





¼ yard	Fossils - Gray (C)	9754-90
⅝ yard	Pterodactyl - Blue (D)	9753-11
¼ yard	Fossils - Navy (E)	9754-77
¼ yard	Foot Prints - Navy (F)	9752-77
⅔ yard	Dinosaur Tossed Allover - White (G)	9758-1
¼ yard	Dinosaur Egg - Blue (H)	9755-11
½ yard	Stegosaurus - Teal (I)	9756-76
2 ⅝ yards	Border Stripe - Blue (J)	9757-11
⅔ yard	Modern Melody Basics - Navy (K)	1063-77*
5 ¼ yards	Patchwork - Navy (Backing)	9759-77

### Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Panel - Light Teal (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 22 ½" x 42 ½" rectangle, centered on the panel.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Silver Gray (B), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x 42 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 2 ½" x 26 ½" WOF strips.
- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 70 ½" strips.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 54 ½" strips.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 2 ½" x 6" strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 ½" x 6 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 56 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 38 ½" WOF strips.

#### From the Fossils - Gray (C), cut:

- (1) 6" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6" squares.

#### From the Pterodactyl - Blue (D), cut:

- (3) 6" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 6" x 13" strips and (4) 6" x 12" strips.

#### From the Fossils - Navy (E), cut:

- (1) 6" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 6" x 16 ½" strips.

#### From the Foot Prints - Navy (F), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 ½" squares.

#### From the Dinosaur Tossed Allover - White (G), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 ½" x 8 ½" strips.
- (2) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 6 ½" x 12 ½" strips.

#### From the Dinosaur Egg - Blue (H), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 6 ½" x 10 ½" strips and (2) 6 ½" squares.

#### From the Stegosaurus - Teal (I), cut:

- (2) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 6 ½" x 14 ½" strips.

#### From the Border Stripe - Blue (J), cut:

- (2) 6 ½" x 90" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) 6 ½" x 70" LOF strips.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Navy (K), cut:

- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Patchwork - Navy (Backing), cut:

- (2) 94" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 74" x 94" back.

### Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 42 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 ½" x 42 ½" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 26 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 25 ½" x 45 ½"**.

2. Sew together (1) 6" x 13" Fabric D strip, (1) 2 ½" x 6" Fabric B strip, (1) 6" x 16 ½" Fabric E strip, (1) 2 ½" x 6" Fabric B strip and (1) 6" x 13" Fabric D strip, end to end and in that order from top to bottom to make (1) Inner Side Border (Fig. 2). Repeat to make a second Inner Side Border.





3. Sew together (1) 6" Fabric C square, (1) 6" x 12" Fabric D strip, (1) 2 1/2" x 6" Fabric B strip, (1) 6" x 12" Fabric D strip and (1) 6" Fabric C square, in that order from left to right, to make the Inner Top Border (Fig. 3). Repeat to make the Inner Bottom Border.



4. Sew together (1) 6 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric G strip, (1) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric B strip, (1) 6 1/2" x 14 1/2" Fabric I strip, (1) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric B strip, (1) 6 1/2" Fabric H square, (1) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric B strip, (1) 6 1/2" x 14 1/2" Fabric I strip, (1) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric B strip and (1) 6 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric G strip together end to end and in that order top to bottom to make (1) Outer Side Border (Fig. 4). Repeat to make a second Outer Side Border.

5. Sew together (1) 6 1/2" Fabric F square, (1) 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric G strip, (1) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric B strip, (1) 6 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric H strip, (1) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric B strip, (1) 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric G strip and (1) 6 1/2" Fabric F square, in that order from left to right, to make the Outer Top Border (Fig. 5). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.



### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*

6. Sew (1) Inner Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Inner Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
7. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 56 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 38 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
8. Sew (1) Outer Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Outer Top Border and Outer Bottom Borders to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
9. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 70 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 54 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Center (1) 6 1/2" x 90" Fabric J strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a 1/4" from the top edge of the block and stop a 1/4" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.
11. Repeat Step 10 to sew (1) 6 1/2" x 70" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start 1/4" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 6).

12. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 6), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the quilt top.




13. Layer and quilt as desired.

14. Sew the (8) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric K strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

15. Bind as desired.
