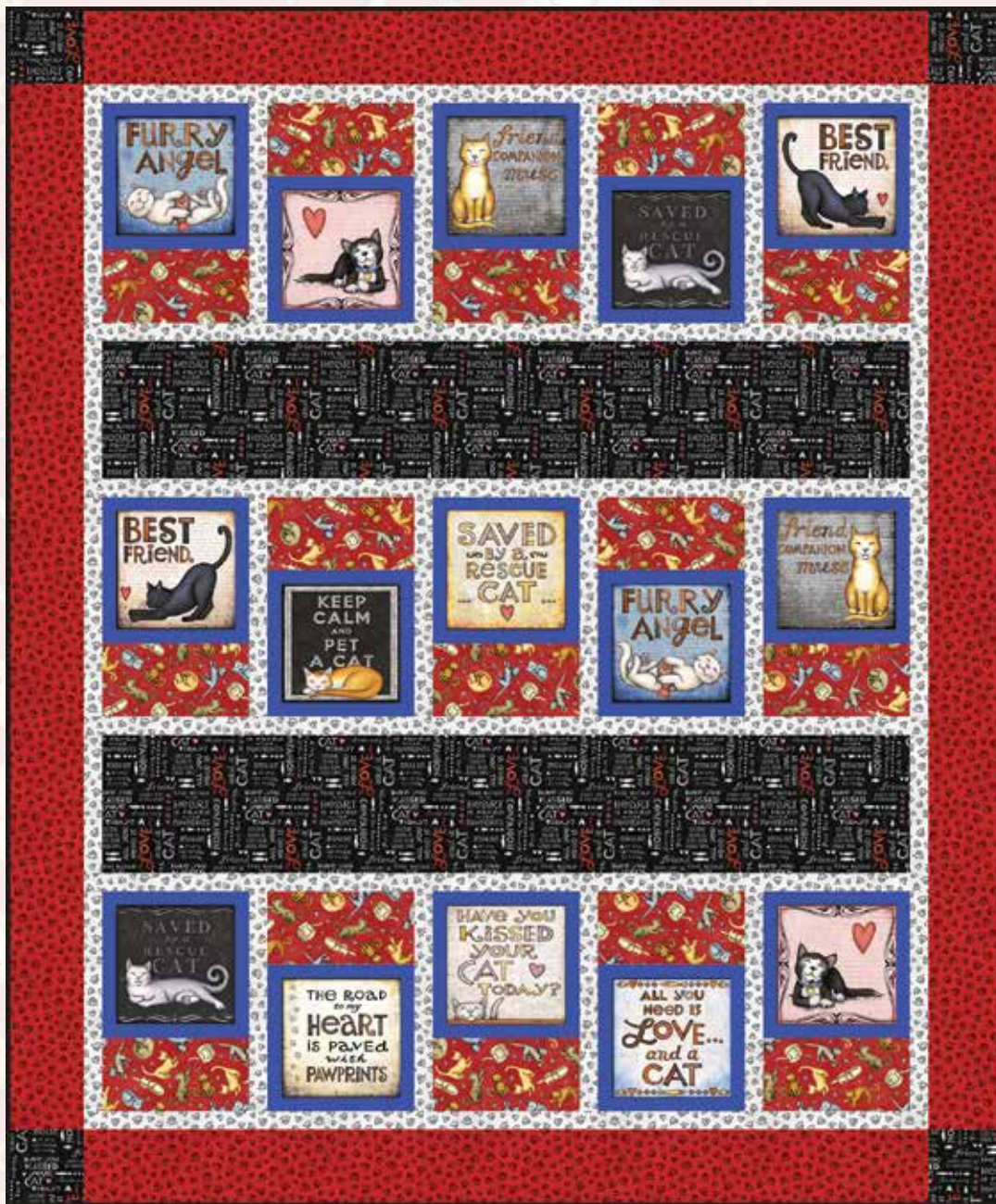

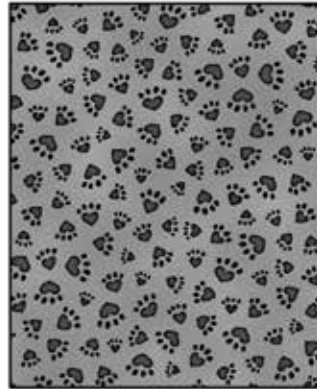

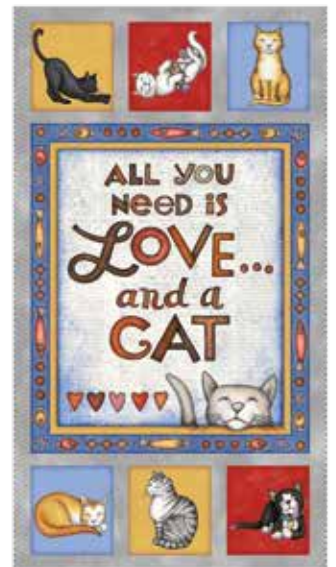

## Materials

2/3 yard	Cat Blocks - Multi (A)	9906-77
7/8 yard	Modern Melody Basics - Royal (B)	1063-75
5/8 yard	Tossed Cats - Red (C)	9905-88
3/4 yard	Paw Prints - Light Gray (D)	9904-9
7/8 yard	Words - Black (E)	9907-99
7/8 yard	Paw Prints - Red (F)	9904-88
1/2 yard	Modern Melody Basics - Black (G)	1063-99*
3 1/2 yards	Tossed Cats - Red (Backing)	9905-88

\*Includes binding

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

### From the Cat Blocks - Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (15) 7" x 7 1/4" rectangles, each centered on a block.

### From the Modern Melody Basics - Royal (B), cut:

- (5) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 2" x 7 1/4" strips.
- (8) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 2" x 10" strips.

### From the Tossed Cats - Red (C), cut:

- (4) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (15) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.

### From the Paw Prints - Light Gray (D), cut:

- (6) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (18) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 1 1/2" x 8" strips.
- (7) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (6) 1 1/2" x 46 1/2" strips.

### From the Words - Black (E), cut:

- (3) 8" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 8" x 44 1/2" strips.
- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 1/2" squares.

### From the Paw Prints - Red (F), cut:

- (3) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 1/2" x 57 1/2" strips.
- (3) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 1/2" x 46 1/2" strips.

### From the Modern Melody Basics - Black (G), cut:

- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

### From the Tossed Cats - Red (Backing), cut:

- (2) 62" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 62" x 73" back.

## Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 7 1/4" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 7" x 7 1/4" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 10" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 8 1/2" x 8 1/2"**. Repeat to make (15) Unit 1 squares total.

