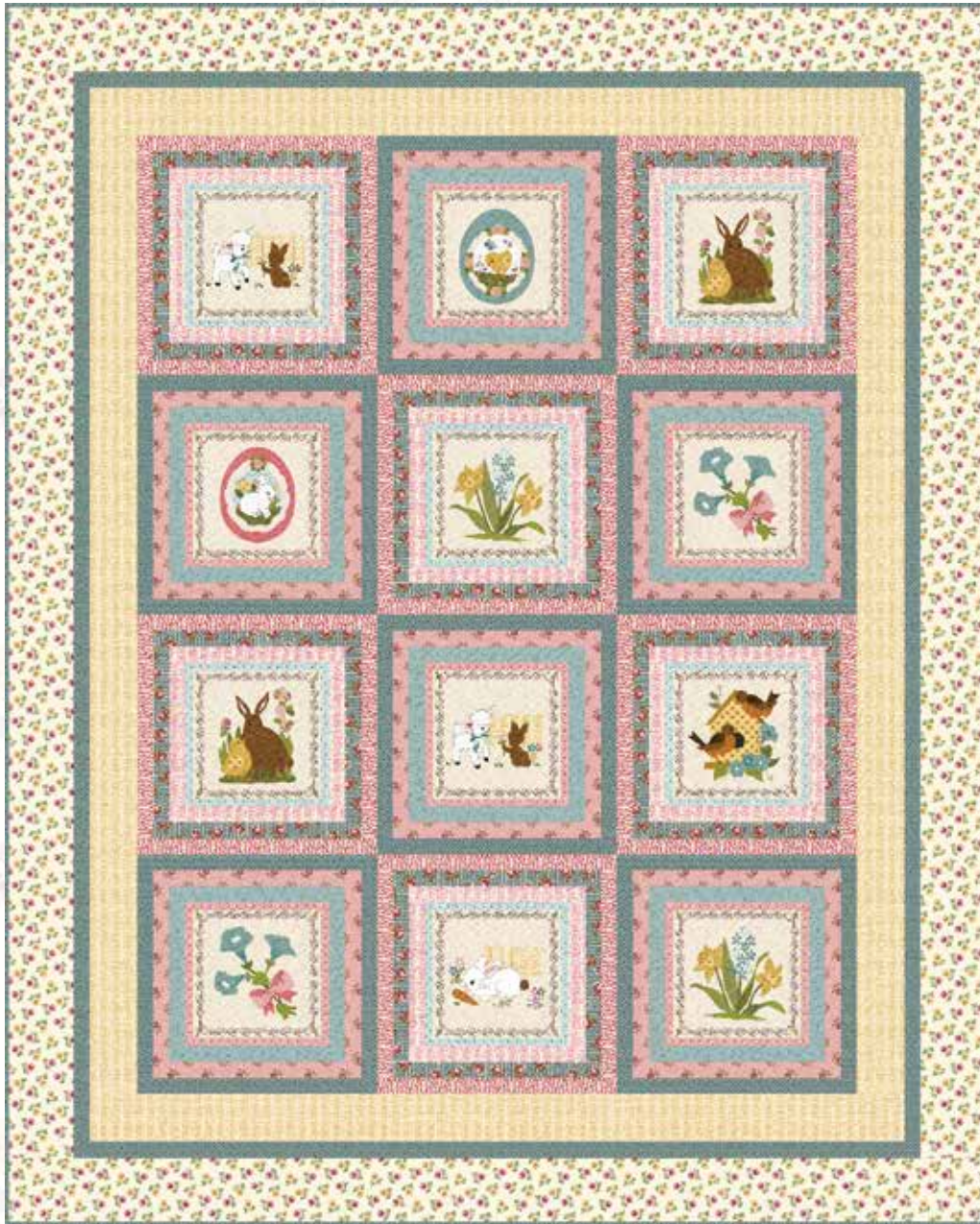

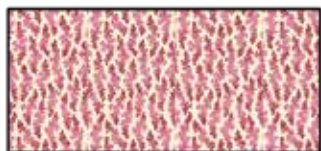

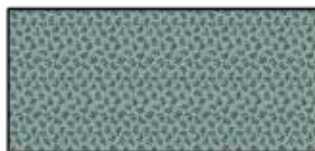

1 yard (0.92m)	Small Blocks - Multi (A)	1176-44
$\frac{3}{8}$ yard (0.35m)	Tiny Geometric - Blue (B)	1174-11
$\frac{3}{8}$ yard (0.35m)	Tossed Tiny Bunnies - Pink (C)	1168-22
$\frac{1}{2}$ yard (0.46m)	Stylized Tulip - Blue (D)	1171-11
$\frac{1}{2}$ yard (0.46m)	Geometric - Pink (E)	1172-02
$\frac{3}{8}$ yard (0.35m)	Tiny Geometric - Pink (F)	1174-22
$\frac{3}{8}$ yard (0.35m)	Timeless Linens Basics - Soft Blue (G)	1027-111
$\frac{1}{2}$ yard (0.46m)	Stylized Tulip - Pink (H)	1171-22
1 $\frac{3}{8}$ yards (1.26m)	Ditsy - Blue (I)	1173-11*
$\frac{7}{8}$ yard (0.81m)	Tossed Tiny Bunnies - Yellow (J)	1168-44
1 $\frac{1}{8}$ yards (1.03m)	Daisy - Multi (K)	1175-42
4 yards (3.66m)	Medium Floral - Pink (Backing)	1170-22

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Small Blocks - Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (12) 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares centered on blocks.

