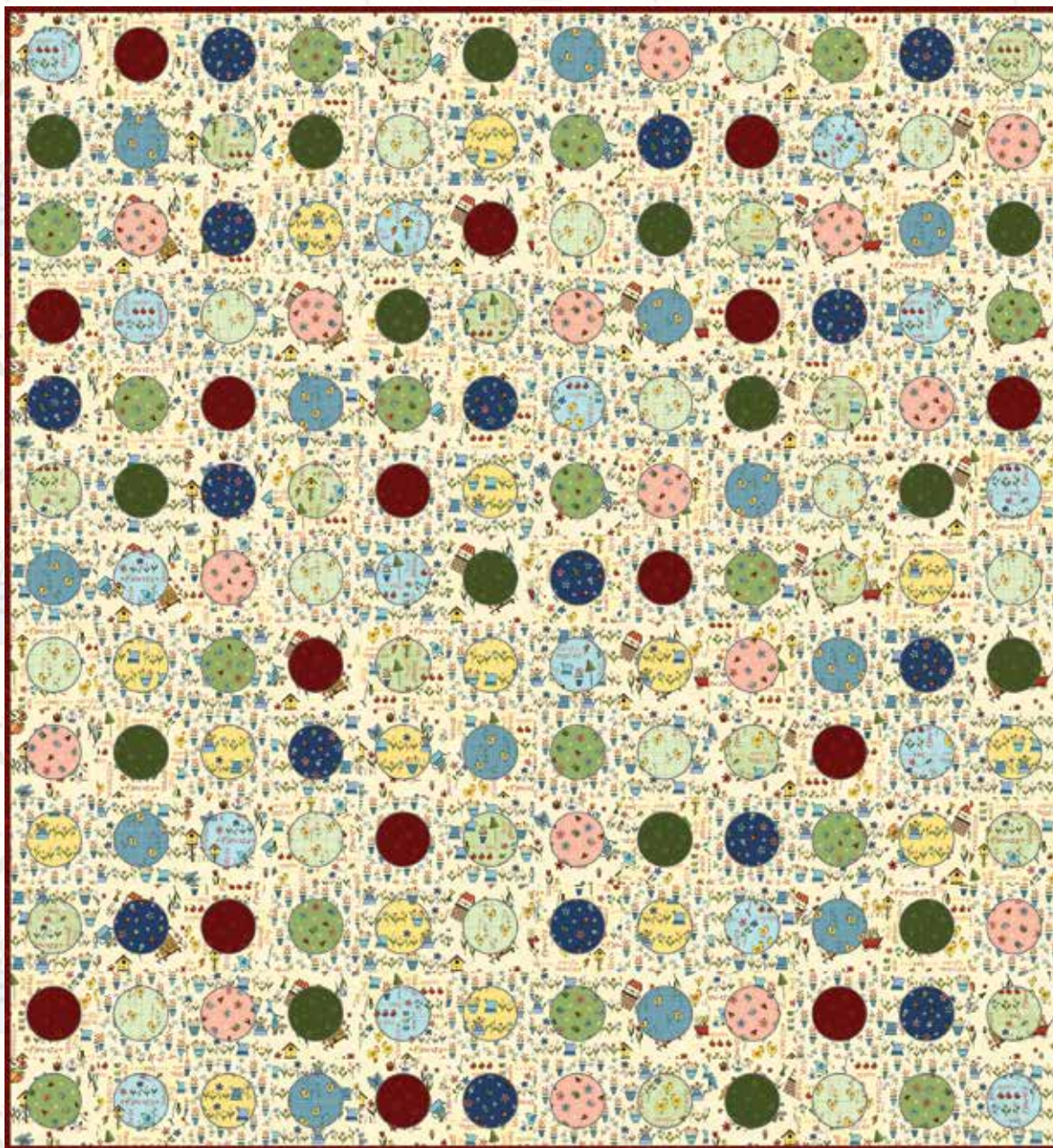

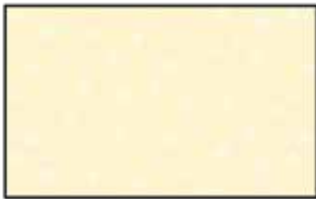

¼ yard	Gail Flower Basic - Green (J)	2591-66
¾ yard	Gail Flower Basic - Red (K)	2591-88*
¼ yard	Chicken - Light Blue (L)	2592-17
¼ yard	Chicken - Green (M)	2592-66
¾ yard	Watering Can - Cream (N)	2593-33

### You will also need:

- Fusible web

### Cutting Instructions

*Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.*

#### From the Allover Novelty - Cream (A):

- Fussy cut (5) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (39) 4 ½" squares.

