5/8 yard	Wonky Stripe - White/Red (B)	817-08
1/8 yard	Berries - Navy (C)	813-77
1 yard	Folio Basics - White on White (D)	7755-01
3/4 yard	Texture - Navy (E)	815-77
1 yard	Tossed Bunnies - Light Blue (F)	819-11
3/4 yard	Snowflake and Dots - Red (G)	814-88
1/4 yard	Forest Animal Scenic - Multi (H)	820-90
1/2 yard	Mittens - Navy (I)	822-78
1 1/8 yards	Bias Plaid - Red (J)	821-88*
2 1/2 yards	Winter Scene Stripe - Multi (K)	823-71
5 yards	Mittens - White/Red (Backing)	822-08

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Six Blocks on 24 Inch Repeat - Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (6) 10" squares, each centered on a block.

From the Wonky Stripe - White/Red (B), cut:

- (3) 2 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 1/4" x 10" strips.
- (4) 2 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 1/4" x 13 1/2" strips.

From the Berries - Navy (C), cut:

- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (24) 1 1/2" squares.

From the Folio Basics - White on White (D), cut:

- (2) 5 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 5 7/8" squares.
- (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 66 1/2" strips.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 52 1/2" strips.
- (8) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips.

From the Texture - Navy (E), cut:

- (9) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (62) 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" strips.

From the Tossed Bunnies - Light Blue (F), cut:

- (3) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.
- (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (55) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

From the Snowflake and Dots - Red (G), cut:

- (9) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (130) 2 1/2" squares.

From the Forest Animal Scenic - Multi (H), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Mittens - Navy (I), cut:

- (2) 5 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 5 7/8" squares.

From the Bias Plaid - Red (J), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 68 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 55 1/2" strips.
- (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Winter Scene Stripe - Multi (K), cut:

- (2) 6" x 86" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) 6" x 70" LOF strips.

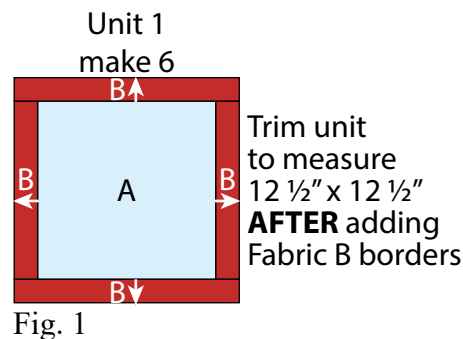
From the Mittens - White/Red (Backing), cut:

- (2) 90" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 74" x 90" back.

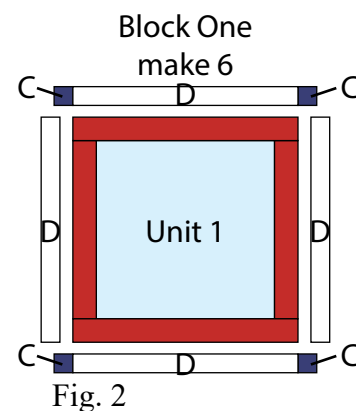
Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2 1/4" x 10" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 10" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2 1/4" x 13 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 12 1/2" x 12 1/2"**. Repeat to make (6) Unit 1 squares total.



2. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) 1 1/2" Fabric C square to each end of (1) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric D strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) 14 1/2" Block One square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.



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3. Place (1) $5\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric I square on top of (1) $5\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric D square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 3). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 3). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 4) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square to make (2) Unit 2 squares (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (24) Unit 2 squares total.

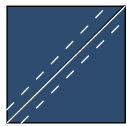

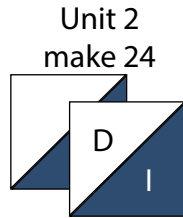

4. Place (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G square on the left side of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip, right sides together (Fig. 6). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 6). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance (Fig. 7).

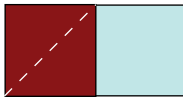

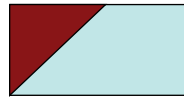

5. Place another $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G square on the right side of the $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip, right sides together (Fig. 8). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 8). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 3 strip (Fig. 9).

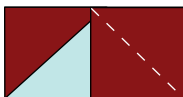

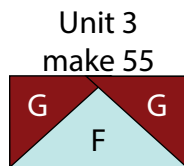

6. Repeat Steps 4-5 to make (55) Unit 3 strips total.

7. Sew (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to the top of (1) Unit 3 strip lengthwise along the Fabric F side to make (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 4 rectangle (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (24) Unit 4 rectangles total.

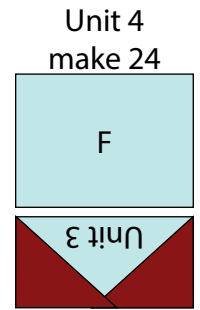

8. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to each side of (1) Unit 4 rectangle to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 4 rectangle to each side of (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) $14\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Two square (Fig. 11). Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.

