

Runner Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Tossed Sunflower - Black (A), cut:

• (1) 2 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 1/8" squares and (8) 2 ½" squares.

From the Tossed Pumpkins - Black (B), cut:

• (1) 2 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 1/8" squares and (8) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Plaid - Brown (C), cut:

- (1) 2 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 1/8" squares and (4) 2 ½" squares.
- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Small Sunflower - Gold (D), cut:

• (1) 2 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 1/8" squares and (4) 2 ½" squares.

From the Pumpkin - Black (E), cut:

• (1) 11 ³/₄" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 11 ³/₄" x 5" strips.

From the Folio - Off-White (F), cut:

- (1) 2 \%" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 \%" squares
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 2 ½" and (12) 2" squares.
- (3) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/4" x 11 3/4" strips.
- (2) 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 7/8" x 6 1/2" strips.

From the Folio - Brown Bag (G), cut:

- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 ½" x 12 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 44 ½" strips.

From the Border Stripe - Cream (H), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" x 28" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (3) 5 ½" x 58" LOF strips.


From the Pumpkin - White (Backing), cut:

• (1) 62" x 32" WOF strip for the backing.


Runner Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise

1. Place (1) 2 %" Fabric A square on top of (1) 2 %" Fabric F square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2½" square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (8) Unit 1 squares total.



2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figures 4-6 for fabric identification and placement to make (8) Unit 2 squares, (4) Unit 3 squares and (4) Unit 4 squares.



3. Place (1) 2" Fabric F square on the bottom left corner of (1) Unit 2 ½" Fabric A square, right sides together (Fig. 7). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 7). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 8).


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- 4. Follow Figure 9 for the seam direction to add a 2" Fabric F square to the upper right corner of the 2 ½" Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 5 square (Fig. 10).
- 5. Repeat steps 3-4 to make a second Unit 5 square.





6. Repeat Steps 3-4 and refer to Figures 11-13 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (2) Unit 6 squares, (1) Unit 7 square and (1) Unit 8 square.







7. Sew together (1) 2 ½" Fabric F square, (2) Unit 1 squares, in that order from left to right, to make the top row (Fig. 14).

- 8. Sew together (1) Unit 1 square and (2) 2 ½" Fabric A squares, in that order from left to right, to make the middle row (Fig. 14).
- 9. Sew together (1) Unit 1 square, (1) 2 1/2" Fabric A square and (1) Unit 5 square, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row (Fig. 14).
- 10. Sew together the (3) rows from Steps 7-9 lengthwise to make (1) 6 ½" Unit 9 square (Fig. 14).
- 11. Repeat Steps 7-10 to make a second Unit 9 square.





12. Repeat Steps 7-10 and refer to Figures 15-17 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (2) Unit 10 squares, (1) Unit 11 square and (1) Unit 12 square.







- 13. Sew (1) Unit 9 square to the top of (1) Unit 10 square to make (1) Block One rectangle (Fig. 18).
- 14. Sew (1) Unit 11 square to the top of (1) Unit 12 square to make (1) Block Two rectangle (Fig. 19).

15. Sew (1) Unit 10 square to the top of (1)Unit 9 square to make (1) Block Three rectangle (Fig. 20).



16. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 11 3/4" Fabric F strip to each side of (1) 5" x 11 3/4" Fabric E strip. Sew (1) 7/8" x 6 ½" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E strip to make (1) 6 ½" x 12 ½" Block Four rectangle (Fig. 21). Repeat to make (4) Block Four rectangles total.



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17. Sew together (1) Block Four rectangle, (1) Block One rectangle, (1) Block Four rectangle, (1) Block Two rectangle, (1) Block Four rectangle, (1) Block Three rectangle and (1) Block Four rectangle, lengthwise and in that order from left to right, to make the Runner Center Block (Fig. 22 below).

Runner Assembly

(Follow the Runner Layout in Figure 24 while assembling.) 18. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 19. Center (1) 5 ½" x 28" Fabric H strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a ½" from the top edge of the block and stop a ½" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.
- 20. Repeat Step 19 to sew (1) 5 ½" x 58" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start ¼" away from each end of the block. To

miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 23).

21. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 23), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a ½" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the Runner top.



- 22. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 23. Sew the (4) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 24. Bind as desired.





Place Mat Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Continuous Block - Cream (A):

• Fussy cut (8) 10 ½" squares, each centered on a block.

From the Plaid — Brown (B), cut:

- (1) 2 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 1/8" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" squares.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 10 ½" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 13 ½" strips.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for binding (4) place mats.

From the Small Sunflower - Gold (C), cut:

- (1) 2 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 1/8" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" squares.

From the Folio - Off-White (D), cut:

- (3) 2 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2 1/8" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" squares.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2" squares.

From the Zigzag Line - Gold (E), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 10 ½" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 13 ½" strips.

From the Tossed Pumpkins - Black (F), cut:

- (1) 2 \%" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 \%" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" squares.

From the Tossed Sunflower - Black (G), cut:

- (1) 2 \%" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 \%" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" squares.

From the Folio - Brown Bag (H), cut:

• (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for binding (4) place mats.


From the Pumpkin - White (Backings), cut:

• (4) 22" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 22" x 16" rectangles for the backs.


Place Mat Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

- 25. Sew (1) 2" x 10 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 10 ½" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 13 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Block Five square (Fig. 25). **Trim the block to measure** 12 ½" x 12 ½". Repeat to make (4) Block Five squares total.
- 26. Sew (1) 2" x 10 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of (1) 10 ½" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 13 ½" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Block Six square (Fig. 26). **Trim the block to measure** 12 ½" x 12 ½". Repeat to make (4) Block Six squares total.




27. Place (1) 2 1/8" Fabric B square on top of (1) 2 1/8" Fabric D square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 27). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 27). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 28) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2 1/2" square to make (2) Unit 13 squares (Fig. 29). Repeat to make (16) Unit 13 squares total.




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28. Repeat Step 27 and refer to Figures 30-32 for fabric identification and placement to make (16) of each unit square, Unit 14-16.

29. Place (1) 2" Fabric D square on the bottom left corner of (1) Unit 2 ½" Fabric B square, right sides together (Fig. 33). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 33). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 34). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ¼" away from the sewn seam.

30. Follow Figure 35 for the seam direction to add a 2" Fabric D square to the upper right corner of the 2 ½" Fabric B square to make (1) Unit 17 square (Fig. 36).

31. Repeat Steps 29-30 to make (4) Unit 17 squares total.



32. Repeat Steps 29-30 and refer to Figures 37-39 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (4) Unit 18 squares, (4) Unit 19 squares and (4) Unit 20 squares.

33. Sew together (1) 2 ½" Fabric D square and (2) Unit 13 squares, in that order from left to right, to make the top row

(Fig. 40).

- 34. Sew together (1) Unit 13 square and (2) 2 ½" Fabric B squares, in that order from left to right, to make the middle row (Fig. 40).
- 35. Sew together (1) Unit 13 square, (1) 2 ½" Fabric B square and (1) Unit 17 square, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row (Fig. 40).
- 36. Sew together the (3) rows from Steps 33-35 lengthwise to make (1) 6 ½" Block Seven square (Fig. 40).
- 37. Repeat Steps 33-36 to make(4) Block Seven squares total.






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Place Mat Assembly (Follow the Runner Layouts in Figures 44-45 while assembling.)

39. Sew (1) Block Seven square to the top of (1) Block Eight square. Sew the newly sewn strip to the right side of (1) Block Five square to make (1) Place Mat #1 top (Fig. 44). Repeat to make (4) Place Mat #1 tops total.




- 40. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 41. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Cut the strip into (4) equal pieces for the Place Mat #1 bindings.
- 42. Bind as desired.

43. Sew (1) Block Nine square to the top of (1) Block Ten square. Sew the newly sewn strip to the right side of (1) Block Six square to make (1) Place Mat #2 top (Fig. 45). Repeat to make (4) Place Mat #2 tops total.



- 44. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 45. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric H strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Cut the strip into (4) equal pieces for the Place Mat #2 bindings.
- 46. Bind as desired.
