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Block Assembly
Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Place (1) 3 " Fabric I square on the left side of (1) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{1 / 2}$ " Fabric Q strip, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance (Fig. 2).

2. Place (1) 3 " Fabric H square on the right side of the $3 " \times 51 / 2 "$ Fabric Q strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip for Version \#1 (Fig. 4). For Version \#2 repeat Steps 1-2 to make (9) Unit 1 strips total.

28. Sew (1) $51 / 2 " \times 601 / 2 "$ Fabric A strip to each side of the Version \#2 Center Block. Sew (1) $51 / 2 "$ x $701 / 2 "$ Fabric A strip to the top and to the bottom of the Version \#2 Center Block to make the Version \#2 quilt top.

## Both Versions

29. Layer and quilt as desired.
30. Sew the (7) $21 / 2$ " x WOF Fabric $Z$ strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
31. Bind as desired.