From the Tiny Geometric - Blue (B), cut:

- (3) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (3) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Tossed Tiny Bunnies - Pink (C), cut:

- (4) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (3) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Stylized Tulip - Blue (D), cut:

- (4) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (4) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Geometric - Pink (E), cut:

- (6) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (4) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Tiny Geometric - Pink (F), cut:

- (3) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (3) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Timeless Linens - Soft Blue (G), cut:

- (4) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (3) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Stylized Tulip - Pink (H), cut:

- (4) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (4) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Ditsy - Blue (I), cut:

- (6) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (4) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (4) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 66 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (3) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 53 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (7) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Tossed Tiny Bunnies - Yellow (J), cut:

- (3) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 60 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (3) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Daisy - Multi (K), cut:

- (4) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 68 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (4) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 61 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Medium Floral - Pink (Backing), cut:

- (2) 69" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 69" x 84" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). **Trim the unit to measure 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".** Repeat to make (6) Unit 1 squares total.

2. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to each side of (1) 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 2). **Trim the unit to measure 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".** Repeat to make (6) Unit 2 squares total.

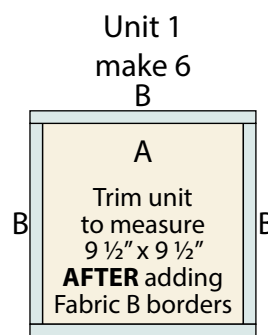

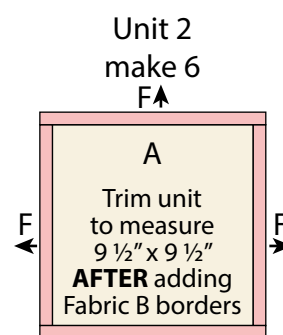

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3. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $11\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (6) Unit 3 squares total.

4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Figure 4 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (6) Unit 4 squares.

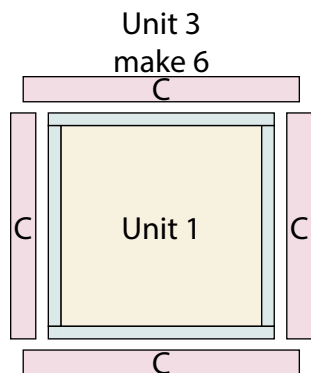

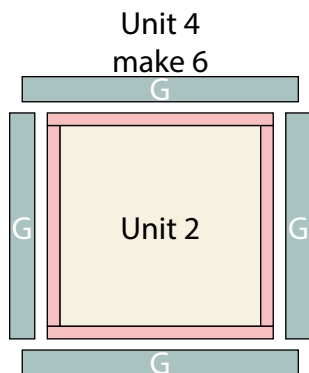

5. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $11\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of (1) Unit 3 square. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $13\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 3 square to make (1) Unit 5 square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (6) Block 5 squares total.

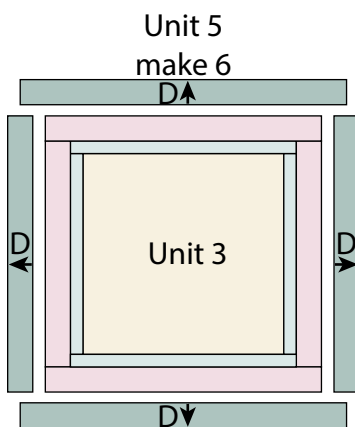

6. Repeat Step 5 and refer to Figure 6 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (6) Unit 6 squares.

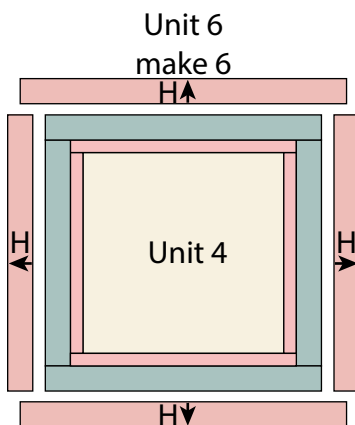

7. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $13\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to each side of (1) Unit 5 square. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $15\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 5 square to make (1) $15\frac{1}{2}$ " Block One square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.

