## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Panel Butterfly Bath 24 inch $x 44$ inch - Cream (A), fussy cut:

- (1) $231 / 2 " \times 28 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, centered on the main panel.
- (2) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 231 / 2 "$ strips, centered on the floral borders.

From the Sprig Toss - Dark Blue (B), cut:
-(2) 2 " $\times 421 / 2 "$ WOF strips, piece as needed.

- (2) $11 / 2$ " $\times 231 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (2) $11 / 2$ " $\times 26 \frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (3) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 521 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 361 / 2 "$ WOF strips.

From the Tulip Toss - Taupe (C), cut:
-(1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.

- (1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Tulip Toss - Cream (D), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $21 / 2 "$ x $41 / 2 "$ strips.
- (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Medium Butterfly Toss - Light Blue (E), cut: -(1) $21 / 2 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Flower Stripe - Cream (F), cut:
-(1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Butterfly Wreaths - Light Blue (G), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Butterfly and Words - Cream (H), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (7) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Flower Stripe - Light Blue (I), cut:
-(1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Medium Butterfly Toss - Cream (J), cut:
-(1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Sprig Toss - Light Blue (K), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Lazy Daisy Toss - Taupe (L), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Butterfly Wreaths - Cream (M), cut:
-(1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Lazy Daisy Toss - Dark Blue (N), cut:
-(6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Butterfly and Words - Light Blue (O), cut:

- (3) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $41 / 2 " \times 541 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $41 / 2 " \times 441 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Butterfly and Words - Light Blue (Backing), cut:
-(2) $52 "$ x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $52 " \times 70 "$ back.

Block Assembly
Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4 "$ seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 231 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the $231 / 2 " \times 281 / 2$ " Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) $6 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 231 / 2$ " Fabric A strip to the top and to the bottom of the newly sewn block to make the $231 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Center Block (Fig. 1).

2. Follow Figure 2 and sew together
(2) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric C squares and (2) $21 / 2 "$

Fabric D squares into a $2 \times 2$ matrix to make
(1) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 1 square. Repeat to make
(4) Unit 1 squares total.

3. Follow Figure 3 and sew together (22) assorted $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2$ " strips lengthwise from top to bottom to make the Left Side Border.
4. Follow Figure 4 and sew together (22) assorted $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips lengthwise from top to bottom to make the Right Side Border.
5. Follow Figure 5 and sew together (13) assorted $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips lengthwise from left to right. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Top Border.

6. Follow Figure 6 and sew together (13) assorted $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips lengthwise from left to right. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Bottom Border.

Quilt Top Assembly
(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
7. Sew (1) $2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 26 \frac{1}{2}, "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
8. Sew the Left Side Border and the Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.
9. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 521 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 361 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 54 \frac{1}{2} "$ Fabric O strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 441 / 2 "$ Fabric O strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
12. Layer and quilt as desired.
13. Sew the (6) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF Fabric N strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
14. Bind as desired.
