#### **Cutting Instructions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Panel - Cream A), cut:

• (1) 26 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" square.

#### From the Dots - Cream (B), cut:

- (13) 2 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (240) 2 1/8" squares.
- (20) 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (480) 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" squares

#### From the Stripe - Cream (C):

• Fussy cut (120) 1 3/4" squares, each centered on a shape.

#### From the Check - Sage (D), cut:

• (2) 2 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) 2 1/8" squares.

#### From the Check - Cream (E), cut:

• (2) 2 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 2 1/8" squares.

#### From the Star - Light Blue (F), cut:

- (4) 4 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (29) 4 1/4" squares.
- (2) 2 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2 1/8" squares.

#### From the Presents - Sage (G), cut:

- (4) 4 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) 4 1/4" squares.
- (1) 2 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (14) 2 1/8" squares.

#### From the Dots - Brown (H), cut:

- (3) 2 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (44) 2 1/8" squares.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Holly - Clay (I), cut:

• (2) 2 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (38) 2 1/8" squares.

#### From the Star - Medium Blue (J), cut:

- (4) 4 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (29) 4 1/4" squares.
- (1) 2 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 1/8" squares.

#### From the Dots - Clay (K), cut:

• (1) 2 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 1/8" squares.

#### From the Holly - Cream (L), cut:

• (2) 2 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 1/8" squares.

#### From the Holly - Light Blue (M), cut:

• (4) 4 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (34) 4 1/4" squares.

#### From the Stripe - Light Blue (N), cut:

• (4) 3" x 73" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.

#### From the Star - Cream (Backing), cut:

• (2) 77" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 77" x 77" back.


#### **Block Assembly**

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.


1. Place (1) 2 1/8" Fabric D square on top of (1) 2 1/8" Fabric B square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 1 3/4" square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (72) Unit 1 squares total.








2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figures 4-11 for fabric identification and placement to make the designated number of unit squares for Unit 2 through Unit 9. There will be (480) half-square triangles in total.







3. Sew (1) 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" Fabric B square to each side of (1) Unit 1 square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each side of (1) 1 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" Fabric C square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 12). Repeat to make (18) Block One squares total.








4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Figures 13-20 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the designated number of block squares for Block Two through Block Nine.






5. Follow Figure 21 and sew together (18) assorted Blocks and (17) assorted 4 1/4" squares into a 5 x 7 matrix to make the Left Side Border.



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
6. Repeat Step 5 and refer to Figures 22-24 to make the Right Side Border, Top Border and Bottom Border.



#### **Quilt Top Assembly**

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
7. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right side of the 26 ¾" Fabric A square. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and bottom of the Fabric A square to make the Center Block.

8. Center (1) 3" x 73" Fabric N strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a ½" from the top edge of the block and stop a ½" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.









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- 9. Repeat Step 8 to sew (1) 3" x 73" Fabric N strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start 1/4" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 25).
- 10. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 25), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a ¼" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the quilt top.



- 11. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 12. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric H strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 13. Bind as desired.



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
