$7 / 8$ yard ( 0.81 m ) Modern Melody Basics - Grass Green (B)

$13 / 8$ yards (1.26m) Modern Melody Basics - Marigold (C) 1063-48
$11 / 4$ yards (1.15m) Caterpillar Stripe - Multi (D) 3258-11*
$1 / 4$ yard ( 0.23 m ) Butterflies - Yellow (E) 3257-33
$1 / 4$ yard ( 0.23 m ) Monotone Bugs - Light Blue (F) 3256-17
$3 / 4$ yard ( 0.69 m ) Monotone Bugs - Green (G) 3256-66
$1 / 4$ yard (0.23m) Big Bugs - Red (H) 3254-88
$1 / 3$ yard ( 0.31 m ) Allover Leaves and Bugs - Green (I) 3260-66
$1 / 4$ yard (0.23m) Lady Bugs - Light Blue (J) 3255-17

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Bug Bug Bug Book - Red (A):

- Fussy cut (12) $71 / 2 "$ squares, centered on blocks.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Grass Green (B), cut:

- (3) $21 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (14) $21 / 2 " \times 71 / 2 "$ strips.
- (5) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (14) $21 / 2 "$ x $111 / 2 "$ strips.
- (1) $2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $2 "$ x $101 / 2 "$ strips.
-(1) $2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $2 " x 71 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Modern Melody Basics - Marigold (C), cut:
- (9) 3 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (60) $3 " \times 51 / 2 "$ strips.
-(5) 3 " $x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (60) 3 " squares.
From the Caterpillar Stripe - Multi (D), cut:
-(9) $3 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (120) 3" squares.
-(6) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Butterflies - Yellow (E), cut:
-(1) $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $5 \frac{1}{2} ’$ squares.
From the Monotone Bugs - Light Blue (F), cut:
-(1) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $51 / 2 "$ squares.


## From the Monotone Bugs - Green (G), cut:

- (1) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $51 / 2 "$ squares.
- (3) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 601 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 541 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Big Bugs - Red (H), cut:
-(1) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $51 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Allover Leaves and Bugs - Green (I), cut:
-(1) $71 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) $71 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Lady Bugs - Light Blue (J), cut:

- (1) $51 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) $51 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Turquoise (K), cut:

- (2) $21 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) $21 / 2 " \times 71 / 2 "$ strips.
- (4) $21 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) $21 / 2 "$ x $11 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strips.
-(1) $2 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $2 "$ x $101 / 2 "$ strips.
-(1) $2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $2 " \times 71 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Allover Leaves and Bugs - Green (Backing), cut:
-(2) $62 " \times$ WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $62 " \times 72 "$ back.


## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ "seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 71 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $71 / 2 "$ Fabric A square. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 11 \frac{1}{2} \gg$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure $101 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$. Repeat to make (7) Block One squares total.

2. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 71 / 2 "$ Fabric K strip to each side of (1) $71 / 2 "$ Fabric A square. Sew (1) $21 / 2 "$ x $11 \frac{1}{2} "$ Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make
(1) Block Two square (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure $101 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$. Repeat to make (5) Block Two squares total.

3. Sew (1) 2" x $71 / 2 "$ Fabric K strip to each side of (1) $71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I square. Sew (1) $2 " \times 10 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric I square to make (1) $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " Block Three square (Fig. 3).

5. Place (1) 3" Fabric D square on the left side of (1) $3 " \times 51 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 5). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 5). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance (Fig. 6).

6. Place another $3 "$ Fabric D square on the right side of the $3 " \times 51 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 7). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 7). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4 "$ seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 8).
7. Repeat Steps 5-6 to make (60) Unit 1 strips total.

8. Sew (1) $3 "$ Fabric C square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of (1) $5 \frac{1}{2} "$ Fabric E square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) $101 / 2 "$ Block Five square (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (4) Block Five squares total.

10. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Block Five square, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Six square and (1) Block One square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One (Fig. 14).
11. Repeat Step 10 and refer to Figure 14 for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Two through Row Six.
12. Sew together the (6) pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from the top to the bottom, to make the $501 / 2 " \times 601 / 2 "$ Center Block (Fig. 14).

Quilt Top Assembly
(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
13. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 601 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 541 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
14. Layer and quilt as desired.
15. Sew the (6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
16. Bind as desired.