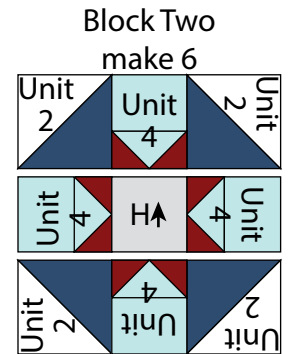

9. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to each end of (1) Unit 3 strip to make (1) Block Three strip (Fig. 12). Repeat to make (31) Block Three strips total.

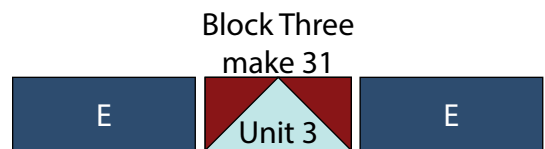


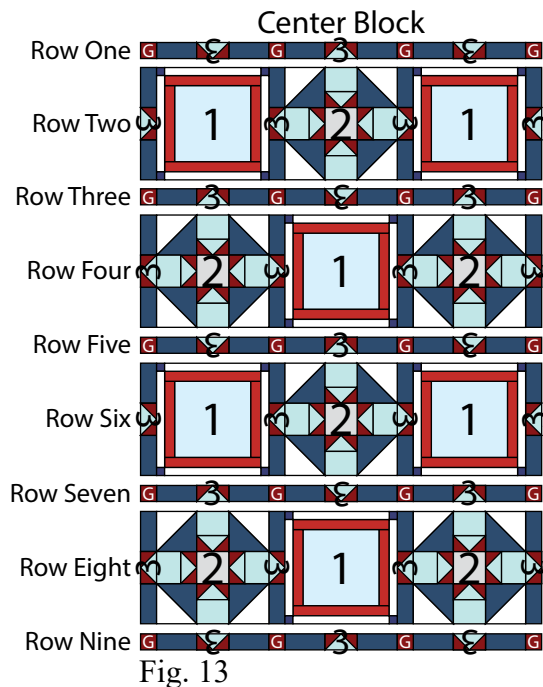

10. Sew together (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G squares and (3) Unit 3 strips, end to end and alternating them from left to right, to make Row One (Fig. 13). Repeat to make Row Three, Row Five, Row Seven and Row Nine.

11. Sew together (1) Block Three strip, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Three strip, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Three strip, (1) Block One square and (1) Block Three strip, in that order from left to right, to make Row Two (Fig. 13). Repeat to make Row Six.

12. Sew together (1) Block Three strip, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Three strip, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Three strip, (1) Block Two square and (1) Block Three strip, in that order from left to right, to make Row Four (Fig. 13). Repeat to make Row Eight.

13. Sew together the (9) Rows from Steps 10-12, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 50 ½" x 66 ½" Center Block (Fig. 13).



Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

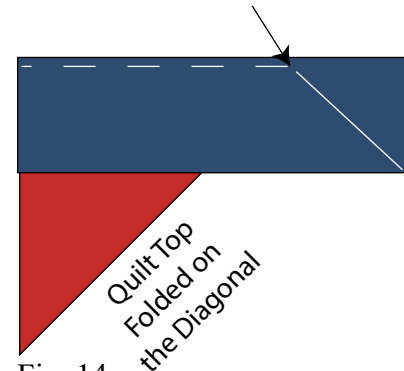
14. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 66 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 52 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

15. Sew (1) 2" x 68 ½" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 55 ½" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

16. Center (1) 6" x 86" Fabric K strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a ¼" from the top edge of the block and stop a ¼" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.

17. Repeat Step 16 to sew (1) 6" x 70" Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start ¼" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 14).

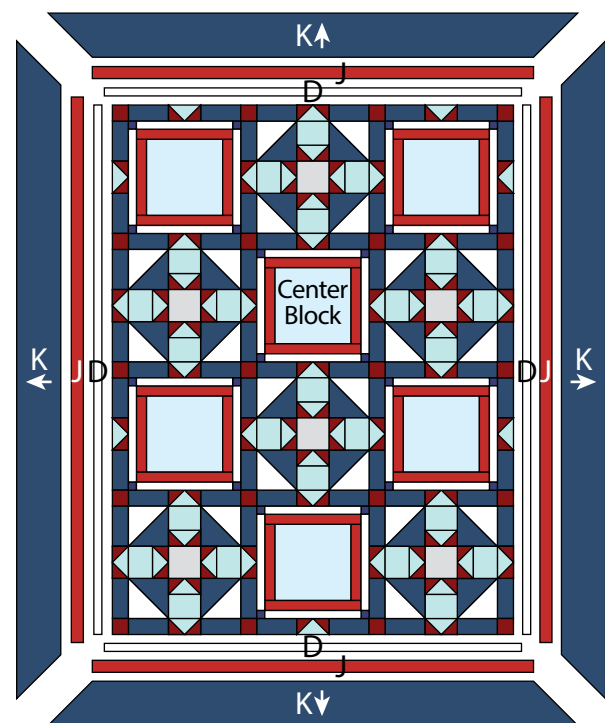
18. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 14), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a ¼" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the quilt top.



19. Layer and quilt as desired.

20. Sew the (8) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric J strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

21. Bind as desired.



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