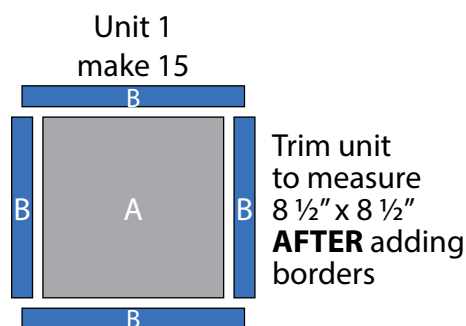

2. Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric C strip to the bottom of (1) Unit 1 square to make (1) Unit 2 rectangle (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (9) Unit 2 rectangles total.

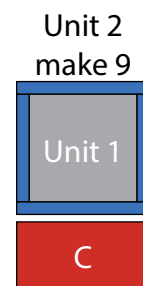

3. Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top of (1) Unit 1 square to make (1) Unit 3 rectangle (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (6) Unit 3 rectangles total.

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4. Sew together (1) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric D strip, (1) Unit 2 rectangle, (1) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric D strip, (1) Unit 3 rectangle, (1) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric D strip, (1) Unit 2 rectangle, (1) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric D strip, (1) Unit 3 rectangle, (1) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric D strip, (1) Unit 2 rectangle and (1) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric D strip, in that order from left to right, to make (1) 12 1/2" X 46 1/2" Unit 4 strip (Fig. 4 below). Repeat to make (3) Unit 4 strips total.

5. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 8" Fabric D strip to each end of (1) 8" x 44 1/2" Fabric E strip. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 46 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E strip to make (1) 10" x 46 1/2" Unit 5 strip (Fig. 5 below). Repeat to make a second Unit 5 strip.

## Quilt Top Assembly

*(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*

6. Sew together (3) Unit 4 strips and (2) Unit 5 strips, lengthwise and alternating them from top to bottom, to make the Center Block.

7. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 46 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

8. Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 57 1/2" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4 1/2" Fabric E square to each end of (1) 4 1/2" x 46 1/2" Fabric F strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