#### From the Words - Light Blue (B), cut:

- See instructions to cut (16) Circles.

#### From the Words - Cream (C), cut:

- (5) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (39) 4 ½" squares.

#### From the Words - Green (D), cut:

- See instructions to cut (16) Circles.

#### From the Snails - Pink (E), cut:

- See instructions to cut (16) Circles.

#### From the Snails - Green (F), cut:

- See instructions to cut (16) Circles.

#### From the Snails - Navy (G), cut:

- See instructions to cut (16) Circles.

#### From the Flower Pots - Cream (H), cut:

- (5) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (39) 4 ½" squares.

#### From the Watering Cans - Yellow (I), cut:

- See instructions to cut (16) Circles.

#### From the Gail Flower Basic - Green (J), cut:

- See instructions to cut (16) Circles.

#### From the Gail Flower Basic - Red (K), cut:

- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.
- See instructions to cut (16) Circles.

#### From the Chicken - Light Blue (L), cut:

- See instructions to cut (13) Circles.

#### From the Chicken - Green (M), cut:

- See instructions to cut (15) Circles.

#### From the Watering Can - Cream (N), cut:

- (5) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (39) 4 ½" squares.

#### From the Words - Blue (Backing), cut:

- (2) 56" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 56" x 60" back.

### Block Assembly

- Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace (156) Circle templates onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed in the cutting instructions. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
- Press (1) Fabric B circle to the center of (1) 4 ½" Fabric A square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1).
- Finish the raw edges of the circle with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) Block One square.
- Repeat Steps 1-4 to make (3) Block One squares.
- Repeat Steps 1-4 and refer to Figures 2-40 for fabric identification to make a total of (156) assorted blocks.

