Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted. Red Version fabrics are listed second where they differ from Teal Version fabrics.

From the Large Dinosaur Panel 24-IN - Light Gray (A):

• Fussy cut (1) 23 ½" x 41 ½" rectangle, centered on the panel

From the Houndstooth Basics - Lime Green (B), cut: Bubble Dot - Red (B), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x 41 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x 27 ½" WOF strips.
- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 4 ½" squares.

From the Starry Basics -Light Gray (C), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 44 ½" strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x 30 ½" WOF strips.
- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 64 ½" strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x 42 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Bias Plaid - Teal (D), cut: Bias Plaid - Rose (D), cut:

• (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4 ½" squares.

From the Starry Basics - New Teal (E), cut: Starry Basics - Red (E), cut:

- (1) 6 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 1/8" squares.
- (1) 2 \%" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 \%" squares.

From the Tropical Leaf - Light Gray (F), cut:

- (2) 2 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) 2 1/8" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (14) 2 ½" squares.

From the Starry Basics - Green (G), cut: Starry Basics - Rose Berry (G), cut:

• (2) 2 %" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 2 %" squares.

From the Teal and Blue Dino - Teal (H), cut: Pink and Red Dino - Light Gray (H), cut:

• (2) 6 \%" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 6 \%" squares.

From the Houndstooth Basics - New Teal (I), cut: Houndstooth Basics - Rose (I), cut:

• (1) 6 \%" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 \%" squares.

From the Dino Tracks - Navy (J), cut:

• (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Word Print - Light Gray (Backing), cut:

• (2) 54" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 54" x 72" back.

Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 41 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 23 ½" x 41 ½" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 27 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle. Trim the block to measure 26 ½" x 44 ½" to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).




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
2. Place (1) 2 1/8" Fabric G square on top of (1) 2 1/8" Fabric F square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 2). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 3) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2 ½" square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (32) Unit 1 squares total.




3. Repeat Step 2 and refer to Figure 5 for fabric identification and placement to make (24) Unit 2 squares.




4. Follow Figure 6 and sew together (4) Unit 1 squares, (1) 2 ½" Fabric F square and (1) 4 ½" Fabric B square to make (1) 6 1/2" Block One square. Repeat to make (8) Block One squares total.




5. Repeat Step 4 and refer to Figure 7 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (6) Block Two squares.



6. Place (1) 6 \%" Fabric E square on top of (1) 6 \%" Fabric H square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 8). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 8). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 9) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 6 ½" square to make (2) Block Three squares (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (8) Block Three squares total.



7. Repeat Step 6 and refer to Figure 11 for fabric identification and placement to make (8) Block Four squares.

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- 8. Follow Figure 12 and sew together (2) Block One squares, (1) Block Two square, (3) Block Three squares and (2) Block Four squares to make the Left Side Border.
- 9. Repeat Step 8 and refer to Figures 13-15 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the Right Side Border, the Top Border and the Bottom Border.











Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 10. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 30 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 11. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.
- 12. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 13. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $42\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and the bottom of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 64 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 14. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 15. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric J strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 16. Bind as desired.
