1/2 yard	Folio - Spruce (B)	7755-74
3/4 yard	Folio - Grape (C)	7755-58
2/3 yard	Forest Fern - Royal (D)	3015-77
2/3 yard	Folio - Powder Blue (E)	7755-07
1/3 yard	Mushrooms - Forest (F)	3016-66
1/3 yard	Fairy Silhouettes - Royal (G)	3014-77
1 1/8 yards	Rainbow Ferns - Lilac (H)	3018-55
1 1/8 yards	Flower Meadow - Forest (I)	3013-66*
3 1/2 yards	Fairies Allover - Lilac (Backing)	3012-55

\*Includes binding

### Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Blocks - Royal (A):

- Fussy cut (12) 6 1/2" squares, each centered on a block.

#### From the Folio - Spruce (B), cut:

- (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips.
- (6) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.

#### From the Folio - Grape (C), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2" squares.
- (5) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" strips.
- (6) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" strips.

#### From the Forest Fern - Royal (D), cut:

- (6) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" strips.
- (8) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 1/2" x 11 1/2" strips.

#### From the Folio - Powder Blue (E), cut:

- (8) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (96) 2" x 3 1/4" strips.

#### From the Mushrooms - Forest (F), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2" x 3 1/4" strips.

#### From the Fairy Silhouettes - Royal (G), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2" x 3 1/4" strips.

#### From the Rainbow Ferns - Lilac (H), cut:

- (3) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 1/2" x 59 1/2" strips.
- (3) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 1/2" x 50 1/2" strips.
- (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/2" x 14 1/2" strips.
- (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (3) 1 1/2" x 44 1/2" strips.

#### From the Flower Meadow - Forest (I), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 65 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 53 1/2" strips.
- (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

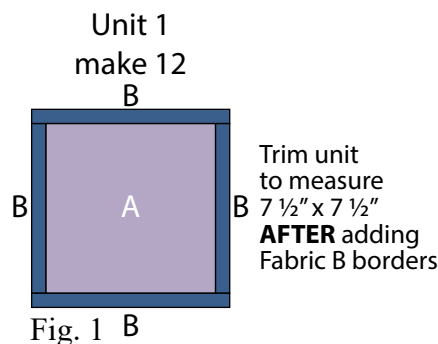
#### From the Fairies Allover - Lilac (Back), cut:

- (2) 61" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 61" x 76" back.

### Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

- Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 6 1/2" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). **Trim the unit to measure 7 1/2" x 7 1/2"**. Repeat to make (12) Unit 1 squares total.



- Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (12) Unit 2 squares total.

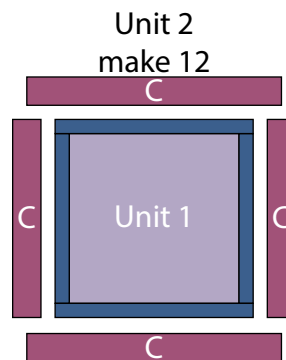

3. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 square. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $11\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 2 square to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (12) Unit 3 squares total.

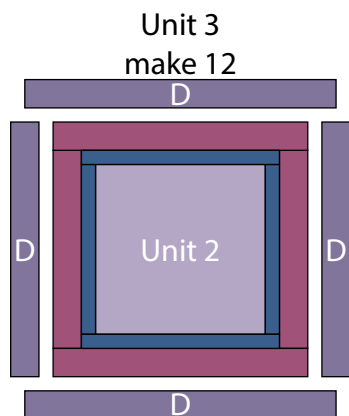

4. Sew together (1)  $2$ " x  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric E strip, (1)  $2$ " x  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric F strip, (1)  $2$ " x  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric E strip and (1)  $2$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip, end to end and in that order from left to right, to make (1)  $2$ " x  $11\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 4 strip (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (48) Unit 4 strips total.

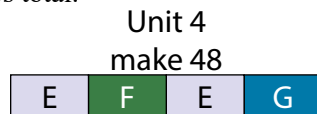

5. Sew (1)  $2$ " Fabric C square to each end of (1) Unit 4 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 4 strip to each side of (1) Unit 3 square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1)  $14\frac{1}{2}$ " Block One square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (12) Block One squares total.