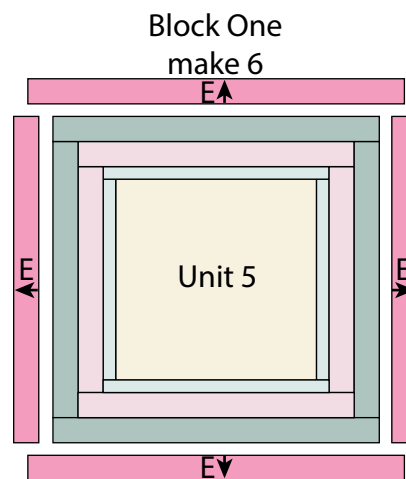

8. Repeat Step 7 and refer to Figure 8 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (6) Block Two squares.

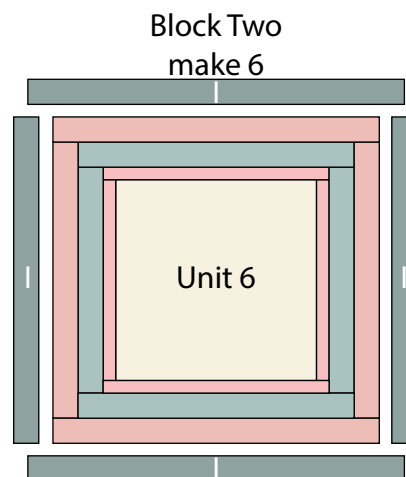

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9. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two square to make Row One (Fig. 9). Repeat to make Row Three.

10. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) Block One square to make Row Two (Fig. 9). Repeat to make Row Four.

11. Sew together the (4) pieced rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from the top to the bottom, to make the 45 1/2" x 60 1/2" Center Block (Fig. 9).

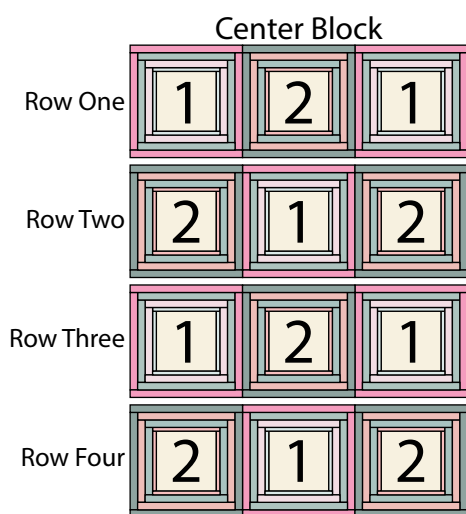

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

12. Sew (1) 3 1/2" x 60 1/2" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3 1/2" x 51 1/2" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

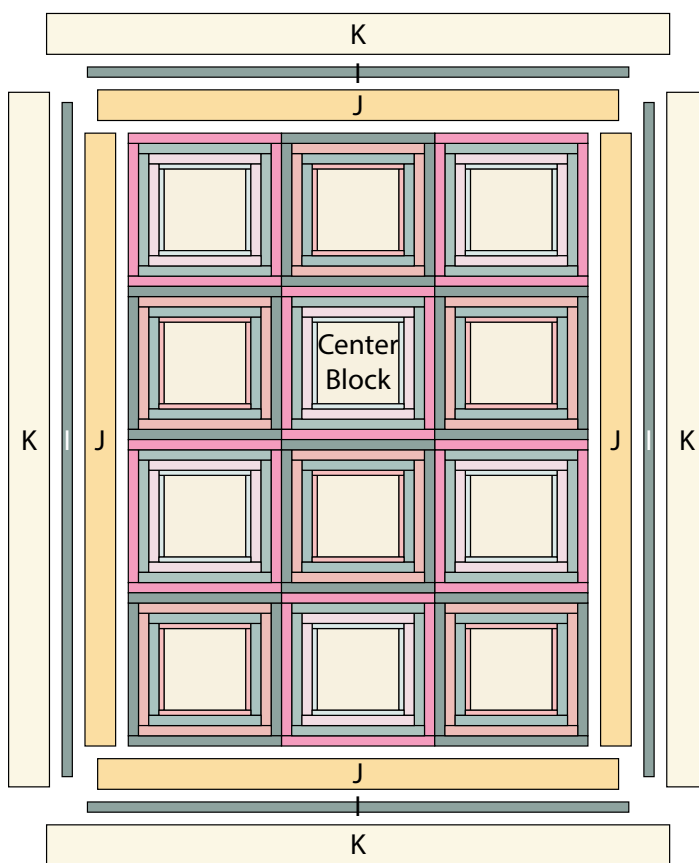
13. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 66 1/2" Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 53 1/2" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

14. Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 68 1/2" Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 61 1/2" Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

15. Layer and quilt as desired.

16. Sew the (7) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

17. Bind as desired.
