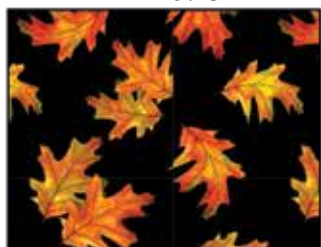

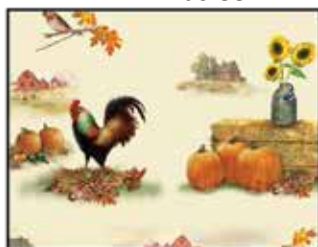

2 yards	Folio Basics - Wine (B)	7755-89*
1 1/8 yards	Tossed Leave and Bird - Cream (C)	269-44
2/3 yard	Continuous Block - Black (D)	275-99
1 3/8 yards	Tossed Leave - Black (E)	271-99
1/2 yard	Folio Basic - Brown (F)	7755-38
3/8 yard	Plaid - Gold (G)	268-33
3/8 yard	Folio Basic - Light Green (H)	7755-64
3/8 yard	Folio Basic - Dark Olive (I)	7755-65
2 1/3 yards	Floral - Gold (J)	273-33
7 1/4 yards	Scenic - Cream (Backing)	272-44

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Banner Panel 24 in - Black (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 22 1/2" x 42 1/2" rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Folio Basics - Wine (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 42 1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 2" x 25 1/2" WOF strips.
- (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 79" strips.
- (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 63 1/4" strips.
- (7) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) 1 1/4" x 10" strips.
- (10) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) 1 1/4" x 11 1/2" strips.
- (9) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Tossed Leave and Bird - Cream (C), cut:

- (3) 3 3/8" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 5/8" x 44 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 1/2" x 58 1/4" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 76" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 61 1/4" strips.

From the Continuous Block - Black (D):

- Fussy cut (14) 6 1/2" squares, each centered on a block.

From the Tossed Leave - Black (E), cut:

- (5) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) 3" x 6 1/2" strips.
- (10) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) 3" x 11 1/2" strips.

From the Folio Basic - Brown (F), cut:

- (4) 3 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (38) 3 1/4" squares.

From the Plaid - Gold (G), cut:

- (3) 3 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) 3 1/4" squares.

From the Folio Basic - Light Green (H), cut:

- (3) 3 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) 3 1/4" squares.

From the Folio Basic - Dark Olive (I), cut:

- (3) 3 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) 3 1/4" squares.

From the Floral - Gold (J), cut:

- (2) 8 1/2" x 81" LOF strips.
- (2) 8 1/2" x 79 1/4" WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Scenic - Cream (Backing), cut:

- (3) 87" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 87" x 105" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

- Sew (1) 2" x 42 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 1/2" x 42 1/2" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 25 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 24 1/2" x 44 1/2".**

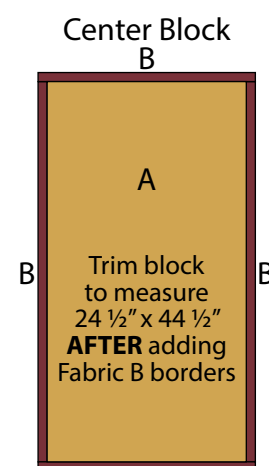

- Sew (1) 3" x 6 1/2" Fabric E strip to each side of (1) 6 1/2" Fabric D square. Sew (1) 3" x 11 1/2" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric D square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 2). **Trim the block to measure 10" x 10".** Repeat to make (14) Unit 1 squares total.