9. Layer and quilt as desired.

10. Sew the (6) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

11. Bind as desired.

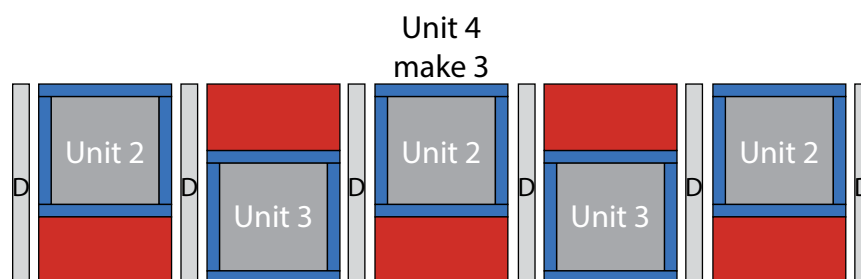

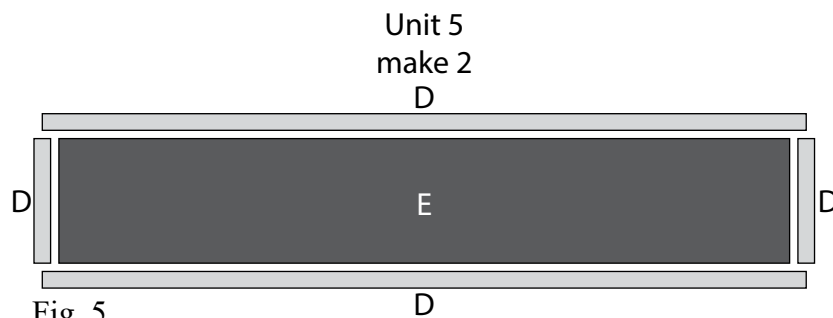
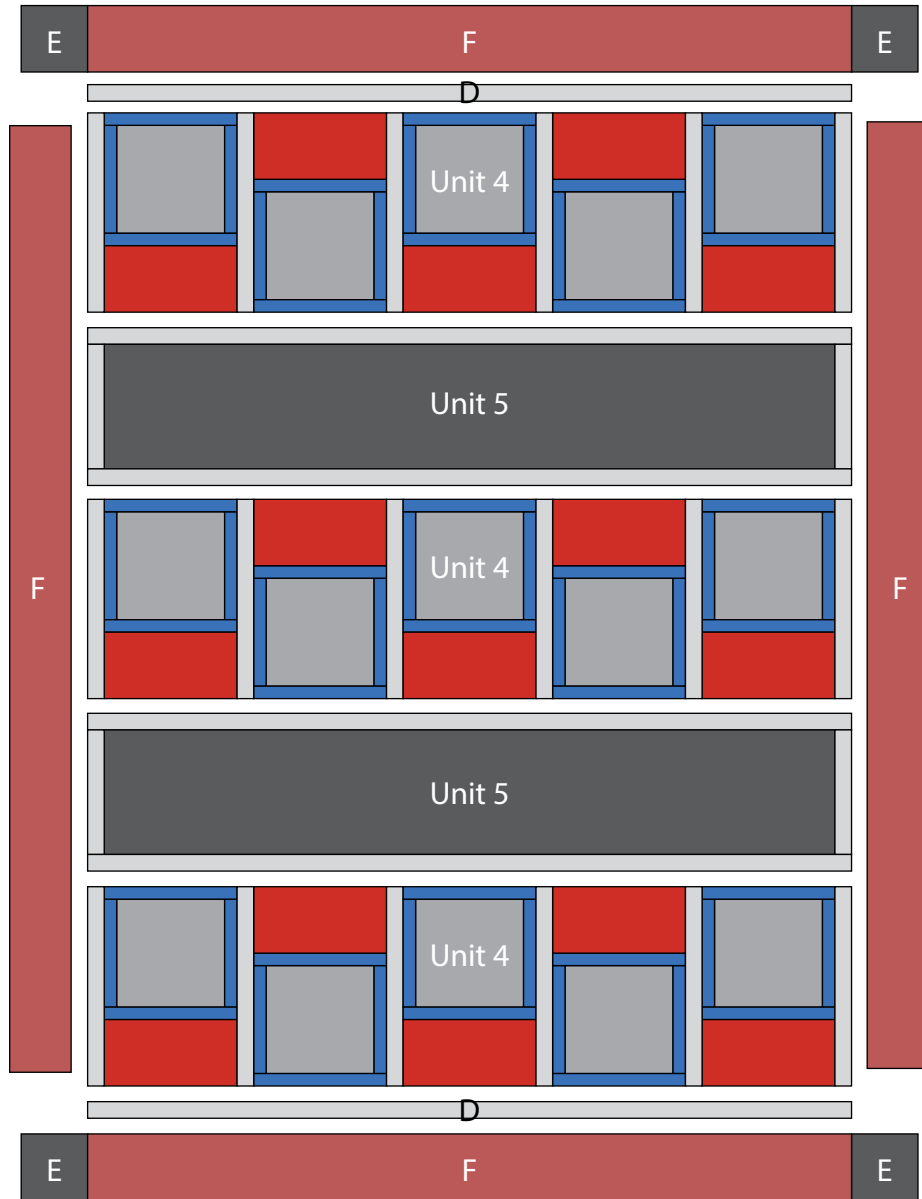
