1/2 yard	Flower Cluster - Coral (G)	1726-30
5/8 yard	Floral Vine - Cream (H)	1728-8
1 2/3 yards	Zig Zag Dot - Brick (I)	1725-88*
2/3 yard	Star Dot - Brick (J)	1727-88
3/8 yard	Zig Zag Dot - Teal (K)	1725-77

Version #1 Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Zig Zag Dot - Green (A), cut:

- (5) 3 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (44) 3 7/8" squares.
- (2) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 3 1/2" squares.

From the Small Star Burst - Green (B), cut:

- (6) 3 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (52) 3 7/8" squares. Cut (32) of the 3 7/8" squares across one diagonal to make (64) 3 7/8" triangles.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (C), cut:

- (7) 3 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (66) 3 7/8" squares. Cut (30) of the 3 7/8" squares across one diagonal to make (60) 3 7/8" triangles.
- (3) 6 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 6 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across one diagonal to make (32) 6 7/8" triangles.
- (2) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 3 1/2" squares.

From the Geometric - Cream (D), cut:

- (3) 9 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 9 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across one diagonal to make (20) 9 7/8" triangles.

From the Small Star Burst - Gold (E), cut:

- (2) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 3 1/2" squares.

From the Leaf Berry - Cream/Brown (F), cut:

- (3) 3 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) 3 7/8" squares.

From the Flower Cluster - Coral (G), cut:

- (3) 3 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) 3 7/8" squares.

From the Floral Vine - Cream (H), cut:

- (4) 3 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) 3 7/8" squares.

From the Zig Zag Dot - Brick (I), cut:

- (4) 3 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) 3 7/8" squares.
- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 1/2" x 72 1/2" strips.
- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 1/2" x 76 1/2" strips.
- (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Star Dot - Brick (J), cut:

- (5) 3 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (44) 3 7/8" squares.

From the Zig Zag Dot - Teal (K), cut:

- (2) 3 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 3 7/8" squares.

From the Flower Cluster - Aqua (L), cut:

- (2) 3 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 3 1/2" squares.

From the Floral Vine - Light Blue (Backing), cut:

- (2) 84" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 84" x 84" back.

Version #1 Block Assembly

Pay attention to the orientations of the various components while assembling the quilt top.

1. Place (1) 3 7/8" Fabric F square on top of 3 7/8" Fabric G square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 3). Trim the units to measure 3 1/2" square. Repeat to make (40) Unit 1 squares total.







2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figures 4-7 for fabric identification and placement to make (40) Unit 2 squares, (40) Unit 3 squares, (40) Unit 4 squares and (32) Unit 5 squares.







3. Place (1) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric G square on top of $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric F square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 8). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 9). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 9) to make (2) Unit 6 squares (Fig. 10). Trim the units to measure $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make (16) Unit 6 squares total.





4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Figures 11-12 for fabric identifications and placement to make (32) Unit 7 squares, and (48) Unit 8 squares.



5. Sew (1) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric C triangle to the left side of (1) Unit 4 square. Sew (1) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric C triangle to the top of the Unit 4 square to make the top row. Sew together (1) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric C triangle, (1) Unit 4 square and (1) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric A square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows to make (1) Unit 9 triangle (Fig. 13). Repeat to make (20) Unit 9 triangles total.





7. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to the top of (1) Unit 2 square. Sew (1) Unit 3 square to the bottom of the Unit 2 square. Sew the newly sewn strip

to the left side of (1) Unit 10 square. Sew together (1) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E square, (1) Unit 1 square, (1) Unit 2 square and (1) Unit 3 square, in that order. Sew the newly sewn strip to the top of the Unit 10 square to make (1) Unit 11 Square (Fig. 15). Repeat to make (20) Unit 11 squares total.



8. Sew together (2) Unit 11 squares to make the top row. Pay attention to the unit orientations. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew the (2) rows together to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 16). Repeat to make (5) Block One squares total.



6. Sew together (1) $9 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric D triangle and (1) Unit 9 triangle along their long sides to make (1) Unit 10 square (Fig. 14). Trim the unit to measure $9 \frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make (20) Unit 10 squares total.

9. Refer to Figure 17 for fabric and component identification, placement and orientation to make (16) Unit 12 triangles.



10. Sew (1) 3 1/2" Fabric C square to the left side of (1) Unit 5 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 5 square to the left side of (1) 3 1/2" Fabric L square to make the bottom row. Sew the (2) rows together. Sew (1) 6 7/8" Fabric C triangle to the left and to the top of the sewn square to make (1) Unit 13 triangle (Fig. 18). Repeat to make (16) Unit 13 triangles total.



11. Sew together (1) Unit 12 triangle and (1) Unit 13 triangle along their long sides to make (1) Unit 14 square (Fig. 19). Trim the unit to measure 12 1/2" square. Repeat to make (16) Unit 14 squares total.



12. Sew together (2) Unit 14 squares to make the top row. Pay attention to the unit orientations. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew the (2) rows together to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 20). Repeat to make (4) Block Two squares total.



Version #1 Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow Figure 21 while assembling the quilt top.)

13. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two square to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.

14. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) Block One square to make Row Two.

