$5 / 8$ yard $\quad$ Quarter Inch Stripe - Multi (D) 616-186
$1 / 2$ yard Tossed Bees - Multi (E)
$1 / 2$ yard Check - Black/White (F)
$3 / 8$ yard Tossed Animals - Multi (G)
$1 / 4$ yard Tossed Boats - Royal (H)
$1 / 4$ yard Tossed Octopus - Royal (I) 620-77
$1 / 4$ yard Moons and Clouds - Royal (J) 613-77
$1 / 2$ yard Folio Basics - White on White (K) 7755-01W
$12 / 3$ yards Hot Air Balloon, Rocket, Planes - Blue (L)

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 24 Inch Alphabet Panel - Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (1) $20 \frac{1}{1} 2 " \times 343 / 4$ " rectangle, centered on the panel

From the Folio Basics - True Red (B), cut:

- (2) 2 " $\times 343 / 2$ " WOF strips.
- (2) $21 / 8 " \times 231 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
-(6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Sun and Clouds - Blue (C), cut:
- (2) $41 / 2 " \times 37$ " Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) $31 / 2 " \times 301 / 2 "$ WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Quarter Inch Stripe - Multi (D), cut:
-(3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 43 "$ strips.
-(3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 521 / 2 "$ strips.
-(2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 421 / 2 "$ WOF strips, piece as needed.
-(2) $11 / 4 " \times 321 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
From the Tossed Bees - Multi (E), cut:
-(3) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) $41 / 2>$ squares.
From the Check - Black/White (F), cut:

- (5) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (80) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Tossed Animals - Multi (G), cut:

- (2) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Tossed Boats - Royal (H), cut:

- (1) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $41 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Tossed Octopus - Royal (I), cut:

- (1) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Moons and Clouds - Royal (J), cut:

- (1) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Folio Basics - White on White (K), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 541 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 45^{1 / 2 "}$ strips.

From the Hot Air Balloon, Rocket, Planes - Blue (L), cut:

- (2) $41 / 2 " \times 571 / 2 "$ LOF strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) $41 / 2$ " $531 / 2 / 2$ WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Tossed Letters - Royal (Backing), cut:

- (2) 61 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 61 " x 73 " back.


## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 343 / 4 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the $201 / 2 " \times 343 / 4 "$ Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) $21 / 8 " \times 231 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure $221 / 2 " \times 37 "$.

2. Place (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric F square on the top left corner of (1) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric E square, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn seam (Fig. 3).

3. Follow Figure 4 for the seam direction to add a $21 / 2$ " Fabric F square to each of the remaining corners of the $41 / 2$, Fabric E square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 5).
4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (20) Block One squares total.

5. Refer to Figure 6 and sew together
(6) Block One squares, (3) $41 / 2$ " Fabric G squares and (2) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric J squares to make (1) Side Border. Repeat to make a second Side Border.
6. Refer to Figure 7 and sew together (2) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric I squares, (4) Block One squares, (2) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric G squares and (1) $41 / 2 \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to make the Top Border. Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

Quilt Top Assembly
(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
7. Sew (1) $4^{1 / 2} \times 37^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block.
8. Sew (1) $31 / 2 " \times 301 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
9. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} " \times 43 "$ Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 4 \times 321 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Top and Bottom Borders to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 521 / 2 "$ Fabric $D$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
12. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 541 / 2 "$ Fabric $K$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $451 / 2 "$ Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
13. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 571 / 2 "$ Fabric L strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 531 / 2 "$ Fabric L strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
14. Layer and quilt as desired.
15. Sew the (6) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
16. Bind as desired.
