$5 / 8$ yard Wonky Stripe - White/Red (B) 817-08
$1 / 8$ yard Berries - Navy (C) 813-77
1 yard Folio Basics - White on White (D) 7755-01
$3 / 4$ yard Texture - Navy (E) 815-77
1 yard Tossed Bunnies - Light Blue (F) 819-11
$3 / 4$ yard $\quad$ Snowflake and Dots - Red (G) 814-88
$1 / 4$ yard Forest Animal Scenic - Multi (H) 820-90
$1 / 2$ yard Mittens - Navy (I) 822-78
$11 / 8$ yards Bias Plaid - Red (J) 821-88*
$21 / 2$ yards Winter Scene Stripe - Multi (K) 823-71
5 yards Mittens - White/Red (Backing) 822-08

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Six Blocks on 24 Inch Repeat - Multi (A):
-Fussy cut (6) 10" squares, each centered on a block.
From the Wonky Stripe - White/Red (B), cut:
-(3) $21 / 4 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $21 / 4 "$ x $10 "$ strips.
-(4) $21 / 4 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $21 / 4 "$ x $131 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Berries - Navy (C), cut:
-(1) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (24) $11 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Folio Basics - White on White (D), cut:

- (2) $57 / 8 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $57 / 8 "$ squares.
- (4) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 661 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 521 / 2 "$ strips.
- (8) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x $121 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Texture - Navy (E), cut:
-(9) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (62) $21 / 2 " \times 51 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Tossed Bunnies - Light Blue (F), cut:

- (3) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $31 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.
- (7) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (55) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Snowflake and Dots - Red (G), cut:
-(9) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (130) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Forest Animal Scenic - Multi (H), cut:
-(1) $41 / 2 \prime x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $41 / 2 \prime$ squares.
From the Mittens - Navy (I), cut:

- (2) $57 / 8 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $57 / 8 "$ squares.

From the Bias Plaid - Red (J), cut:
-(4) $2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 681 / 2 "$ strips.

- (3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 551 / 2 "$ strips.
-(8) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Winter Scene Stripe - Multi (K), cut:
-(2) $6 " \times 86 "$ Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
-(2) $6 " \times 70 "$ LOF strips.
From the Mittens - White/Red (Backing), cut:
- (2) 90 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $74 " \times 90 "$ back.


## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) $21 / 4 " \times 10 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $10 "$ Fabric A square. Sew (1) $21 / 4 " \times 131 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure
$121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2 "$. Repeat to make (6) Unit 1 squares total.

2. Sew (1) $11 / 2$ " x $121 / 2$ " Fabric D strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C square to each end of (1) $11 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) $141 / 2$ " Block One square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.

3. Place (1) $57 / 8 "$ Fabric I square on top of (1) $57 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 3). Sew $1 / 4$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 3). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 4) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure $51 / 2$ " square to make (2) Unit 2 squares (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (24) Unit 2 squares total.

4. Place (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric G square on the left side of (1) 2 $1 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip, right sides together (Fig. 6). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 6). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance (Fig. 7).

5. Place another $21 / 2$ " Fabric G square on the right side of the $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip, right sides together (Fig. 8). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 8). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 3 strip (Fig. 9).
6. Repeat Steps $4-5$ to make (55) Unit 3 strips total.

7. Sew (1) $31 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip to the top of (1) Unit 3 strip lengthwise along the Fabric F side to make (1) $51 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Unit 4 rectangle (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (24) Unit 4 rectangles total.

8. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to each side of (1) Unit 4 rectangle to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 4 rectangle to each side of (1) $41 / 2$ " Fabric H square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) $141 / 2 "$ Block Two square (Fig. 11). Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.

9. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 51 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to each end of (1) Unit 3 strip to make (1) Block Three strip (Fig. 12). Repeat to make (31) Block Three strips total.

10. Sew together (4) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric G squares and (3) Unit 3 strips, end to end and alternating them from left to right, to make Row One (Fig. 13). Repeat to make Row Three, Row Five, Row Seven and Row Nine.
11. Sew together (1) Block Three strip, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Three strip, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Three strip, (1) Block One square and (1) Block Three strip, in that order from left to right, to make Row Two (Fig. 13). Repeat to make Row Six.
12. Sew together (1) Block Three strip, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Three strip, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Three strip, (1) Block Two square and (1) Block Three strip, in that order from left to right, to make Row Four (Fig. 13). Repeat to make Row Eight.
13. Sew together the (9) Rows from Steps $10-12$, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the $501 / 2 " \times 661 / 2 "$ Center Block (Fig. 13).


## Quilt Top Assembly

 (Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 14. Sew (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 661 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 521 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.15. Sew (1) $2 " \times 681 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $551 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
16. Center (1) 6 " $\times 86$ " Fabric K strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $1 / 4 "$ from the top edge of the block and stop a $1 / 4 "$ from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.
17. Repeat Step 16 to sew (1) 6 " $\times 70$ " Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start $1 / 4$ " away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 14).
18. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 14), draw a 45 -degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the quilt top.

19. Layer and quilt as desired.
20. Sew the (8) $21 / 2 \gg \times$ WOF Fabric J strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
21. Bind as desired.
