

Materials - Wall Hanging

2/3 yard	Continuous Blocks - Ecrú (A)	9665-44
1 1/8 yards	Border Stripe - Ecrú (B)	9664-44
1/4 yard	Tractor Tossed Allover - Ecrú (C)	9661-44
1 yard	Calico - Navy (D)	9660-77
7/8 yard	Bud Calico - Ecrú (E)	9659-44
7/8 yard	Polish Hen Allover - Black (F)	9658-99
2/3 yard	Calico - Red (G)	9660-88*
3 1/3 yards	Tractor Tossed Allover - Ecrú (Backing)	9661-44

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions - Wall Hanging

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Continuous Blocks - Ecrú (A), fussy cut:

- (1) 19 1/2" x 14" rectangle, centered on the large block.
- (6) 6" squares, each centered on the small blocks.
- (1) 12" x 6" rectangle, centered on the medium block.

From the Border Stripe - Ecrú (B), cut:

- (2) 6" x 38 1/2" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.

From the Tractor Tossed Allover - Ecrú (C), cut:

- (1) 6 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 6 1/2" x 14 1/2" strips.

From the Calico - Navy (D), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 1/2" x 14 1/2" strips.
- (2) 2" x 23 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 6" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 9" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 6 1/2" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 15" strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 1 1/2" x 14 1/2" strips.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 1 1/2" x 6" strips.
- (4) 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Bud Calico - Ecrú (E), cut:

- (1) 8 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips and (3) 3" x 8 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 51 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 43 1/2" strips.
- (1) 1 3/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 3/4" x 16 1/2" strips.
- (4) 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Polish Hen Allover - Black (F), cut:

- (3) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 1/2" x 54 1/2" strips.
- (3) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 1/2" x 43 1/2" strips.

From the Calico - Red (G), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 1/2" squares.
- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.


From the Tractor Tossed Allover - Ecrú (Backing), cut:

- (2) 59" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 59" x 70" back.


Block Assembly - Wall Hanging

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.


1. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 14 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of the 19 1/2" x 14 1/2" Fabric A large block. Sew (1) 2" x 23 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A large block to make (1) Unit 1 rectangle (Fig. 1). **Trim the unit to measure 22 1/2" x 16 1/2"**.




2. Sew (1) 1 3/4" x 16 1/2" Fabric E strip to each side of the Unit 1 rectangle to make (1) Block One rectangle (Fig. 2).




3. Sew (1) 2" x 6" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) 6" Fabric A small block. Sew (1) 2" x 9" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A small block to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 3). **Trim the block to measure 8 1/2" x 8 1/2"**. Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.




4. Sew (1) 2" x 6" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) 12" x 6" Fabric A medium block. Sew (1) 2" x 15" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A medium block to make (1) Block Three rectangle (Fig. 4). **Trim the block to measure 14 1/2" x 8 1/2".**




5. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 14 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) 6 1/2" x 14 1/2" Fabric C strip. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric C strip to make (1) Block Four rectangle (Fig. 5). Repeat to make a second Block Four rectangle.



6. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 6" Fabric D strip to each end of (1) 6" x 38 1/2" Fabric B strip. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric B strip to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 6). Repeat to make a second Unit 2 strip.



7. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 40 1/2" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 2 strip lengthwise to make (1) Block Five strip (Fig. 7). Repeat to make a second Block Five strip.




8. Sew together (1) Block Two square, (1) 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric E strip, (1) Block Three rectangle, (1) 5 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric E strip and (1) Block Two square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One (Fig. 8).

9. Sew (1) Block Four rectangle to each side of the Block One rectangle to make Row Three (Fig. 8).

10. Sew together (4) Block Two squares and (3) 3" x 8 1/2" Fabric E strips, lengthwise and alternating them from left to right, to make Row Five (Fig. 8).

11. Sew together Row One, (1) Block Five strip, Row Three, (1) Block Five strip and Row Five, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make the Wall Hanging Center Block (Fig. 8).



Wall Hanging Assembly

(Follow the Wall Hanging Layout in Figure 9 while assembling the top.)