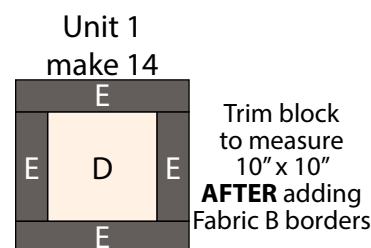


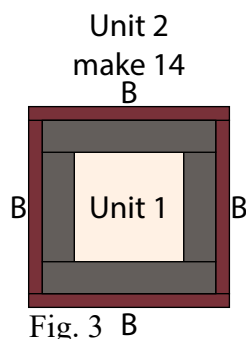

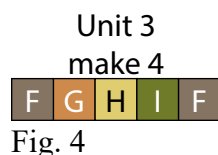

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3. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x 10" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $11\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (14) Unit 2 squares total.



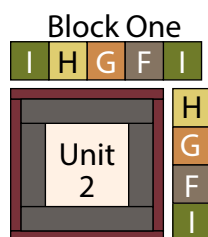
4. Sew together (1) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric F square, (1) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric G square, (1) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric H square, (1) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric I square and (1) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric F square, in that order from left to right, to make (1) Unit 3 strip (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (4) Unit 3 strips total.



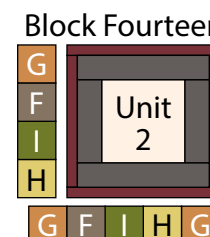
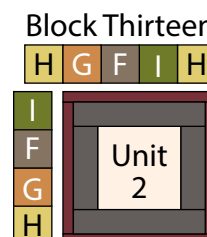
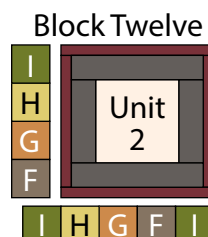
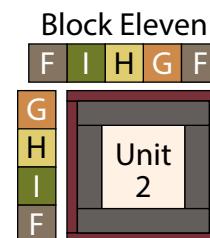
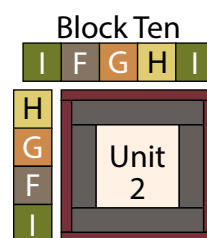
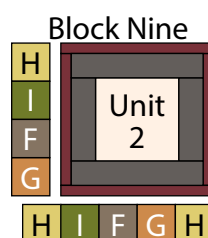
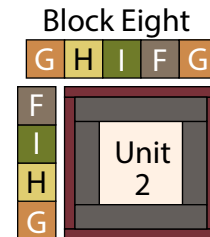
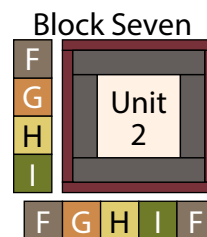
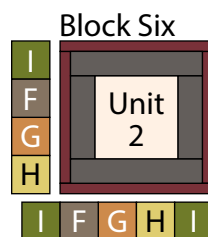
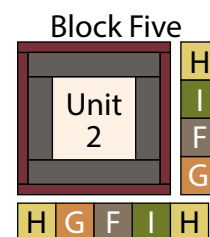
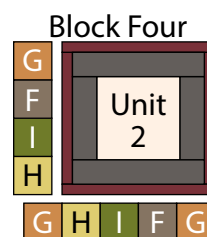
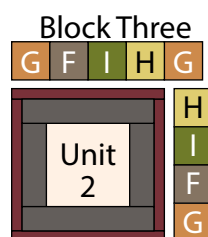
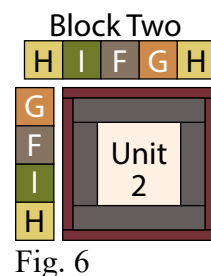
5. Sew together (1) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric I square, (1) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric H square, (1) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric G square, (1) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric F square and (1) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric I square, in that order from left to right, to make the top border (Fig. 5).

6. Sew together (1) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric H square, (1) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric G square, (1) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric F square and (1) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric I square, in that order from top to bottom, to make the right side border (Fig. 5).

7. Sew the top border from Step 5 and the right side border from Step 6 to the top and right sides of (1) Unit 2 square to make (1) $14\frac{1}{4}$ " Block One square (Fig. 5).



8. Repeat Steps 5-6 and refer to Figures 6-18 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (1) of each square, Block Two through Block Fourteen.



9. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Block Two Square, (1) Block Three square and (1) Unit 3 strip, in that order from top to bottom, to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 19).

10. Repeat Step 9 and refer to Figure 20-22 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the Right Side Border, Top Border and Bottom Border.

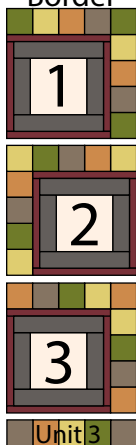

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

11. Sew (1) $3\frac{5}{8}$ " x $44\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block.

12. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and right sides of the Center Block.

13. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $58\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

14. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

15. Sew (1) 2" x 76" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $61\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

16. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 79" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $63\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

17. Sew (1) $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x 81" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $79\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

18. Layer and quilt as desired.

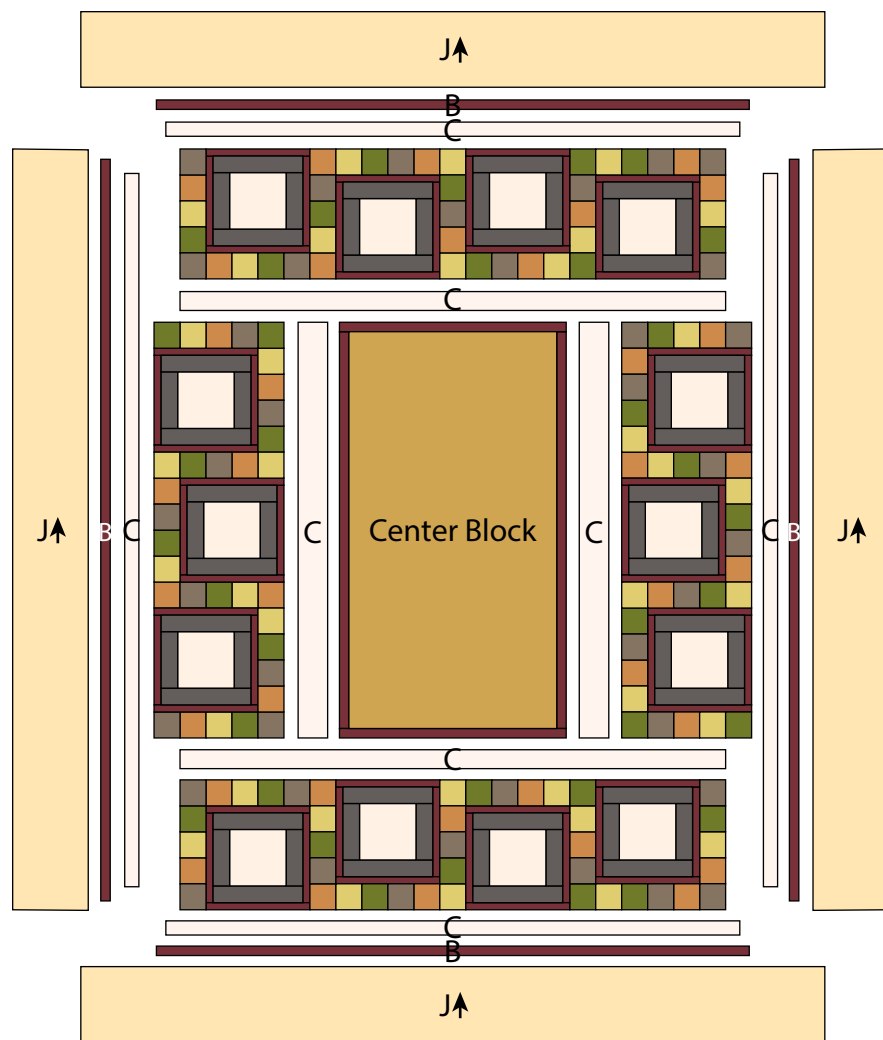
19. Sew the (9) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

20. Bind as desired.
