Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Panel Bird Houses - Cream (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 22 1/2" x 30 1/2" rectangle, centered on the panel

From the Gails Basic Daisy - Taupe (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 30 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 25 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Small Vine - Red (C), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (17) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x 32 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x 26 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Small Bird House Daisy - Red (D), cut:

- (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 9 7/8" squares.

From the Small Vine - Cream (E), cut:

- (1) 9 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 9 7/8" squares.

From the Border Stripe - Cream (F), cut:

- (1) 16 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 16 1/2" x 9 1/2" strips and (2) 9 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.

From the Diagonal Stripe - Taupe (G), cut:

- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 1/2" x 52 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 1/2" x 48 1/2" strips.

From the Large Bird House Toss - Red (H), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (18) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

From the Large Bird House Toss - Cream (I), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (17) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

From the Gails Basic Daisy - Cream (J), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (18) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

From the Scattered Birds and Words - Taupe (K), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (17) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

From the Diagonal Stripe - Pink (L), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (17) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

From the Small Bird House Daisy - Cream (M), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Scattered Birds and Words - Red (N), cut:

- (4) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 1/2" x 64 1/2" strips.
- (4) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 1/2" x 62 1/2" strips.

From the Gails Basic Daisy - Red Rose (O), cut:

- (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Bird House Blocks - Cream (P):

- Fussy cut (8) 9 1/2" squares, each centered on a block.

From the Scattered Birds and Words - Red (Backing), cut:

- (2) 70" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 70" x 78" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

- Sew (1) 2" x 30 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 1/2" x 30 1/2" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 25 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 24 1/2" x 32 1/2".**

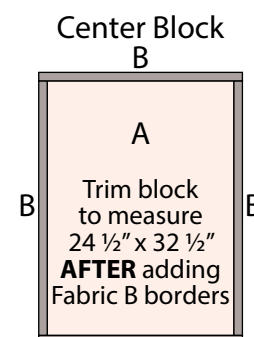

2. Place (1) $9\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric D square on top of (1) $9\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric E square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 2). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure $9\frac{1}{2}$ " square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (4) Unit 1 squares total.

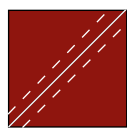

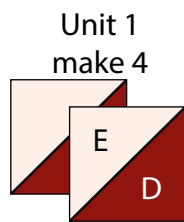

3. Sew (1) $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric P square to the top and to the bottom of (1) $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to make (1) Inner Side Border (Fig. 5). Repeat to make a second Inner Side Border.

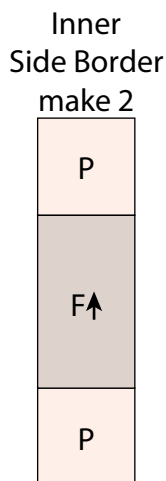

4. Sew together (1) Unit 1 square, (1) $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric P square, (1) $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip, (1) $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric P square and (1) Unit 1 square, in that order from left to right, to make the Inner Top Border (Fig. 6).

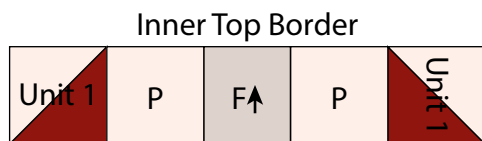

5. Repeat Step 4 and refer to Figure 7 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the Inner Bottom Border.

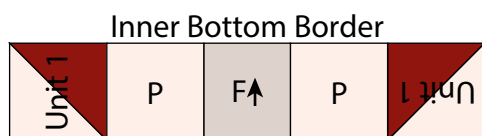

6. Refer to Figure 8 and sew together (28) assorted $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips lengthwise to make the Outer Left Side Border.

7. Refer to Figure 9 and sew together (28) assorted $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips lengthwise to make the Outer Right Side Border.

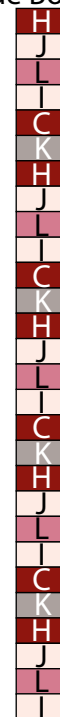

8. Sew together (24) assorted $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips lengthwise. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric M square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Outer Top Border (Fig. 10).

9. Sew together (24) assorted $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips lengthwise. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric M square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Outer Bottom Border (Fig. 11).

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

10. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 32 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 26 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

11. Sew (1) Inner Side Border to each side of the Center Block.

12. Sew the Inner Top Border and Inner Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

13. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 52 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

14. Sew the Outer Left Side Border and Outer Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.

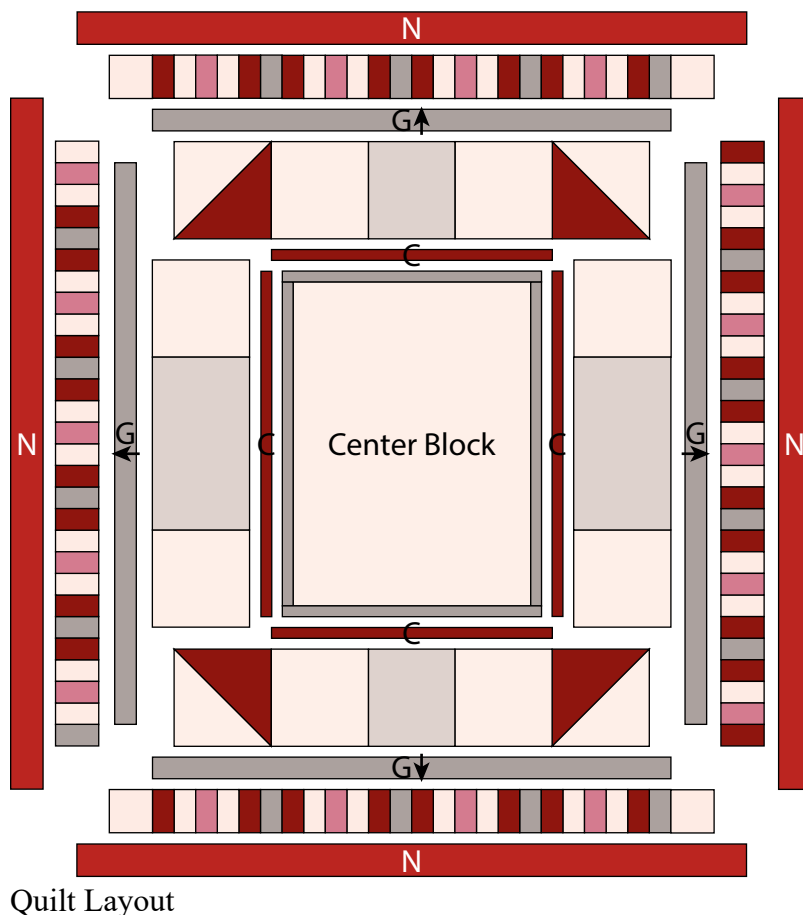
15. Sew the Outer Top Border and Outer Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

16. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 64 ½" Fabric N strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 62 ½" Fabric N strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

17. Layer and quilt as desired.

18. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric O strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

19. Bind as desired.