12. Sew (1) 2" x 51 1/2" Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 43 1/2" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

13. Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 54 1/2" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4 1/2" Fabric G square to each end of (1) 4 1/2" x 43 1/2" Fabric F strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the Wall Hanging top.

14. Layer and quilt as desired.

15. Sew the (6) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

16. Bind as desired.



Materials - Runner

½ yard	Scenic - Green (A)	9663-66
⅝ yard	Folio Basic - Dark Olive (B)	7755-65*
⅔ yard	Calico - Red (C)	9660-88
⅝ yard	Sheep Allover - Ecu (D)	9662-44
1 ⅔ yards	Polish Hen Allover - Black (Backing)	9658-99

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions - Runner

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Scenic - Green (A), cut:

- (1) 12 ½" x 40 ½" WOF strip.

From the Folio Basic - Dark Olive (B), cut:

- (2) 1 ½" x 42 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 ½" x 12 ½" strips.
- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Calico - Red (C), cut:

- (4) 2 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (68) 2 ¼" squares.

From the Sheep Allover - Ecu (D), cut:

- (4) 4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) 4" squares.


From the Polish Hen Allover - Black (Backing), cut:

- (1) 57" x 29" WOF strip.

Block Assembly - Runner

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

17. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 40 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric A strip. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 42 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A strip to make the Runner Center Block (Fig. 10).



18. Place (1) 2 ¼" Fabric C square on the bottom left corner of (1) 4" Fabric D square, right sides together (Fig. 11). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 11). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ¼" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 12).





19. Follow Figure 13 for the seam direction to add a 2 ¼" Fabric C square to the lower right corner of the 4" Fabric D square to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 14).

20. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (32) Unit 3 squares total.





21. Repeat Step 2 and refer to Figures 15-16 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (2) Unit 4 squares and (2) Unit 5 squares.





Table Set

22. Sew together (4) Unit 3 squares. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) newly sewn strip to each side of the Runner Center Block (Fig. 17).

23. Sew (12) Unit 3 squares together. Sew (1) Unit 4 square to the left end of the newly sewn strip and (1) Unit 5 square to the right end. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the newly sewn strips to the top and to the bottom of the Runner Center Block to make the Runner top (Fig. 17).

24. Layer and quilt as desired.

25. Sew the (4) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

26. Bind as desired.



3/8 yard	Tractor Tossed Allover - Ecrú (A)	9661-44
3/8 yard	Calico - Navy (B)	9660-77
3/8 yard	Bud Calico - Ecrú (C)	9659-44
7/8 yard	Calico - Red (D)	9660-88*
1 3/8 yards	Sheep Allover - Ecrú (Backing)	9662-44

Cutting Instructions - Place Mats

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Tractor Tossed Allover - Ecrú (A), cut:

- (1) 10 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 10 1/2" squares.

From the Calico - Navy (B), cut:

- (2) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips.

From the Bud Calico - Ecrú (C), cut:

- (3) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

From the Calico - Red (D), cut:

- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2 1/2" squares.
- (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Sheep Allover - Ecrú (Backing), cut:

- (2) 22" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 16" x 22" strips.

Block Assembly - Place Mats

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

27. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 10 1/2" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Place Mat Center Block (Fig. 18). Repeat to make (4) Place Mat Center Blocks.



28. Place (1) 2 1/2" Fabric D square on the top left corner of (1) 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 19). Sew across the diagonal of the small square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 19). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 20).

29. Follow Figure 21 for the seam direction to add a 2 1/2" Fabric D square to the lower left corner of the 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric C strip to make (1) Unit 6 rectangle (Fig. 22).

30. Repeat Steps 28-29 to make (24) Unit 6 rectangles total.





31. Sew together (3) Unit 6 rectangles lengthwise. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) newly sewn strip to each side of (1) Place Mat Center Block to make (1) Place Mat top (Fig. 23). Repeat to make (4) Place Mat tops total.

Place Mat Layout make 4



32. Layer and quilt as desired.

33. Sew the (7) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Cut the strip into (4) equal lengths.

34. Bind as desired.
