## Runner Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Tossed Sunflower - Black (A), cut:

- (1) $27 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $27 / 8 "$ squares and
(8) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Tossed Pumpkins - Black (B), cut:
-(1) $27 / 8 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $27 / 8 "$ squares and
(8) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Plaid - Brown (C), cut:
-(1) $27 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $27 / 8 "$ squares and
(4) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
-(4) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Small Sunflower - Gold (D), cut:
-(1) $27 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $27 / 8 "$ squares and
(4) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Pumpkin - Black (E), cut:

- (1) $113 / 4 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $113 / 4 "$ x 5 " strips.

From the Folio - Off-White (F), cut:

- (1) $27 / 8 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) $27 / 8 "$ squares
- (1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $21 / 2 "$ and (12) $2 "$ squares.
- (3) $1 \frac{1}{4} " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 113 / 4$ " strips.
-(2) $7 / 8 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $7 / 8 " \times 61 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Folio - Brown Bag (G), cut:
- (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2} \gg \times 121 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 441 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Border Stripe - Cream (H), cut:

- (2) $51 / 2 " \times 28^{\prime \prime}$ Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
-(3) $5 \frac{1}{2} / 2 \times 58 "$ LOF strips.


## From the Pumpkin - White (Backing), cut:

-(1) $62 " \times 32 "$ WOF strip for the backing.

Runner Block Assembly
Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Place (1) $27 / 8 "$ Fabric A square on top of (1) $27 / 8 "$

Fabric F square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew $1 / 4 "$ away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure $21 / 2 "$ square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (8) Unit 1 squares total.

3. Place (1) 2 " Fabric F square on the bottom left corner of (1) Unit $21 / 2 "$ Fabric A square, right sides together (Fig. 7). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 7). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4 "$ away from the sewn seam (Fig. 8).

16. Sew (1) $11 / 4 " \times 113 / 4 "$ Fabric F strip to each side of (1) 5 " x $113 / 4$ " Fabric E strip. Sew (1) $7 / 8$ " x $61 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E strip to make (1) $61 / 2$ " $\times 121 / 2$ " Block Four rectangle (Fig. 21). Repeat to make (4) Block Four rectangles total.

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17. Sew together (1) Block Four rectangle, (1) Block One rectangle, (1) Block Four rectangle, (1) Block Two rectangle, (1) Block Four rectangle, (1) Block Three rectangle and (1) Block Four rectangle, lengthwise and in that order from left to right, to make the Runner Center Block (Fig. 22 below).

## Runner Assembly

(Follow the Runner Layout in Figure 24 while assembling.) 18. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 12^{1 / 2 " ~ F a b r i c ~ G ~ s t r i p ~ t o ~ e a c h ~ s i d e ~ o f ~ t h e ~}$ Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 441 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
19. Center (1) $51 / 2 " \times 28^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $1 / 4 "$ from the top edge of the block and stop a $1 / 4 "$ from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.
20. Repeat Step 19 to sew (1) $51 / 2 " \times 58 "$ Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start $1 / 4$ " away from each end of the block. To
miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 23).
21. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 23), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the Runner top.

23. Sew the (4) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

## Place Mat Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Continuous Block - Cream (A):

- Fussy cut (8) $10 \frac{1}{2} / 2$ squares, each centered on a block.

From the Plaid - Brown (B), cut:

- (1) $27 / 8 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $27 / 8 "$ squares.
- (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
- (2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 " x $101 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $2 "$ x $131 / 2 "$ strips.
- (7) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF strips for binding (4) place mats.

From the Small Sunflower - Gold (C), cut:

- (1) $27 / 8 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $27 / 8 "$ squares.
-(1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Folio - Off-White (D), cut:
- (3) $27 / 8 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) $27 / 8 "$ squares.
- (1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
- (2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2" squares.

From the Zigzag Line - Gold (E), cut:
-(2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 " x $101 / 2 "$ strips.

- (3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 " x $131 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Tossed Pumpkins - Black (F), cut:

- (1) $27 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $27 / 8 "$ squares.
- (1) $21 / 2>x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Tossed Sunflower - Black (G), cut:

- (1) $27 / 8 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $27 / 8 "$ squares.
- (1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Folio - Brown Bag (H), cut:

- (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for binding (4) place mats.


## From the Pumpkin - White (Backings), cut:

- (4) 22 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 22 " x 16 " rectangles for the backs.

Place Mat Block Assembly
Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.
25. Sew (1) $2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $101 / 2 "$ Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x $131 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Block Five square (Fig. 25). Trim the block to measure $121 / 2 " \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$. Repeat to make (4) Block Five squares total.
26. Sew (1) 2 " x $101 / 2$ " Fabric E strip to each side of (1) $101 / 2 "$ Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x $131 / 2$ " Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Block Six square (Fig. 26). Trim the block to measure $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{1 / 2 " \text {. Repeat to make (4) Block Six squares total. }}$
