





1 ½ yards	Folio - Brown Bag (B)	7755-30*
1 1/4 yards	Pumpkin - White (C)	730M-01
²⁄₃ yard	Tossed Pumpkins - Black (D)	726M-99
5/8 yard	Plaid - Brown (E)	728M-35
1/4 yard	Tossed Sunflower - Black (F)	729M-99
²⁄₃ yard	Berry - Black (G)	724M-99
½ yard	Gingham - Gold (H)	727M-33
3/8 yard	Folio - White on White (I)	7755-01
2 ¹ / ₄ yards	Border Stripe - Cream (J)	731M-04
4 ³ / ₄ yards	Pumpkin - Black (Backing)	730M-99

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 24 Inch Panel - Cream (A):

• Fussy cut (1) 22 ½" x 40 ½" rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Folio - Brown Bag (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 40 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 25 ½" WOF strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 60 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 44 ½" strips.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Pumpkin - White (C), cut:

- (2) 3 ½" x 42 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 3 ½" x 30 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Tossed Pumpkins - Black (D), cut:

• (3) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (15) 6 ½" squares.

From the Plaid - Brown (E), cut:

• (5) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (60) 3 ½" squares.

From the Tossed Sunflower - Black (F), cut:

• (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (15) 3 ½" squares.

From the Berry - Black (G), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (60) 2" squares.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 62 ½" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 47 ½" strips.

From the Gingham - Gold (H), cut:

• (6) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (120) 2" squares.

From the Folio - White on White (I), cut:

• (5) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (60) 2" x 3 ½" strips.

From the Border Stripe - Cream (J), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" x 79" LOF strips.
- (2) 5 ½" x 61" LOF strips.


From the Pumpkin - Black (Backing), cut:

• (2) 83" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 65" x 83" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 40 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 25 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure 24 ½" x 42 ½".



2. Place (1) 2" Fabric H square on the left side of (1) 2" x 3 ½" Fabric I strip, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance (Fig. 3).


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- 3. Place another 2" Fabric H square on the right side of the 2" x 3 ½" Fabric I strip, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 5).
- 4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (60) Unit 1 strips total.





5. Sew (1) 2" Fabric G square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of (1) 3 ½" Fabric F square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 6 ½" Block One square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (15) Block One squares



6. Place (1) 3 ½" Fabric E square on the top left corner of (1) 6 ½" Fabric D square, right sides together (Fig. 7). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 7). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 8).

- 7. Follow Figure 9 for the seam direction to add a 3 ½" Fabric E square to each of the remaining corners of the 6 1/2" Fabric D square to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 10).
- 8. Repeat Steps 6-7 to make (15) Block Two squares total.

9. Sew together (4) Block One squares and (4) Block Two squares, alternating them from top to bottom, to make (1) Side Border (Fig. 11). Repeat to make a second Side Border.



10. Sew together (4) Block Two squares and (3) Block One squares, alternating them from left to right, to make the Top Border (Fig. 12).



11. Sew together (4) Block One squares and (3) Block Two squares, alternating them from left to right, to make the Bottom Border (Fig. 13).



Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

- 12. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 42 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 30 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 13. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block.
- 14. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of Center Block.

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- 15. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 60 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 16. Sew (1) 2" x 62 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 47 ½" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 17. Center (1) 5 ½" x 79" Fabric J strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a ¼" from the top edge of the block and stop a ¼" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.
- 18. Repeat Step 17 to sew (1) 5 ½" x 61" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start ¼" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 14).

19. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 14), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the quilt top.




- 20. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 21. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 22. Bind as desired.



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
