



Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Tiny Berry Toss - Cream (A), cut:

• (6) 8 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (3) 8 ¹/₂" x 72 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Foulard Diamonds - Black/Cheddar (B), cut:

• (1) 4 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4 ¹/₂" squares.

• (3) Large Leaf templates.

From the Tiny Wheels - Pumpkin (C), cut:

- (3) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 ¹/₂" x 4 ¹/₂" strips. • (3) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2 ¹/₂" squares.
- (3) Small Leaf templates.

From the Tossed Sprigs - Green (D), cut:

- (2) 2 ⁷/₈" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 ⁷/₈" squares.
- (2) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 ¹/₂" squares.
- (3) Large Leaf templates.

From the Tiny Berry Toss - Dark Pumpkin (E), cut: • (3) Small Leaf templates.

From the Tossed Sprigs - Dark Gold (F), cut:

- (3) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2 ¹/₂" squares.
- (3) Large Leaf templates.

From the Acorns and Oak Leaves - Green (G), cut:

- (1) 4 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4 ¹/₂" squares.
- (2) 2 ⁷/₈" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 ⁷/₈" squares.
- (2) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 ¹/₂" squares.
- (3) Large Leaf templates.
- (3) Small Leaf templates.

From the Berry Branches - Red (H), cut:

- (3) Large Leaf templates.
- (3) Small Leaf templates.

From the Berry Branches - Gold (I), cut:

- (3) Large Leaf templates.
- (3) Small Leaf templates.

From the Floral Bud Trellis - Green (J), cut:

• (3) Small Leaf templates.

From the Novelty Toss - Cocoa (K), cut:

- (4) 6 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 ¹/₂" x 75 ¹/₂" strips.
- (4) 6 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 ¹/₂" x 69 ¹/₂" strips.
- (3) Large Leaf templates.

From the Acorns and Oak Leaves - Pumpkin (L), cut:

• (3) Small Leaf templates.

From the Floral Bud Trellis - Gold (M), cut:

• (3) Large Leaf templates.

From the Buttermilk Blenders - Cream (N), cut:

- (4) 2 ⁷/₈" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2 ⁷/₈" squares.
- (6) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2 ¹/₂" x 4 ¹/₂" strips.
- (3) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Buttermilk Blenders - Brown (O), cut:

• (3) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Tiny Wheels - Red (P), cut:

- (3) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 ¹/₂" x 4 ¹/₂" strips.
- (3) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Floral Buttons - Black/Brown (Q), cut:

- (11) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (6) 2" x 72 ½" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 57 ¹/₂" strips.
- (8) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Floral Bud Trellis - Red (Backing), cut:

• (2) 95" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 77" x 95" back.


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Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Place (1) 2 ⁷/₈" Fabric D square on top of (1) 2 ⁷/₈"


Fabric N square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew ¹/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2 ¹/₂" square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (48) Unit 1 squares total.



2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figure 4 for fabric identification and placement to make (48) Unit 2 squares.

3. Sew (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric N square to the left side of (1) Unit 1 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to the left side of (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 3 square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (24) Unit 3 squares total.

4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Figure 6 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (24) Unit 4 squares.






5. Place (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square on the left side of (1) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric N strip, right sides together (Fig. 7). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 7). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance (Fig. 8).




6. Place another 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square on the right side of the 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 9). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 9). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 5 strip (Fig. 10).

7. Repeat Steps 5-6 to make (24) Unit 5 strips total.



8. Repeat Steps 5-6 and refer to Figures 11-13 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (24) Unit 6 strips, (24) Unit 7 strips and (24) Unit 8 strips.



9. Sew (1) Unit 6 strip to the top of (1) Unit 5 strip lengthwise and along the Fabric C sides to make (1) 4 ¹/₂" Unit 9 square (Fig. 14). Repeat to make (24) Unit 9 squares total.




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
10. Sew (1) Unit 8 strip to the top of (1) Unit 7 strip lengthwise and along the Fabric P sides to make (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 10 square (Fig. 15). Repeat to make (24) Unit 10 squares total.



11. Sew (1) Unit 3 square to each side of (1) Unit 9 square to the make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 9 square to each side of (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Block One square (Fig. 16). Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.



12. Sew (1) Unit 4 square to each side of (1) Unit 10 square to the make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 10 square to each side of (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Two square (Fig. 17). Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.



13. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.

14. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.

15. Refer to Figure 18 to arrange and press the (8) assorted large leaves and (7) assorted small leaves onto (1) $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 72 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strip.

16. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) Block Three strip.

17. Repeat Steps 15-16 to make (3) Block Three strips total.



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18. Sew together (3) Block One squares and (3) Block Two squares, alternating them from top to bottom, to make Column One (Fig. 19).

19. Sew together (3) Block Two squares and (3) Block One squares, alternating them from top to bottom, to make Column Two (Fig. 19).

20. Sew together (1) Block Three strip, (1) 2" x 72 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric Q strip, Column One, (1) 2" x 72 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric Q strip, (1) Block Three strip, (1) 2" x 72 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric Q strip, Column Two, (1) 2" x 72 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric Q strip and (1) Block Three strip, lengthwise and in that order from left to right, to make the 54 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 72 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Center Block (Fig. 19).



Quilt Top Assembly


(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 21. Sew (1) (1) 2" x 72 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric Q strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 57 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric Q strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

22. Sew (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 75 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 69 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.


23. Layer and quilt as desired.

24. Sew the (8) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric Q strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

25. Bind as desired.