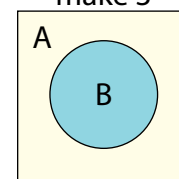

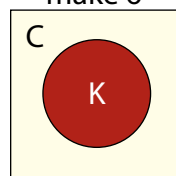

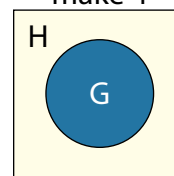

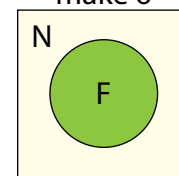

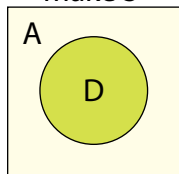

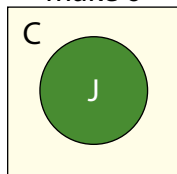

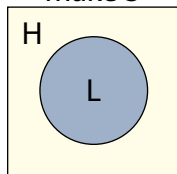

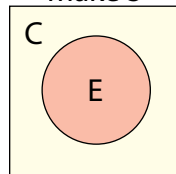

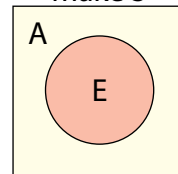

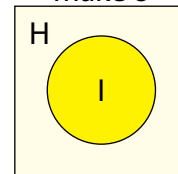

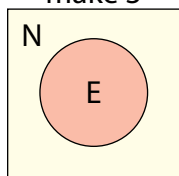

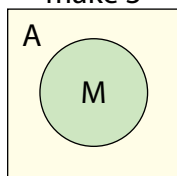

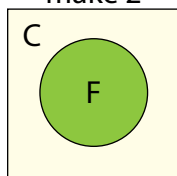

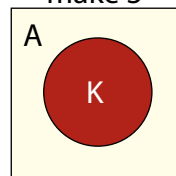

make 4

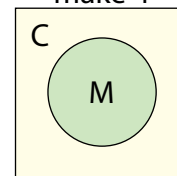

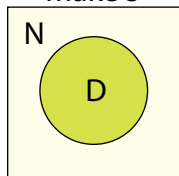

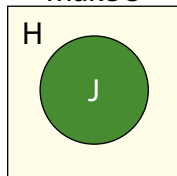

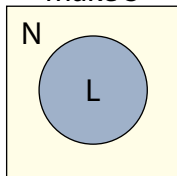

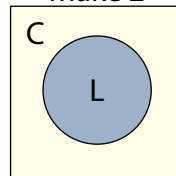

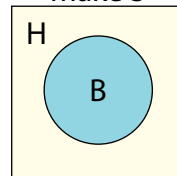

make 4

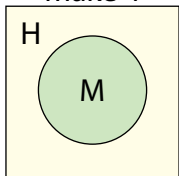

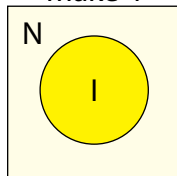

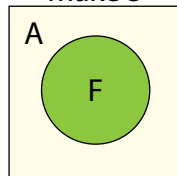

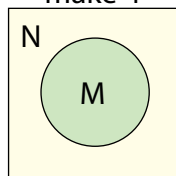

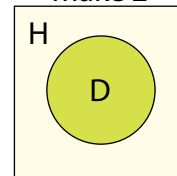

make 6

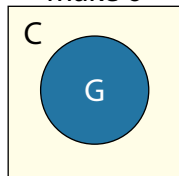

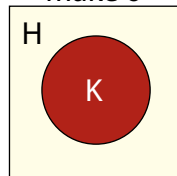

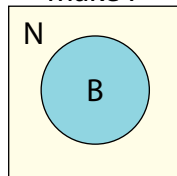

make 3

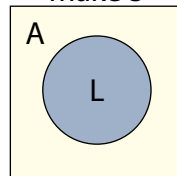

make 3

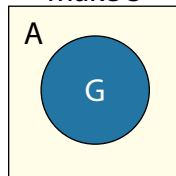

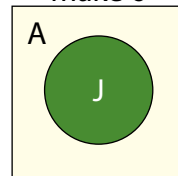

Block Thirty-Two make 4

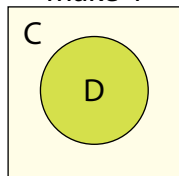

Block Thirty-Three make 3

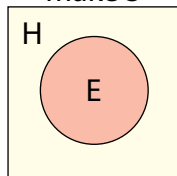

Block Thirty-Four make 1

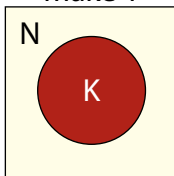

Block Thirty-Five make 1

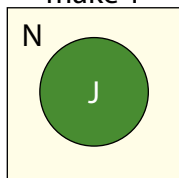

Block Thirty-Six make 3

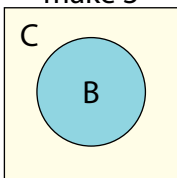

Block Thirty-Seven make 1

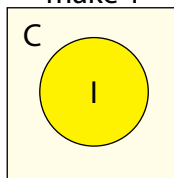

Block Thirty-Eight make 3

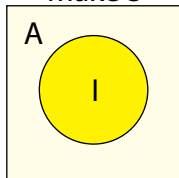

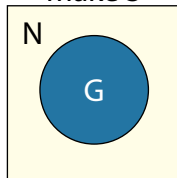

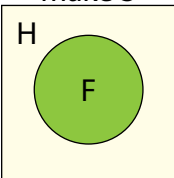

### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*

7. Refer to the Quilt Layout to arrange and sew together (12) assorted blocks to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Two through Row Thirteen.

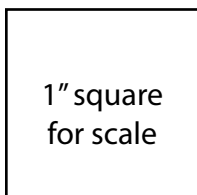
8. Sew the (13) Rows together to make the quilt top.

9. Layer and quilt as desired.

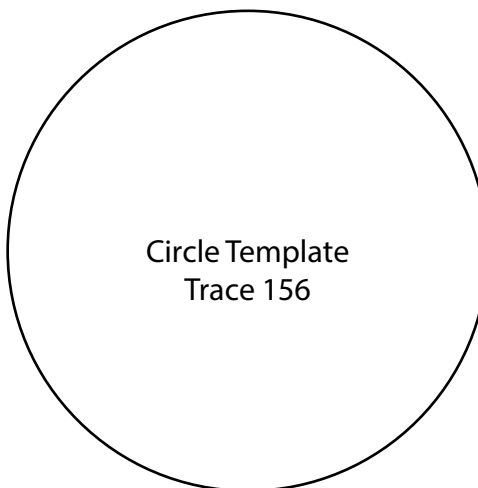
10. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric K strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

11. Bind as desired.
