1 panel Autumn Banner Panel - Cream (A) 2517P-33
$5 / 8$ yard Folio - Sepia Brown (B) 7755-39
1 yard Patterned Leaves - Black (C) 2521-99
$7 / 8$ yard Blocks - Red (D) 2519-88
$3 / 4$ yard Circle Dots - Green (E) 2520-66*
$5 / 8$ yard Folio - Tan (F) 7755-46
1/4 yard Circle Dots - Pumpkin (G) 2520-35
$3 / 8$ yard Paisley - Black $(\mathrm{H}) \quad$ 2523-99
$1 / 4$ yard Folio - Wine (I) 7755-89
$3 / 8$ yard $\quad$ Stripe - Red (J) 2525-88
$13 / 8$ yards Autumn Floral - Black (K) 2524-99
5 yards Tossed Leaves - Black (Backing) 2522-99
*Includes binding

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

## From the Autumn Banner Panel - Cream (A):

- Fussy cut (1) $23 " \times 421 / 2 "$ panel, centered on the panel.

From the Folio - Sepia Brown (B), cut:
-(2) $2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ WOF strips, piece as needed.

- (2) 2 " x $26 "$ WOF strips.
- (3) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 521 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 361 / 2 "$ WOF strips.

From the Patterned Leaves - Black (C), cut:
-(3) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 441 / 2 "$ strips.
-(2) $41 / 2 " \times 341 / 2 "$ WOF strips.

## From the Blocks - Red (D):

-Fussy cut (17) $61 / 2 "$ squares, each centered on a design.

## From the Circle Dots - Green (E), cut:

- (1) $27 / 8 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $27 / 8 "$ squares.
-(1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
-(7) $21 / 2>x$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Folio - Tan (F), cut:
- (3) $27 / 8 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (34) $27 / 8 "$ squares.
-(2) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (17) $21 / 2 "$ squares and (14) $2 "$ squares.
- (1) $2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (20) $2 "$ squares.


## From the Circle Dots - Pumpkin (G), cut:

- (1) $27 / 8 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $27 / 8 "$ squares.
- (1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Paisley - Black (H), cut:

- (1) $27 / 8 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) $27 / 8 "$ squares.
- (2) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Folio - Wine (I), cut:

- (1) $27 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $27 / 8 "$ squares.
- (1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Stripe - Red (J), cut:
-(4) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 66 \frac{1}{2} "$ strips.

- (3) $11 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 501 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Autumn Floral - Black (K), cut:
-(4) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $51 / 2 " \times 681 / 2 "$ strips.

- (3) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 60 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strips.

From the Tossed Leaves - Black (Backing), cut:

- (2) 86 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $68^{\prime \prime} \times 86^{\prime \prime}$ back.


## Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) $2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the $23 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric A panel. Sew (1) $2 " \times 26 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure $241 / 2 "$ x $441 / 2 "$ to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

2. Place (1) $27 / 8$ " Fabric E square on top of (1) $27 / 8$ "

Fabric $F$ square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 2). Sew $1 / 4 "$ away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 3) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure $21 / 2 "$ square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (16) Unit 1 squares total.


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8. Sew (2) Unit 1 squares and (1) $21 / 2$ " Fabric F square together in that order left to right to make the top row. Sew (2) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric E squares and (1) Unit 1 square together in that order left to right to make the middle row. Sew (1) Unit 5 square, (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric E square and (1) Unit 1 square together in that order to make the bottom row. Sew the (3) rows together to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 15). Repeat to make (4) Block One squares total.
9. Repeat Step 8 and refer to Figures 16-18 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (4) Block Two squares, (5) Block Three squares and (4) Block Four squares.

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 10. Sew (1) $51 / 2 " \times 441 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 341 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 521 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 361 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
12. Sew together (1) Block Three square, (1) $61 / 2$ " Fabric D square, (1) Block Four square, (1) $61 / 2 "$ Fabric D square, (1) Block Two square, (1) $61 / 2 "$ Fabric D square, (1) Block Three square, (1) $61 / 2 "$ Fabric D square and (1) Block One square, in that order from top to bottom, to make the Left Side Border. Sew the Left Side Border to the left side of the Center Block.

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13. Repeat Step 12 and refer to the quilt layout for component identification, placement and orientation to make the Right Side Border, Top Border and Bottom Border. Sew the Right Side Border to the right side of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
14. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 661 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 501 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
15. Sew (1) $51 / 2 " \times 681 / 2 "$ Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $5^{1 / 2 "} \times 601 / 2 "$ Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
16. Layer and quilt as desired.
17. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
18. Bind as desired.
