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### Materials

1 panel	Floral and Ornament Panel - Gold (A)	9523P-33
1/3 yard	Folio - Wine (B)	7755-89
3/4 yard	Holly Leaf and Berry - Cream (C)	9516-44
1 1/2 yards	Allover Ornaments - Black (D)	9520-99
1/2 yard	Folio - Forest (E)	7755-68
3/4 yard	Folio - Off White (F)	7755-04
1 1/4 yards	Plaid - Red (G)	9517-88*
1/2 yard	Damask - Gold (H)	9519-33
3/8 yard	Folio - Black (I)	7755-99
1 1/2 yards	Poinsettia Print - Cream (J)	9518-44
5 yards	Santa Collage - Red (Backing)	9522-88

\*Includes binding

### Cutting Instructions

*Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.*

#### From the Floral and Ornament Panel - Gold (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 21 1/2" x 40 1/2" rectangle, centered on the panel.

#### From the Folio - Wine (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 40 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 24 1/2" WOF strips.

#### From the Holly Leaf and Berry - Cream (C), cut:

- (2) 4" x 42 1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 5 1/2" x 30 1/2" WOF strips.

#### From the Allover Ornaments - Black (D), cut:

- (2) 4 1/2" x 52 1/2" LOF strips.

#### From the Folio - Forest (E), cut:

- (5) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 1 1/2" x 52 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x 42 1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed.

#### From the Folio - Off White (F), cut:

- (2) 7 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (9) 7 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (36) 7 1/4" triangles.
- (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 1/2" squares.

#### From the Plaid - Red (G), cut:

- (3) 6 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (14) 6 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (28) 6 7/8" triangles.
- (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Damask - Gold (H), cut:

- (2) 7 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (9) 7 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (36) 7 1/4" triangles.

#### From the Folio - Black (I), cut:

- (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 66 1/2" strips.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 56 1/2" strips.

#### From the Poinsettia Print - Cream (J), cut:

- (7) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 6 1/2" x 68 1/2" strips.

#### From the Santa Collage - Red (Backing), cut:

- (2) 88" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 76" x 88" back.

### Block Assembly

*Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.*

1. Sew (1) 2" x 40 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the 21 1/2" x 40 1/2" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x 24 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 23 1/2" x 42 1/2".**

2. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 52 1/2" Fabric E strip lengthwise to each side of (1) 4 1/2" x 52 1/2" Fabric D strip to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 2). Repeat to make a second Unit 1 strip.

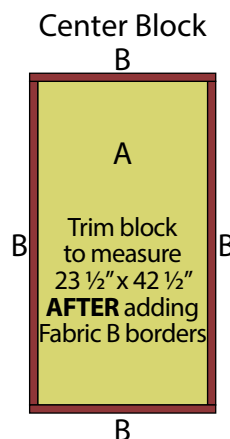

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3. Sew (1) 7 ¼" Fabric F triangle and (1) 7 ¼" Fabric H triangle together. Sew (1) 6 ⅞" Fabric G triangle to the newly sewn triangle along the long sides to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 3). The unit should measure 6 ½" square. Repeat to make (14) Unit 2 squares total.

4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Figure 4 for fabric identification, location and orientation to make (14) 6 ½" Unit 3 squares.

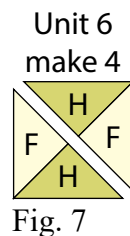


5. Sew (2) Unit 2 squares together along their Fabric G sides to make (1) Unit 4 strip (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (6) Unit 4 strips total.



6. Sew (2) Unit 3 squares together along their Fabric G sides to make (1) Unit 5 strip (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (6) Unit 5 strips total.

7. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Figure 7 for fabric identification to make (4) 6 ½" Unit 6 squares.



8. Sew together (2) Unit 4 strips, (1) Unit 6 square and (2) Unit 5 strips, in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) Side Border (Fig. 8). Repeat to make a second Side Border.

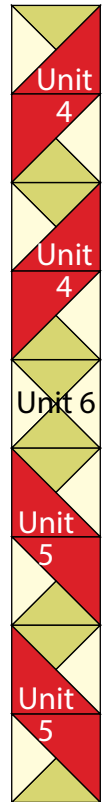

9. Sew together (1) 6 ½" Fabric F square, (1) Unit 3 square, (1) Unit 4 strip, (1) Unit 6 square, (1) Unit 5 square, (1) Unit 2 square and (1) 6 ½" Fabric F square, in that order from left to right, to make the Top Border (Fig. 9 below). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

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### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*

10. Sew (1) 4" x 42 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 30 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

11. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of the Center Block.

12. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 42 1/2" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

13. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

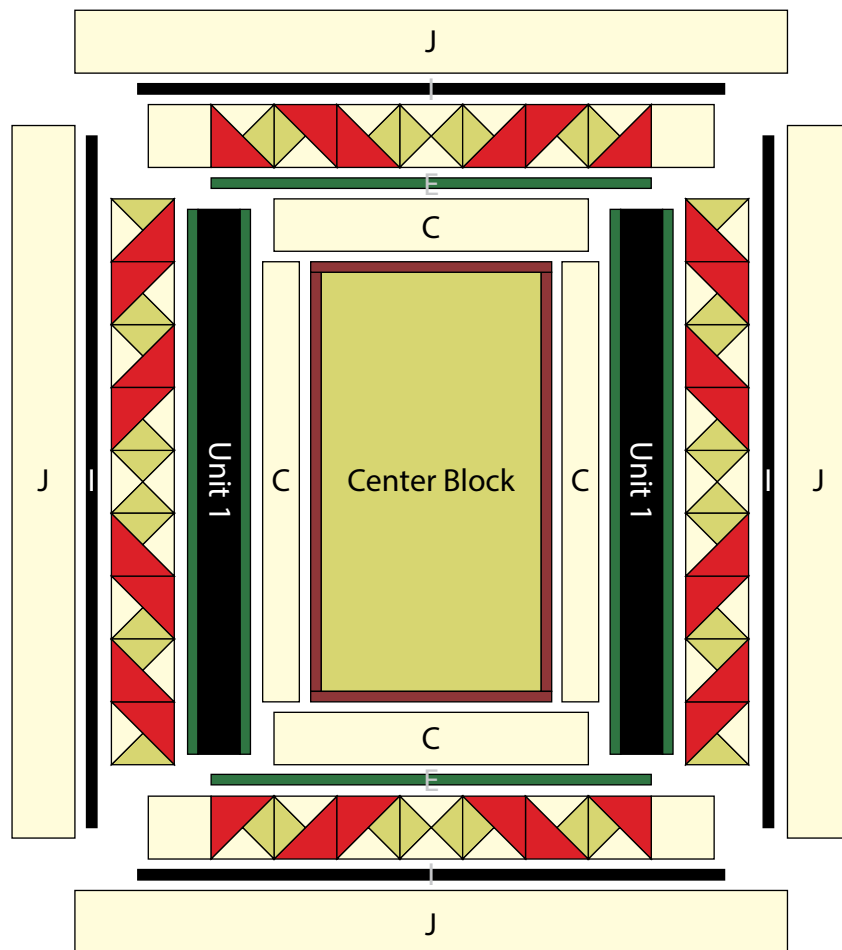
14. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 66 1/2" Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 56 1/2" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

15. Sew (1) 6 1/2" x 68 1/2" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 6 1/2" x 68 1/2" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

16. Layer and quilt as desired.

17. Sew the (8) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

18. Bind as desired.
