2/3 yard (0.61 m)	Small Lilac Flower Tossed - Lilac (C)	960-05
1/2 yard (0.46 m)	Packed Flowers - Lavender (D)	958-55
1/2 yard (0.46 m)	Folio Basics - Lilac (E)	7755-05
1/4 yard (0.23 m)	Tossed Lilac and Butterflies - Green (F)	957-55
7/8 yard (0.81 m)	Small Tossed Lilac and Butterflies - Multi (G)	959-05
1 yard (0.92 m)	Packed Flowers - Periwinkle (H)	958-75*
1/4 yard (0.23 m)	Packed Lilac - Multi (I)	954-56
1/2 yard (0.46 m)	Folio Basics - Early Green (J)	7755-62
4 yards (3.66 m)	Lilac Garden - Multi (Backing)	955-05

### Cutting Instructions

*Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.*

#### From the Vine - Green (A), cut:

- (6) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (54) 4 1/2" squares.

#### From the Folio Basics - Light Violet (B), cut:

- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (96) 2 1/2" squares.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 48 1/2" strips.
- (2) 2" x 39 1/2" WOF strips.

#### From the Small Lilac Flower Tossed - Lilac (C), cut:

- (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (120) 2 1/2" squares.

#### From the Packed Flowers - Lavender (D), cut:

- (3) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 4 1/2" squares.

#### From the Folio Basics - Lilac (E), cut:

- (5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (72) 2 1/2" squares.

#### From the Tossed Lilac and Butterflies - Green (F), cut:

- (1) 5 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 1/2" squares.

#### From the Small Tossed Lilac and Butterflies - Multi (G), cut:

- (3) 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 1/2" x 51 1/2" strips.
- (2) 5 1/2" x 39 1/2" WOF strips.

#### From the Packed Flowers - Periwinkle (H), cut:

- (3) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 4 1/2" squares.
- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Packed Lilac - Multi (I), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4 1/2" squares.

#### From the Folio Basics - Early Green (J), cut:

- (5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (72) 2 1/2" squares.

#### From the Lilac Garden - Multi (Backing), cut:

- (2) 69" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 57" x 69" back.

### Block Assembly

*Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.*

1. Place (1) 2 1/2" Fabric E square on the top left corner of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric D square, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 2).

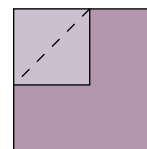

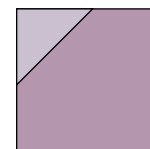

2. Follow Figure 3 for the seam direction to add a 2 1/2" Fabric E square to the upper right corner and 2 1/2" Fabric C squares to the lower left and lower right corners of the 4 1/2" Fabric D square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 4).

3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (24) Unit 1 squares total.

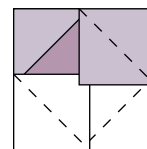

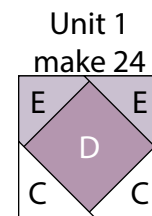

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4. Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Figures 5-9 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (6) Unit 2 squares, (24) Unit 3 squares, (6) Unit 4 squares, (24) Unit 5 squares and (24) Unit 6 squares.

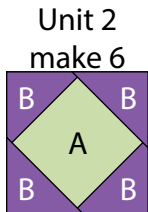

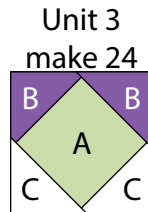

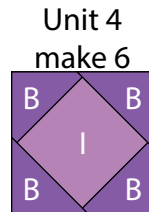

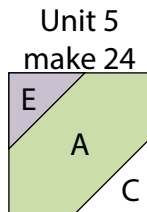

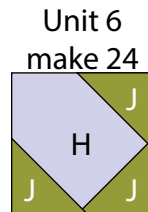

5. Sew (1) Unit 5 square to each side of (1) Unit 1 square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each side of (1) Unit 2 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 12 1/2" Block One square (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.

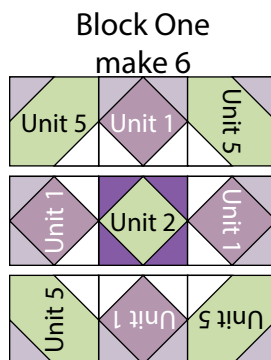

6. Repeat Step 5 and refer to Figure 11 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (6) Block Two squares.

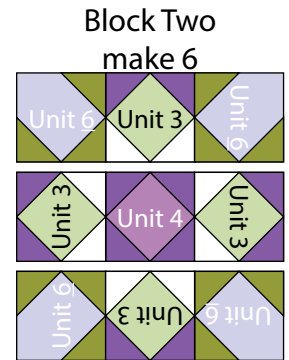

7. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two square to make Row One (Fig. 12). Repeat to make Row Three.

8. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) Block One square to make Row Two (Fig. 12). Repeat to make Row Four.

9. Sew together the (4) Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 36 1/2" x 48 1/2" Center Block (Fig. 12).

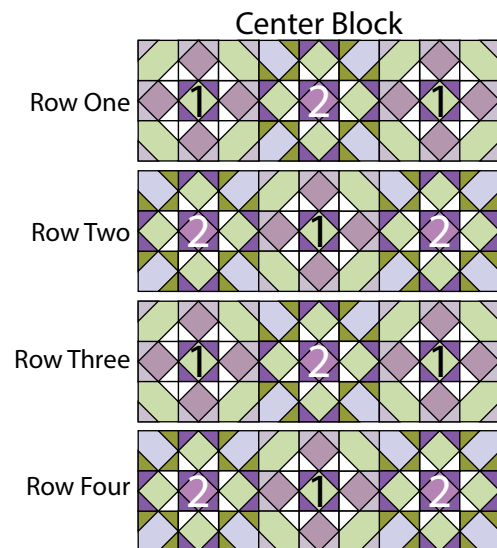

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### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*

10. Sew (1) 2" x 48 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 39 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

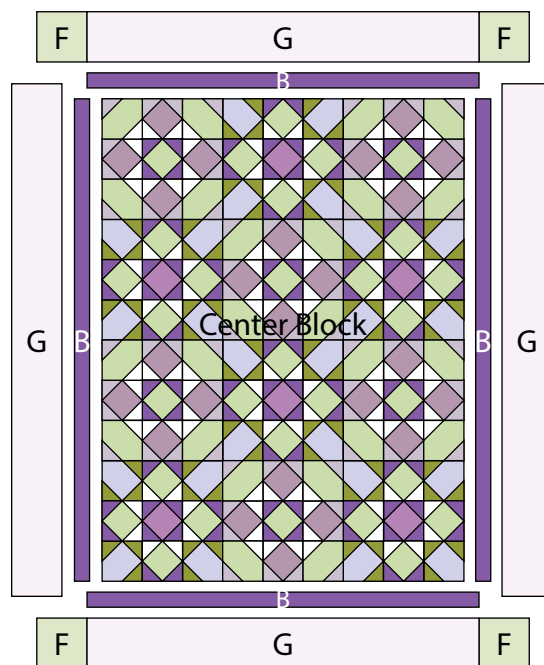
11. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 51 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block.

12. Sew (1) 5 ½" Fabric F square to each end of (1) 5 ½" x 39 ½" Fabric G strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

13. Layer and quilt as desired.

14. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric H strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

15. Bind as desired.
