## Materials

1 panel Banner Panel - Black (A)
$2 / 3$ yard Plaid Scroll - Butter (B)
$1 / 4$ yard Leaves - Burgundy (C)
$1 / 4$ yard Tile - Pumpkin (D)
$1 / 4$ yard Plaid Scroll - Green (E)
$1 / 4$ yard Leaves - Forest (F)
$1 / 4$ yard Tile - Butter (G)
$1 / 4$ yard Paisley - Butter (H)
$1 / 4$ yard Plaid Scroll - Pumpkin (I)
$1 / 4$ yard Tile - Green (J)
$1 / 4$ yard Paisley - Black (K)
$1 / 4$ yard Flowers - Black (L)
$1 / 4$ yard Folio - Red (M)
$11 / 4$ yards Folio - Black (N)
2 yards Border Stripe - Cream (O)
3 yards Pumpkin Patch - Black (Backing)

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Banner Panel - Black (A):

- Fussy cut (1) $201 / 2 " \times 40 "$ panel.

From the Plaid Scroll - Butter (B), cut:

- (2) 3 " $\times 40$ " WOF strips.
- (2) $31 / 2 " \times 25^{1 / 2 "}$ WOF strips.
- (1) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Leaves - Burgundy (C), cut:
-(1) $41 / 2$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4)
(4) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Tile - Pumpkin (D), cut:

- (1) $41 / 2 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Plaid Scroll - Green (E), cut:

- (1) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Leaves - Forest (F), cut:

- (1) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $41 / 2 "$ squares.


## From the Tile - Butter (G), cut:

-(1) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

## From the Paisley - Butter (H), cut:

- (1) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Plaid Scroll - Pumpkin (I), cut:

- (1) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Tile - Green (J), cut:
-(1) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Paisley - Black (K), cut:

- (1) $41 / 2 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Flowers - Black (L), cut:

- (1) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Folio - Red (M), cut:

- (3) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 521 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $11 / 2 " \times 341 / 2 "$ WOF strips.

From the Folio - Black (N), cut:

- (10) $21 / 2 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (152) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
-(6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Border Stripe - Cream (O), fussy cut:
- (2) 6 " $\times 69$ " Length of Fabric (LOF) strips, each centered on the wide strip of leaves.
- (2) 6 " $\times 49$ " LOF strips, each centered on the wide strip of leaves.

From the Pumpkin Patch - Black (Backing), cut:

- (2) 53 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 53 " x 73 " back.


## Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) 3 " $\times 40$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the $201 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 40$ " Fabric A panel. Sew (1) $31 / 2 " \times 251 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure $241 / 2 " \times 441 / 2$ " to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).
2. Place (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric N square on the top left corner of (1) $41 / 2$ " Fabric B square, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2).). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn seam. Flip open the

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3. Follow Figure 4 for the seam direction to add a $21 / 2$ " Fabric N square to each of the remaining corners of the $41 / 2$ " Fabric B square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 5).
4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (4)

Unit 1 squares total.

(4) Unit 2 squares, (4) Unit 3 squares,
(4) Unit 4 squares,
(2) Unit 5 squares,
(4) Unit 6 squares,
(4) Unit 7 squares,
(4) Unit 8 squares, (3) Unit 9 squares,
(3) Unit 10 squares and (2) Unit 11 squares.

Quilt Top Assembly
(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
6. Follow Figure 16 below and sew together (8) assorted units to make the Top Border.
7. Follow Figure 17 below and sew together (8) assorted units to make the Bottom Border.
8. Follow Figure 18 below and sew together (11) assorted units to make the Left Side Border.
9. Follow Figure 19 below and sew together (11) assorted units to make the Right Side Border.

10. Sew the Left, Right, Top and Bottom Borders to the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 521 / 2 "$ Fabric M strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 341 / 2 "$ Fabric M strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
12. Center (1) 6 " x 69 " Fabric O strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $1 / 4$ " from the top edge of the block and stop a $1 / 4$ " from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.

16. Sew the (6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric $N$ strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and
15. Layer and quilt as desired. press.
17. Bind as desired.

14. Starting at the sewn seam Figure 20), draw a 45 -degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4$ " the excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4$
seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the quilt top.

13. Repeat Step 12 to sew (1) 6" $\times 49$ " Fabric O strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start $1 / 4 "$ away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 20).
4. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in
