$1 / 4$ yard ( 0.23 m ) Butterfly and Words - Light Blue (D)

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

## From the Butterfly Blocks - Dark Blue (A):

- Fussy cut (6) $10 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 121 / 2 "$ rectangles, centered on the blocks.

From the Border Stripe - Cream (B):

- Fussy cut (2) $10 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 501 / 2 " \times$ Length of Fabric (LOF) strips, centered on the stripes.

From the Lazy Daisy Toss - Dark Blue (C), cut:
-(5) $11 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 501 / 2 "$ strips.

- (3) $11 / 2$ "x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 601 / 2 "$ strips.
-(3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 521 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Butterfly and Words - Light Blue (D), cut: -(1) $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) $51 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ rectangles.

From the Flower Stripe - Cream (E), cut:
-(1) $6 \frac{1}{2} " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) $6 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " $\times 5 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles.
From the Medium Butterfly Toss - Cream (F), cut:

- (1) $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) $51 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ rectangles.

From the Sprig Toss - Dark Blue (G), cut:
-(1) $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times$ X WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) $51 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ rectangles.

- (7) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Butterfly Wreaths - Light Blue (H), cut:

- (1) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) $51 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ rectangles.

From the Medium Butterfly Toss - Light Blue (I), cut:
-(1) $5 \frac{1}{2} " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $51 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ rectangles.
From the Butterfly and Words - Cream (J), cut:
-(1) $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $51 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ rectangles.
From the Tulip Toss - Cream (K), cut:
-(1) $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $51 / 2 " \times 1$ x $1 / 2$ rectangles.
From the Flower Stripe - Light Blue (L), cut:
-(1) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) $6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ rectangles.
From the Butterfly Wreaths - Cream (M), cut:

- (6) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) $51 / 2 " \times 621 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Butterfly Wreaths - Light Blue (Backing), cut:
-(2) 70 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $70 " \times 80^{\prime \prime}$ back.

## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ "seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) $5 \frac{1}{2} " \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D rectangle to the left side of (1) $51 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric E rectangle to make the top row (Fig. 1). Sew (1) $5^{1 / 2 "} \times 6^{1 / 2 "}$ " Fabric F rectangle to the left side of (1) $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G rectangle to make the bottom row (Fig. 1). Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1)
$101 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ Block One rectangle (Fig. 1). Repeat to make a second Block One

2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figures 2-4 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (3) Block Two rectangles, (3) Block Three rectangles and (1) Block Four rectangle.

3. Sew together (1) Block One rectangle, (1) $101 / 2$ " $\times 121 / 2$ " Fabric A rectangle, (1) Block Two rectangle, (1) $101 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric A rectangle and (1) Block Three rectangle lengthwise to make Row One (Fig. 5).
4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Figure 5 for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Three and Row Five.
5. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 501 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) $101 / 2 " \times 501 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip lengthwise to make Row Two (Fig. 5). Repeat to make Row Four.
6. Sew together the (5) Rows from Steps 3-5, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the $501 / 2 " \times 601 / 2 "$ Center Block (Fig. 5).

Quilt Top Assembly
(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 7. Sew (1) $11 / 2 \times 601 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 521 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
8. Sew (1) $5^{1 / 2 "} \times 621 / 2 "$ Fabric M strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $51 / 2 " \times 621 / 2 "$ Fabric M strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
9. Layer and quilt as desired.
10. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
11. Bind as desired.