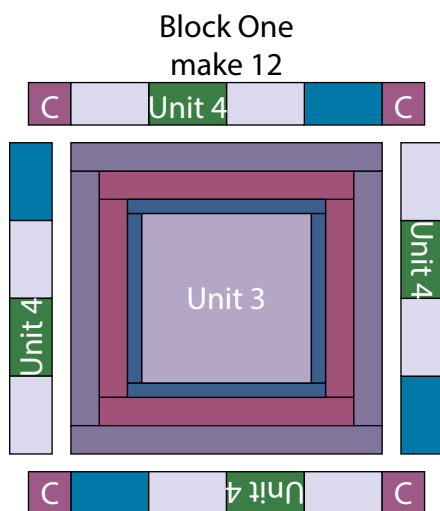

6. Sew together (3) Block One squares and (2)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $14\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strips, alternating them from left to right, to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Two, Row Three and Row Four.

7. Sew together the (4) Rows from Step 6 in numerical order and the (3)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $44\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strips, lengthwise and alternating the from top to bottom, to make the  $44\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $59\frac{1}{2}$ " Center Block (Fig. 6).

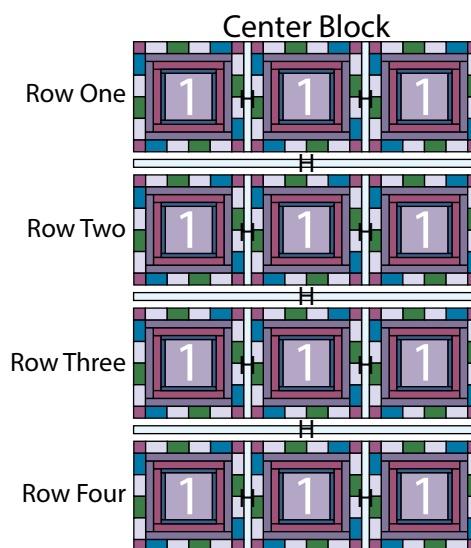

### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*

8. Sew (1)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $59\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1)  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $50\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

9. Sew (1)  $2$ " x  $65\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1)  $2$ " x  $53\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

10. Layer and quilt as desired.

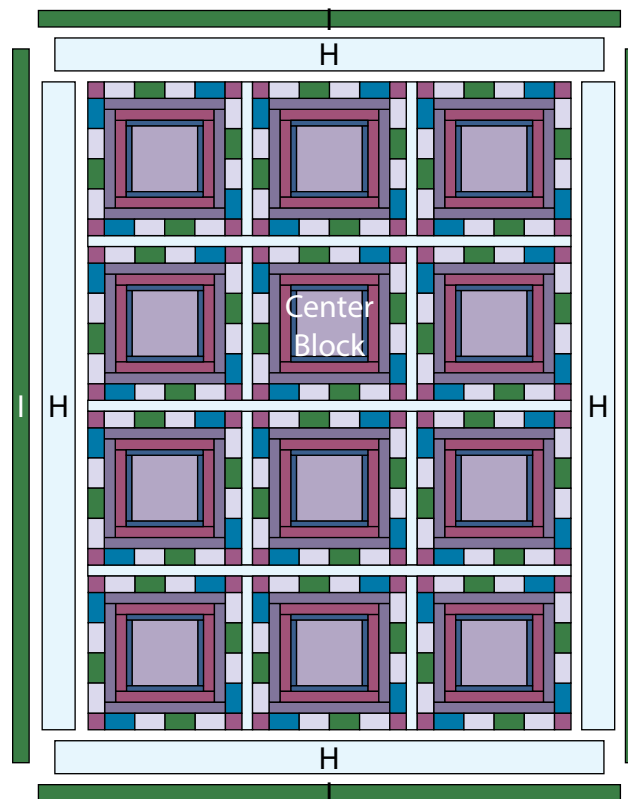
11. Sew the (7)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

12. Bind as desired.
