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#### **Materials**

1 panel	Banner Panel 24 in - Black (A)	276P-99
2 yards	Folio Basics - Wine (B)	7755-89*
1 ½ yards	Tossed Leave and Bird - Cream (C)	269-44
²⁄₃ yard	Continuous Block - Black (D)	275-99
1 3/8 yards	Tossed Leave - Black (E)	271-99
½ yard	Folio Basic - Brown (F)	7755-38
3/8 yard	Plaid - Gold (G)	268-33
3/8 yard	Folio Basic - Light Green (H)	7755-64
3/8 yard	Folio Basic - Dark Olive (I)	7755-65
2 <sup>1</sup> / <sub>3</sub> yards	Floral - Gold (J)	273-33
7 ½ yards	Scenic - Cream (Backing)	272-44

#### **Cutting Instructions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Banner Panel 24 in - Black (A):

• Fussy cut (1) 22 ½" x 42 ½" rectangle, centered on the panel.

#### From the Folio Basics - Wine (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 42 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 2" x 25 ½" WOF strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 79" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 63 ¼" strips.
- (7) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) 1 1/4" x 10" strips.
- (10) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 11 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.
- (9) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Tossed Leave and Bird - Cream (C), cut:

- (3) 3 5/8" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 5/8" x 44 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 58 ¼" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 76" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 61 1/4" strips.

#### From the Continuous Block - Black (D):

• Fussy cut (14) 6 ½" squares, each centered on a block.

#### From the Tossed Leave - Black (E), cut:

- (5) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) 3" x 6 ½" strips.
- (10) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) 3" x 11 ½" strips.

#### From the Folio Basic - Brown (F), cut:

• (4) 3 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (38) 3 1/4" squares.

#### From the Plaid - Gold (G), cut:

• (3) 3 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) 3 1/4" squares.

#### From the Folio Basic - Light Green (H), cut:

• (3) 3 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) 3 1/4" squares.

#### From the Folio Basic - Dark Olive (I), cut:

• (3) 3 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) 3 1/4" squares.

#### From the Floral - Gold (J), cut:

- (2) 8 ½" x 81" LOF strips.
- (2) 8 ½" x 79 ¼" WOF strips, piece as needed.

#### From the Scenic - Cream (Backing), cut:

• (3) 87" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 87" x 105" back.

#### **Block Assembly**

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a '4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 42 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 ½" x 42 ½" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 25 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 24** ½" x 44 ½".



2. Sew (1) 3" x 6 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of (1) 6 ½" Fabric D square. Sew (1) 3" x 11 ½" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric D square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 2). **Trim the block to measure 10" x 10".** Repeat to make (14) Unit 1 squares total.



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3. Sew (1) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 10" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 11 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (14) Unit 2 squares total.





4. Sew together (1) 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" Fabric F square, (1) 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" Fabric G square, (1) 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" Fabric H square, (1) 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" Fabric I square and (1) 3 1/4" Fabric F square, in that order from left to right, to make (1) Unit 3 strip (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (4) Unit 3 strips total.



- 5. Sew together (1) 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" Fabric I square, (1) 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" Fabric H square, (1) 3 1/4" Fabric G square, (1) 3 1/4" Fabric F square and (1) 3 1/4" Fabric I square, in that order from left to right, to make the top border (Fig.5).
- 6. Sew together (1) 3 1/4" Fabric H square, (1) 3 1/4" Fabric G square, (1) 3 1/4" Fabric F square and (1) 3 1/4" Fabric I square, in that order from top to bottom, to make the right side border (Fig. 5).
- 7. Sew the top border from Step 5 and the right side border from Step 6 to the top and right sides of (1) Unit 2 square to make (1) 14 1/4" Block One square (Fig. 5).



8. Repeat Steps 5-6 and refer to Figures 6-18 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (1) of each square, Block Two through Block Fourteen.





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- 9. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Block Two Square, (1) Block Three square and (1) Unit 3 strip, in that order from top to bottom, to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 19).
- 10. Repeat Step 9 and refer to Figure 20-22 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the Right Side Border, Top Border and Bottom Border.








#### **Quilt Top Assembly**

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
11. Sew (1) 3 5/8" x 44 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block.

- 12. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and right sides of the Center Block.
- 13. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 58 ¼" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 14. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 15. Sew (1) 2" x 76" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 61 1/4" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 16. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 79" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 63 ¼" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 17. Sew (1) 8 ½" x 81" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 8 ½" x 79 ¼" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 18. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 19. Sew the (9) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 20. Bind as desired.
