$1 / 3$ yard Stars - Cream/Gold (C) 2080-43
$1 / 4$ yard Mini Glen Plaid - Green (D) 2085Y-66
$3 / 8$ yard Words Monotone - Red (E) 2081-88
$3 / 8$ yard Mini Glen Plaid - Gold (F) 2085Y-33
$81 / 3$ yards Believe Border Stripe - Cream (G) 2078-44
$11 / 3$ yards Words Notes to Santa - Red (H) 2082-88*
$73 / 4$ yards Stars - Black (Backing) 2080-99
*Includes binding

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Tossed Santa - Gray (A), cut:

- (1) $81 / 2 "$ square.

From the Dobbie Plaid - Gray (B), cut:
-(1) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $41 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Stars - Cream/Gold (C), cut:
-(1) $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $41 / 2 "$ x $81 / 2 "$ strips.
-(1) $41 / 2 \prime x$ X WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $41 / 2 \prime$ squares.
From the Mini Glen Plaid - Green (D), cut:

- (2) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 181 / 2 "$ strips and
(2) $11 / 2 " \times 16 \frac{1}{2} / 2$ strips.


## From the Words Monotone - Red (E), cut:

- (4) 2 " x WOF strips
-(2) $17 / 8 " \times$ WOF strips.
From the Mini Glen Plaid - Gold (F), cut
-(4) $2 " x$ WOF strips
-(2) $17 / 8 " \times$ WOF strips.
From the Believe Border Stripe - Cream (G), cut:
-(4) $12 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 74 "$ Length of Fabric (LOF) strips each centered on the trees.
-(4) $6 " \times 721 / 2 "$ LOF strips each centered on the words "Merry \& Bright".
- (4) $101 / 2 " \times 48 "$ LOF strips each centered on the words "Joy \& Peace".


## From the Words Notes to Santa - Red (H), cut:

-(4) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 721 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.

- (4) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 701 / 2 "$ strips.
- (5) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 461 / 2 "$ strips and
(2) $1 \frac{1}{2} " \times 441 / 2 "$ strips.
- (9) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Stars - Black (Backing), cut:

- (3) $91 " \times$ WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $91 " x 91 "$ back.


## Sewing Instructions

1. Place (1) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric B square on the left side of $41 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance.
2. Place another $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B square on the right side of the $41 / 2 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4 "$ seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 4).
3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (4) Unit 1 strips total.

4. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of (1) $8 \frac{1}{2} / 2$ Fabric A square. Sew (1) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric C square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A strip to make (1) Unit 2 block (Fig. 5).
5. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 16 \frac{1}{2} "$ Fabric $D$ strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 18 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 2 block to make (1) Unit 3 block (Fig. 6).

6. Sew (1) 2 " x WOF Fabric E strip and (1) 2 " x WOF Fabric F strip together lengthwise to make (1) EF strip set (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (4) EF strip sets total.
7. Cut the EF strip sets into (56) 2 " $\times 31 / 2 "$ Unit 4 strips (Fig. 8).
8. Sew (2) Unit 4 strips together lengthwise to make (1) Unit 5 block (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (28) Unit 4 blocks total.

9. Sew (6) Unit 5 blocks together to make (1) Center Side Border (Fig. 10). Repeat to make a second Center Side Border.

10. Sew (8) Unit 5 blocks together to make (1) Center Top Border. Repeat to make (1) Center Bottom Border (Fig. 11).

11. Sew (1) Center Side Border to each side of the Unit 3 block. Sew the Center Top and Center Bottom borders to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 3 block to make the Center Block (Fig. 12).

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16. Repeat Step 15 to sew (1) $101 / 2 " \times 48 "$ Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start $1 / 4$ " away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 16).
17. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 16), draw a 45 -degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.

18. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 441 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 461 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
19. Repeat Steps $15-17$ using (4) $121 / 2 " \times 74 "$ Fabric G strips.
20. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 701 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 721 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
21. Sew (1) 6 " $\times 721 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) Border Block to each end of (1) $6 " \times 721 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
22. Layer and quilt as desired.
23. Sew the (9) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric H strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
24. Bind as desired.