15. Sew the (3) Rows together, in numerical order, to make the Center Block.

16. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 72 1/2" Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 76 1/2" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

17. Layer and quilt as desired.

18. Sew the (8) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

19. Bind as desired.



Version #2 Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Small Star Burst - Gold (A), cut:

- (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 3 ½" squares.

From the Flower Cluster - Coral (B), cut:

- (2) 3 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 3 ⅞" squares.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (C), cut:

- (7) 3 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (66) 3 ⅞" squares. Cut (30) of the 3 ⅞" squares across one diagonal to make (60) 3 ⅞" triangles.
- (3) 6 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 6 ⅞" squares. Cut the squares across one diagonal to make (32) 6 ⅞" triangles.
- (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 3 ½" squares.

From the Geometric - Light Green (D), cut:

- (3) 9 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 9 ⅞" squares. Cut the squares across one diagonal to make (20) 9 ⅞" triangles.
- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 72 ½" strips.
- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 76 ½" strips.
- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Floral Vine - Navy (E), cut:

- (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 3 ½" squares.

From the Leaf Berry - Cream/Navy (F), cut:

- (3) 3 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) 3 ⅞" squares.

From the Small Star Burst - Aqua (G), cut:

- (3) 3 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (28) 3 ⅞" squares.

From the Floral Vine - Light Blue (H), cut:

- (4) 3 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) 3 ⅞" squares.

From the Geometric - Navy (I), cut:

- (4) 3 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) 3 ⅞" squares.

From the Zig Zag Dot - Green (J), cut:

- (5) 3 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (44) 3 ⅞" squares.
- (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 3 ½" squares.

From the Star Dot - Teal (K), cut:

- (5) 3 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (44) 3 ⅞" squares.

From the Small Star Burst - Green (L), cut:

- (5) 3 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 3 ⅞" squares. Cut (32) of the 3 ⅞" squares across one diagonal to make (64) 3 ⅞" triangles.

From the Flower Cluster - Aqua (Backing), cut:

- (2) 84" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 84" x 84" back.

Version #2 Block Assembly

Pay attention to the orientations of the various components while assembling the quilt top.

20. Place (1) 3 ⅞" Fabric F square on top of 3 ⅞" Fabric G square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 22). Sew ¼" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 22). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 23) to make (2) Unit 15 squares (Fig. 24). Trim the units to measure 3 ½" square. Repeat to make (40) Unit 15 squares total.







21. Repeat Step 20 and refer to Figures 25-28 for fabric identification and placement to make (40) Unit 16 squares, (40) Unit 17 squares, (40) Unit 18 squares and (32) Unit 19 squares.



22. Place (1) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric G square on top of $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric F square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 29). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 29). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 30) to make (2) Unit 20 squares (Fig. 31). Trim the units to measure $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make (16) Unit 20 squares total.







24. Sew (1) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric C triangle to the left side of (1) Unit 18 square. Sew (1) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric C triangle to the top of the Unit 18 square to make the top row. Sew together (1) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric C triangle, (1) Unit 18 square and (1) $3 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric A square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows to make (1) Unit 23 triangle (Fig. 34). Repeat to make (20) Unit 23 triangles total.





26. Sew (1) Unit 15 square to the top of (1) Unit 16 square. Sew (1) Unit 17 square to the bottom of the Unit 16 square.

Sew the newly sewn strip to the left side of (1) Unit 24 square. Sew together (1) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E square, (1) Unit 15 square, (1) Unit 16 square and (1) Unit 17 square, in that order. Sew the newly sewn strip to the top of the Unit 24 square to make (1) Unit 25 Square (Fig. 36). Repeat to make (20) Unit 25 squares total.





25. Sew together (1) $9 \frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric D triangle and (1) Unit 23 triangle along their long sides to make (1) Unit 24 square (Fig. 35). Trim the unit to measure $9 \frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make (20) Unit 24 squares total.

28. Refer to Figure 38 for fabric and component identification, placement and orientation to make (16) Unit 26 triangles.



29. Sew (1) 3 1/2" Fabric C square to the left side of (1) Unit 19 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 19 square to the left side of (1) 3 1/2" Fabric J square to make the bottom row. Sew the (2) rows together. Sew (1) 6 7/8" Fabric C triangle to the left and to the top of the sewn square to make (1) Unit 27 triangle (Fig. 39). Repeat to make (16) Unit 27 triangles total.



30. Sew together (1) Unit 26 triangle and (1) Unit 27 triangle along their long sides to make (1) Unit 28 square (Fig. 40). Trim the unit to measure 12 1/2" square. Repeat to make (16) Unit 28 squares total.



31. Sew together (2) Unit 28 squares to make the top row. Pay attention to the unit orientations. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew the (2) rows together to make (1) Block Four square (Fig. 41). Repeat to make (4) Block Four squares total.



Version #2 Quilt Top Assembly




Fig. 42

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

(Follow Figure 42 while assembling the quilt top.)

32. Sew (1) Block Three square to each side of (1) Block Four square to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.

33. Sew (1) Block Four square to each side of (1) Block Three square to make Row Two.

34. Sew the (3) Rows together, in numerical order, to make the Center Block.

35. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 72 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 76 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

36. Layer and quilt as desired.

37. Sew the (8) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

38. Bind as desired.
