Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Main Floral - Pink (A), cut:

• (2) 14 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 14 ½" squares.

From the Main Floral - Cream (B), cut:

- (2) 14 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 14 ½" squares.
- Fussy cut (16) Template 1 octagons, each centered on a bouquet.

From the Main Floral - Teal (C), cut:

• (1) 14 ½" square.

From the Vine Stripe - Teal (D), cut:

- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.
- Fussy cut (32) 10 ½" x 2 ½" strips, each centered on a vine.
- (32) Template 2 diamonds.

From the Vine Stripe - Red (E), cut:

- Fussy cut (16) 10 ½" x 2 ½" strips, each centered on a vine.
- (24) Template 2 diamonds.

From the Vine Stripe - Cream (F), cut:

- Fussy cut (16) 10 ½" x 2 ½" strips, each centered on a vine.
- (32) Template 2 diamonds.

From the Double Wreath - Pink (G), cut:

• (5) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (128) 1 ½" squares.

From the Double Wreath - Light Teal (H), cut:

- (5) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (128) 1 ½" squares.
- (16) Template 2 diamonds.

From the Border Stripe - Teal (I), fussy cut:

- (12) Template 9 side triangles each centered on similar flowers.
- (8) Template 8 corner triangles each centered on same design.

From the Whole Cloth Abstract - Cream (J), cut:

- (64) Template 3 triangles.
- (28) Template 4 triangles.
- (84) Template 5 triangles.

From the Palm and Coral - Red (K), cut:

- (32) Template 3 triangles.
- (32) Template 6 rectangles.
- (32) Template 7 squares.

From the Diamond Foulard - Cream (L), cut:

- (8) Template 3 triangles.
- (12) Template 4 triangles.
- (36) Template 5 triangles.

From the Fan Floral - Cream (M), cut:

- (56) Template 3 triangles.
- (16) Template 4 triangles.
- (48) Template 5 triangles.

From the Diamond Foulard - Teal (N), cut:

- (16) Template 3 triangles.
- (16) Template 6 rectangles.
- (16) Template 7 squares.

From the Palm and Coral - Teal (O), cut:

- (16) Template 3 triangles.
- (16) Template 6 rectangles.
- (16) Template 7 squares.

From the Fan Floral - Light Teal (P), cut:

• (24) Template 2 diamonds.

From the Double Wreath - Cream (Q), cut:

- (8) Template 4 triangles.
- (24) Template 5 triangles.

From the Main Floral - Teal (Backing), cut:

• (3) 88" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 88" x 88" back.



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
Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

- 1. Refer to Figure 1 and sew together (2) Fabric F Template 2 diamonds to make (1) Unit 1 segment (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (4) Unit 1 segments total.
- 2. Sew together (2) Unit 1 segments to make (1) Unit 2 segment (Fig. 2). Repeat to make a second Unit 2 segment.



- 3. Sew together the (2) Unit 2 segments to make (1) Unit 3 segment, which should have a octagonal hole in the center (Fig. 3).
- 4. Sew (1) Fabric B Template 1 octagon in the center of the Unit 3 segment to make (1) Unit 4 star (Fig. 4).



5. Follow Figure 5 and sew together (1) Fabric K Template 3 triangle and (1) Fabric J Template 3 triangle to make (1) Unit 5 square. Repeat to make (4) Unit 5 squares total.



6. Follow Figure 6 and sew together (4) Unit 5 squares, (4) Fabric J Template 3 triangles and the Unit 4 star to make (1) Unit 6 square.




- 7. Follow Figure 7 and sew together (1) Fabric K Template 6 rectangle, (2) Fabric L Template 5 triangles, (1) Fabric K Template 7 square and (1) Fabric L Template 4 triangle to make (1) Unit 7 segment. Repeat to make (4) Unit 7 segments total.
- 8. Sew (1) Fabric L Template 5 triangle to each end of (1) Unit 7 segment, along the Fabric K Template 6 ends to make (1) Unit 8 triangle (Fig. 8). Repeat to make a second Unit 8 triangle.



9. Follow Figure 9 and sew (1) Unit 7 segment to each side of the Unit 6 square. Sew (1) Unit 8 segment to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 6 square to make (1) Unit 9 square. The unit should measure 10 ½" x 10 ½".





10. Sew (1) 1 ½" Fabric G square to the left side of (1) 1 ½" Fabric H square to make the top row. Sew (1) 1 ½" Fabric H square to the left side of (1) 1 ½" Fabric G square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) 2 ½" Unit 10 square (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (4) Unit 10 squares total.



- 11. Sew (1) Unit 10 square to each end of (1) 2 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric D strip to make the top row (Fig. 11).
- 12. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Unit 9 square to make the middle row (Fig. 11).
- 13. Sew (1) Unit 10 square to each end of (1) 2 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric E strip to make the bottom row (Fig. 11).
- 14. Sew together the (3) rows from Steps 11-13 lengthwise to make (1) 14 ½" Block One square (Fig. 11).



15. Repeat Steps 1-14 and refer to Figures 12-26 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (1) of each block square for Block Two through Block Sixteen.







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

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
Quilt Top Assembly


(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
16. Sew (1) Fabric I Template 9 triangle to each side of the Block One square. Sew (2) Fabric I Template 8 triangles to the top of the Block One square to make Row One.


- 17. Sew together (1) Fabric I Template 9 triangle, (1) Block Two square, (1) 14 ½" Fabric A square, (1) Block Three square and (1) Fabric I Template 9 triangle, in that order from left to right, to make Row Two.
- 18. Repeat Steps 16-17 and refer to the quilt layout for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Three through Row Seven.

- 19. Sew together the (7) Rows from Steps 16-18, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the quilt top.
- 20. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 21. Sew the (8) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 22. Bind as desired.

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
