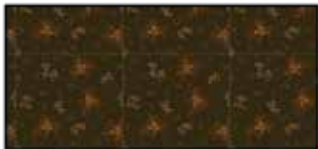

### Cutting Instructions

*Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.*

#### From the Oak Leaves - Cream (A), cut:

- (1) 4 ¾" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 ¾" squares and (4) 2 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 ⅞" squares.
- (2) 1 ¼" x 28 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ¼" x 27" WOF strips.

#### From the Floating Leaves - Pumpkin (B), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 ⅞" squares.
- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 ⅞" x 4 ¾" strips and (4) 2 ⅞" squares.
- See instructions to cut (4) Large Circles.

#### From the Floating Leaves - Green (C), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 2 ⅞" squares.
- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 ⅞" x 4 ¾" strips and (4) 2 ⅞" squares.

#### From the Novelty Toss - Tan (D), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 ⅞" x 4 ¾" strips and (4) 2 ⅞" squares.

#### From the Pumpkin Farm Yarn Dyes - Pumpkin/Olive (E), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 ⅞" x 4 ¾" strips and (4) 2 ⅞" squares.

#### From the Bud Vine - Green (F), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 ⅞" squares.

#### From the Pumpkin Farm Yarn Dyes - Pumpkin/Brown (G), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 ⅞" squares.

#### From the Bud Vine - Brown (H), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 2 ⅞" squares.
- (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Oak Leaves - Green (I), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 ⅞" squares.
- See instructions to cut (16) Large Leaves.

#### From the Oak Leaves - Cheddar (J), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 ⅞" squares.
- See instructions to cut (16) Flower Centers.

#### From the Mini Floral - Dark Red (K), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 ⅞" squares.
- See instructions to cut (16) Petals.

#### From the Dot Weave - Red (L), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ⅞" squares.
- (2) 1 ¼" x 34" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ¼" x 32 ½" WOF strips.
- See instructions to cut (16) Petals.

#### From the Floating Leaves - Brown (M), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 2 ⅞" squares.
- See instructions to cut (16) Stems.

#### From the Acorns - Russet (N), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 ⅞" squares.
- See instructions to cut (16) Petals.

#### From the Dot Weave - Green (O), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 2 ⅞" squares.

#### From the Pumpkin Farm Yarn Dyes - Olive (P), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 ⅞" squares.

#### From the Mini Floral - Cream (Q), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ⅞" squares and (4) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the Acorns - Cream (R), cut:

- (1) 2 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 ⅞" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" squares.

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## Quilt 2

### Cutting Instructions - Continued

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Dot Weave - Cream (S), cut:

- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 7/8" squares.
- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 1/2" squares.

#### From the Floating Leaves - Tan (T), cut:

- (2) 2 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 2 7/8" squares.
- See instructions to cut (4) Small Circles.

#### From the Pumpkin Farm Yarn Dyes - Charcoal/Black (U), cut:

- (2) 1" x 27" WOF strips.
- (3) 1" x 26" WOF strips.
- (1) 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1" x 13" strips.
- (1) 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 1" x 2 1/2" strips.

#### From the Border Stripe - Cream (V), cut:

- (4) 6" x 49" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.

#### From the Pumpkin Farm Yarn Dyes - Pumpkin/Brown (W), cut:

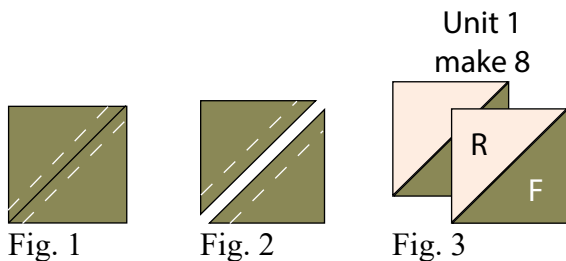
- See instructions to cut (16) Petals.

#### From the Novelty Toss - Cream (Backing), cut:

- (2) 53" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 53" x 53" back.

### Block Assembly

1. Place (1) 2 7/8" Fabric F square on top of (1) 2 7/8" Fabric R square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2 1/2" square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (8) Unit 1 squares total.



2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figures 4-18 for fabric identification and placement to make the indicated number of units for Unit 2 through Unit 16.

