Version #1 Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Main Floral - Pink (A), cut:

• (1) 20 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 20 1/8" square and (6) 6 1/2" squares.

From the Vine Stripe - Red (B), cut:

- (9) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.
- Fussy cut (4) 27" x 2" strips each centered on a vine.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (5) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Border Stripe - Teal (C), fussy cut:

- (4) Template 1 triangles, each center on matching designs.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 6 ½" squares.

From the Vine Stripe - Teal (D), fussy cut:

- (4) 40" x 2 ½" strips, each centered on a vine.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (3) 6 ½" squares.

Double Wreath - Pink (E), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 6 ½" squares.
- (7) 2 1/4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 2 1/4" x 68" strips.

From the Border Stripe - Red (F), fussy cut:

- (4) 4 ³/₄" x 76" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips, each centered on a red stripe.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 6 ½" squares.

From the Whole Cloth Abstract - Cream (G), fussy cut:

- (4) 8 ½" x 92" LOF strips each centered on matching designs.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (4) 6 ½" squares.

From the Fan Floral - Cream (H), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 6 ½" squares.

From the Fan Floral - Light Teal (I), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 6 ½" squares.

From the Palm and Coral - Red (J), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 6 ½" squares.

From the Diamond Foulard - Cream (K), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 ½" squares.

From the Vine Stripe - Cream (L), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 6 ½" squares.

From the Palm and Coral - Teal (M), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 6 ½" squares.

From the Main Floral - Teal (N), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 ½" squares.

From the Double Wreath - Light Teal (O), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 6 ½" squares.

From the Main Floral - Cream (P), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 6 ½" squares.

From the Border Stripe - Cream (Q), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 6 ½" squares.

From the Diamond Foulard - Teal (R), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 6 ½" squares.

From the Double Wreath - Cream (S), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 6 ½" squares.

From the Main Floral - Cream (Backing), cut:


• (3) 96" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 96" x 96" back.

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
Version #1 Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

- 1. Center (1) 2" x 27" Fabric B strip on (1) side of the 20 1/8" Fabric A square and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a 1/4" from the top edge of the block and stop a 1/4" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.
- 2. Repeat Step 1 to sew (1)
 2" x 27" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square, making sure to stop and start 1/4" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Fabric A square on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 1).



3. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 1), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a ¼" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 2).



4. Sew (1) Fabric C Template 1 triangle to each of the (4) sides of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 3). The unit should measure 32 ½" x 32 ½".





5. Repeat Steps 1-3 and refer to Figure 4 to add the 2 ½" x 40" Fabric D strips to the sides, top and bottom of the Unit 2 square to make the Center Block (Fig. 4). The Center Block should measure 36 ½" x 36 ½".



- 6. Follow Figure 5 and sew together (12) assorted $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares into a 2 x 6 matrix to make the Left Side Border (Version #1).
- 7. Repeat Step 6 and refer to Figures 6-8 for fabric identification, location and orientation to make the Right Side (Version #1), Top Border (Version #1) and Bottom Border (Version #1).

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Version #1 Quilt Top Assembly (Follow the Quilt Layout (Version #1) in Figure 9 while assembling the quilt top.)

- 8. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and right sides of the Center Block.
- 9. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 10. Repeat Steps 1-3 while using (4) 2 ½" x 68" Fabric E strips to add the Fabric E border.
- 11. Repeat Steps 1-3 while using (4) 4 ³/₄" x 76" Fabric F strips to add the Fabric F border.

- 12. Repeat Steps 1-3 while using (4) 8 ½" x 92" Fabric G strips to add the Fabric 6 border to make the quilt top.
- 13. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 14. Sew the (9) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 15. Bind as desired.

Quilt Layout (Version #1)



Version #2 Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Main Floral - Cream (A), cut:

• 20 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 20 1/8" square and (6) 6 1/2" squares.

From the Vine Stripe - Cream (B), fussy cut:

- (4) 27" x 2" strips, each centered on a vine.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (5) 6 ½" squares.

From the Border Stripe - Red (C), fussy cut:

- (4) Template 1 triangles, each center on matching designs.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 6 ½" squares.

From the Vine Stripe - Red (D), cut:

- (9) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.
- Fussy cut (4) 40" x 2 ½" strips, each centered on a vine.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (3) 6 ½" squares.

From the Double Wreath - Pink (E), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 6 ½" squares.
- (7) 2 1/4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 2 1/4" x 68" strips.

From the Whole Cloth Abstract - Cream (F), fussy cut:

- (4) 4 ³/₄" x 76" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips, each centered on a red stripe.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 6 ½" squares.

From the Border Stripe - Cream (G), fussy cut:

- (4) 8 ½" x 92" LOF strips each centered on matching designs.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (4) 6 ½" squares.

From the Fan Floral - Cream (H), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 6 ½" squares.

From the Fan Floral - Light Teal (I), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 6 ½" squares.

From the Palm and Coral - Red (J), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 6 ½" squares.

From the Diamond Foulard - Cream (K), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 ½" squares.

From the Vine Stripe - Teal (L), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 6 ½" squares.

From the Palm and Coral - Teal (M), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 6 ½" squares.

From the Main Floral - Teal (N), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 ½" squares.

From the Double Wreath - Light Teal (O), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 6 ½" squares.

From the Main Floral - Pink (P), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 6 ½" squares.

From the Border Stripe - Teal (Q), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 6 ½" squares.

From the Diamond Foulard - Teal (R), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 6 ½" squares.

From the Double Wreath - Cream (S), cut:

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 6 ½" squares.

From the Main Floral - Cream (Backing), cut:

• (3) 96" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 96" x 96" back.

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Version #2 Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

16. Center (1) 2" x 27" Fabric B strip on (1) side of the 20 1/8" Fabric A square and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a 1/4" from the top edge of the block and stop a 1/4" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.

17. Repeat Step 16 to sew (1) 2" x 27" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square, making sure to stop and start 1/4" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Fabric A square on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 10).




18. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 10), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 11).



19. Sew (1) Fabric C Template 1 triangle to each of the (4) sides of the Unit 3 square to make (1) Unit 4 square (Fig. 12). The square should measure 32 ½" x 32 ½".







20. Repeat Steps 16-18 and refer to Figure 13 to add the 2 ½" x 40" Fabric D strips to the sides, top and bottom of the Unit 4 square to make the Center Block. The Center Block should measure 36 ½" x 36 ½".



21. Follow Figure 14 and sew together (12) assorted 6 ½" squares into a 2 x 6 matrix to make the Left Side Border (Version #2).

22. Repeat Step 21 and refer to Figures 15-17 for fabric identification. location and orientation to make the Version 2's of the Right Side, Top and Bottom Borders.

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Version #2 Quilt Top Assembly (Follow the Quilt Layout (Version #2) in Figure 18 while assembling the quilt top.)

- 23. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and right sides of the Center Block.
- 24. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 25. Repeat Steps 1-3 while using (4) 2 ½" x 68" Fabric E strips to add the Fabric E border.
- 26. Repeat Steps 1-3 while using (4) 4 ³/₄" x 76" Fabric F strips to add the Fabric F border.

- 27. Repeat Steps 1-3 while using (4) 8 ½" x 92" Fabric G strips to add the Fabric 6 border to make the quilt top.
- 28. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 29. Sew the (9) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 30. Bind as desired.