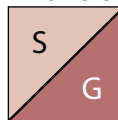

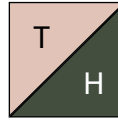

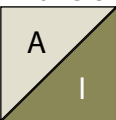

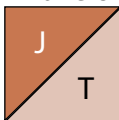

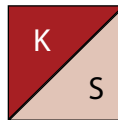

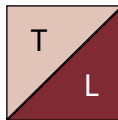

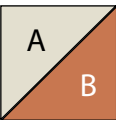

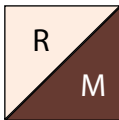

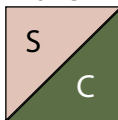

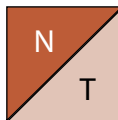

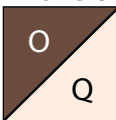

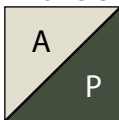

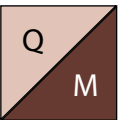

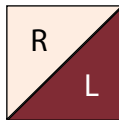

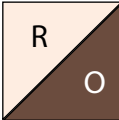

3. Sew (1) 2 5/8" Fabric B square to the left side of (1) 2 5/8" Fabric C square. Sew the resulting strip to the top of (1) 4 3/4" Fabric A square (Fig. 19).

4. Sew (1) 2 5/8" Fabric E square to the left side of (1) 2 5/8" Fabric D square. Sew the resulting strip to the bottom of the Fabric A square from Step 3 (Fig. 19).

5. Sew (1) 2 5/8" x 4 3/4" Fabric B strip to the top of (1) 2 5/8" x 4 3/4" Fabric E strip. Sew the resulting strip to the left side of the Fabric A square from Step 4 (Fig. 19).

6. Sew (1) 2 5/8" x 4 3/4" Fabric C strip to the top of (1) 2 5/8" x 4 3/4" Fabric D strip. Sew the resulting strip to the right side of the Fabric A square from Step 5 to make (1) Unit 17 square (Fig. 19).

7. Repeat Steps 3-6 to make (4) Unit 17 squares total.

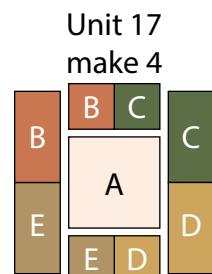

8. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.

9. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.

10. Refer to Figure 20 to arrange and press the assorted petals, stems, leaves and centers onto (1) Unit 17 square.

11. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) Unit 18 square (Fig. 20).

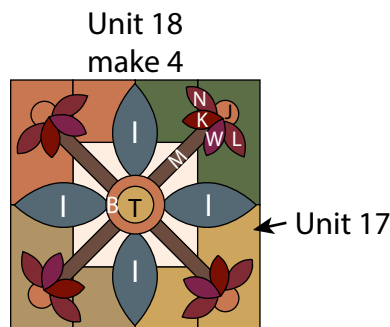

12. Repeat Steps 10-11 to make (4) Unit 18 squares total.

13. Sew (1) Unit 15 square, (1) Unit 14 square, (1) 1" x 2 1/2" Fabric U strip, (1) Unit 13 square and (1) Unit 3 square together in that order. Sew the resulting strip to the left side of (1) Unit 18 square (Fig. 21).

14. Sew (1) Unit 5 square, (1) Unit 6 square, (1) 1" x 2 1/2" Fabric U strip, (1) Unit 7 square and (1) Unit 8 square together in that order. Sew the resulting strip to the right side of (1) Unit 18 square from Step 13 (Fig. 21).

15. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric Q square, (1) Unit 1 square, (1) Unit 2 square, (1) 1" x 2 1/2" Fabric U strip, (1) Unit 3 square, (1) Unit 4 square and (1) 2 1/2" Fabric R square together in that order. Sew the resulting strip to the top of the Unit 18 square from Step 14.

16. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric A square, (1) Unit 12 square, (1) Unit 11 square, (1) 1" x 2 1/2" Fabric U strip, (1) Unit 10 square, (1) Unit 9 square and (1) 2 1/2" Fabric S square together in that order. Sew the resulting strip to the bottom of the Unit 18 square from Step 15 to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 21).

17. Repeat Steps 13-16 to make (4) Block One squares total.

18. Follow Figure 22 below and sew (14) assorted blocks together to make (1) Side Border. Repeat to make a second Side Border.

19. Follow Figure 23 below and sew (14) assorted blocks together. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric R square to each end of the new strip to make the Top Border. Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

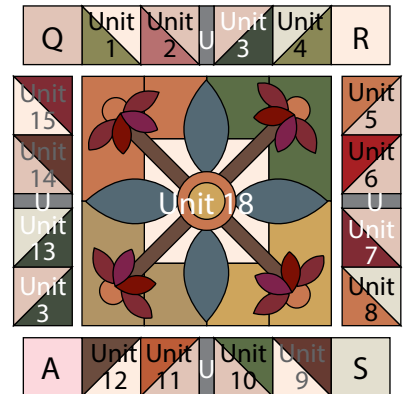

### Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

20. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) 1" x 13" Fabric U strip to make (1) Row One. Repeat to make Row Two. Pay attention to the block orientations.

21. Sew the (2) Rows from Step 20 to the top and to the bottom of (1) 1" x 26" Fabric U strip to make the Center Block.

22. Sew (1) 1" x 26" Fabric U strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1" x 27" Fabric U strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

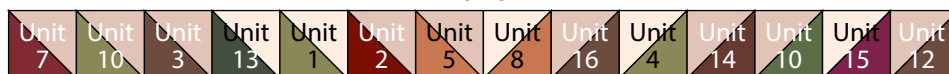

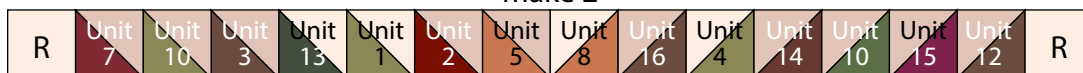

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23. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 27" Fabric A strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 28 ½" Fabric A strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

24. Sew the Side, Top and Bottom Borders to the Center Block.

25. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 32 ½" Fabric L strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 34" Fabric L strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

26. Center (1) 6" x 49" Fabric V strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a ¼" from the top edge of the block and stop a ¼" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.

27. Repeat Step 26 to sew (1) 6" x 49" Fabric V strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start ¼" away from each end of the block. To miter

each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 24).

28. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 24), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a ¼" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the quilt top

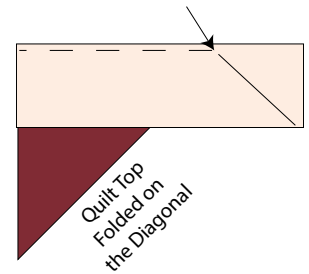
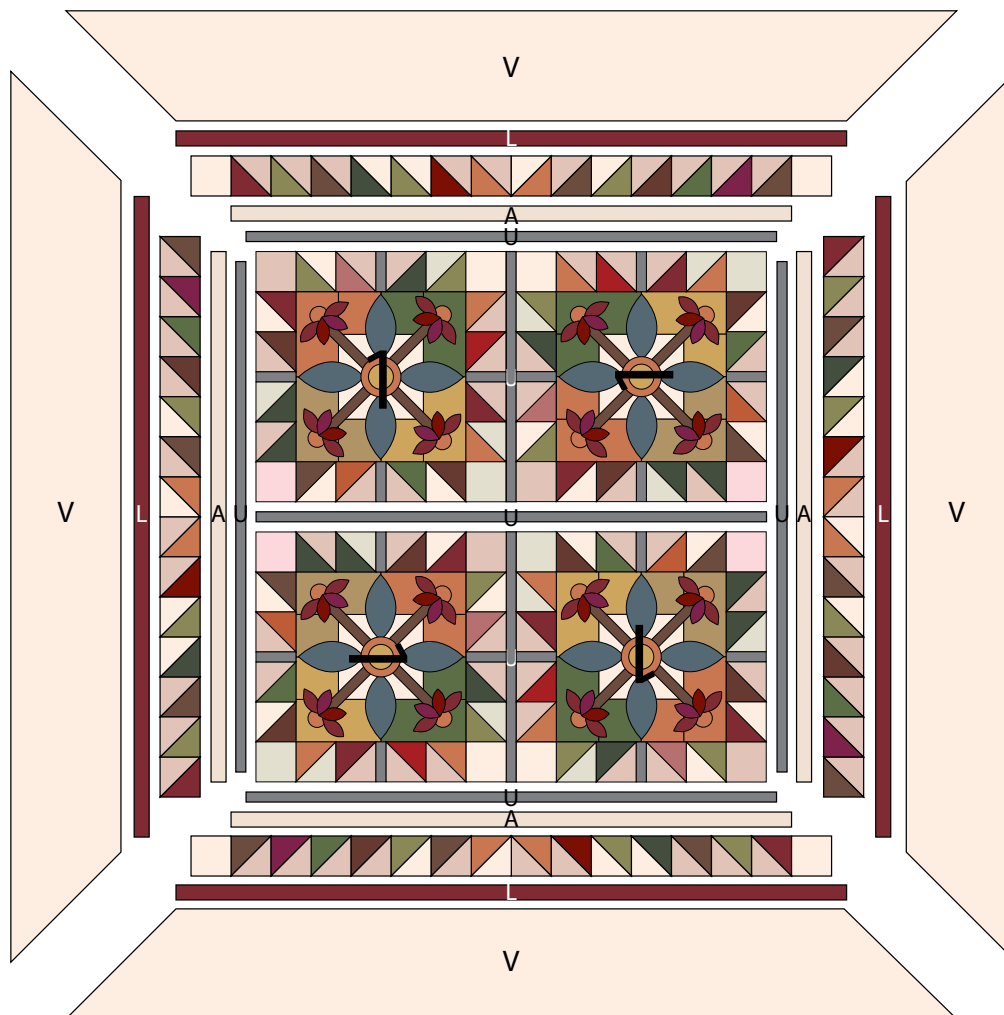

29. Layer and quilt as desired.

30. Sew the (5) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric H strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

31. Bind as desired.
