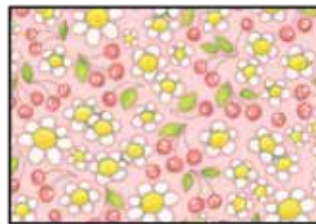

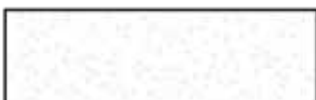


Farm Block Panel

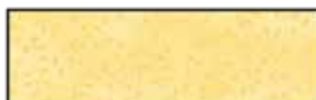

Materials

1 panel	24 Inch Panel - Multi (A)	559P-90
1 yard	Folio Basics - Butter (B)	7755-03*
1/3 yard	Bandana Allover - Green (C)	557-66
1/2 yard	Gingham Check - Gray (D)	552-90
2/3 yard	Farm Scenic - Green (E)	553-66
1 1/4 yards	Tossed Farm Animals - Blue (F)	550-11
3 1/2 yards	Bandana Allover - Blue (Backing)	557-11

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the 24 Inch Panel - Multi (A), fussy cut:

- (1) 18 1/2" x 19" rectangle, centered on a large block.
- (4) 8 1/4" squares, each centered on a small block.

From the Folio Basics - Butter (B), cut:

- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 19" strips.
- (2) 2" x 21 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 8 1/4" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 11 1/4" strips.
- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Bandana Allover - Green (C), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 20 1/2" strips.

From the Gingham Check - Gray (D), cut:

- (2) 1 3/4" x 40 1/2" WOF strips.
- (3) 1 3/4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 3/4" x 43" strips.
- (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/2" x 20 1/2" strips.

From the Farm Scenic - Green (E), cut:

- (1) 20 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 20 1/2" x 5 1/2" strips and (2) 5 1/2" x 20 1/2" strips.

From the Tossed Farm Animals - Blue (F), cut:

- (2) 5 1/2" x 43" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 5 1/2" x 53" WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Bandana Allover - Blue (Backing), cut:

- (2) 61" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 61" x 61" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 19" Fabric B strip to each side of the 18 1/2" x 19" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 21 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 20 1/2" x 20 1/2"**.

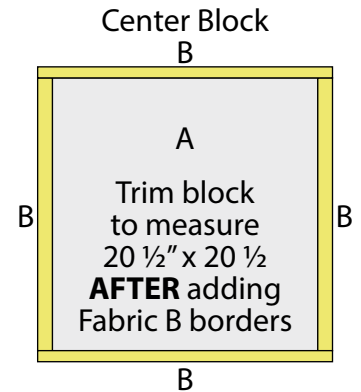

2. Sew (1) 2" x 8 1/4" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 8 1/4" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 11 1/4" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 2). **Trim the block to measure 10 1/2" x 10 1/2"**. Repeat to make (4) Block One squares total.

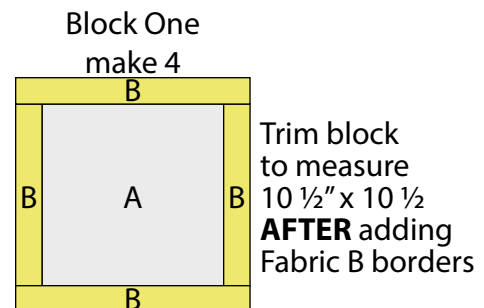

3. Sew together (1) 2" x 20 1/2" Fabric C strip, (1) 1 1/2" x 20 1/2" Fabric D strip, (1) 20 1/2" x 5 1/2" Fabric E strip, (1) 1 1/2" x 20 1/2" Fabric D strip and (1) 2" x 20 1/2" Fabric C strip, lengthwise and in that order from left to right, to make (1) 10 1/2" x 20 1/2" Block Five strip (Fig. 3). Repeat to make a second Block Two strip.

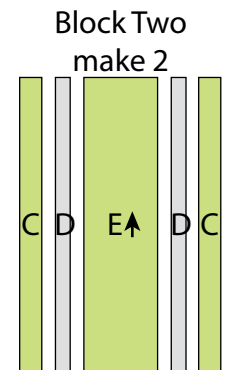

4. Sew together (1) 2" x 20 1/2" Fabric C strip, (1) 1 1/2" x 20 1/2" Fabric D strip, (1) 5 1/2" x 20 1/2" Fabric E strip, (1) 1 1/2" x 20 1/2" Fabric D strip and (1) 2" x 20 1/2" Fabric C strip, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) 10 1/2" x 20 1/2" Block Three strip (Fig. 4). Repeat to make a second Block Three strip.

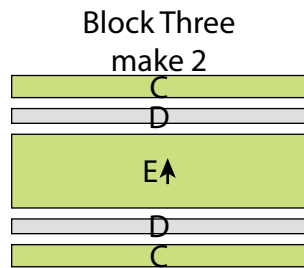

5. Sew (1) Block One square to each end of (1) Block Three strip to make the Top Border (Fig. 5). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

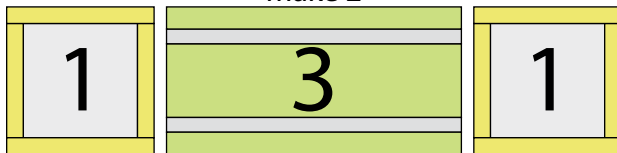

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

6. Sew (1) Block Two strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

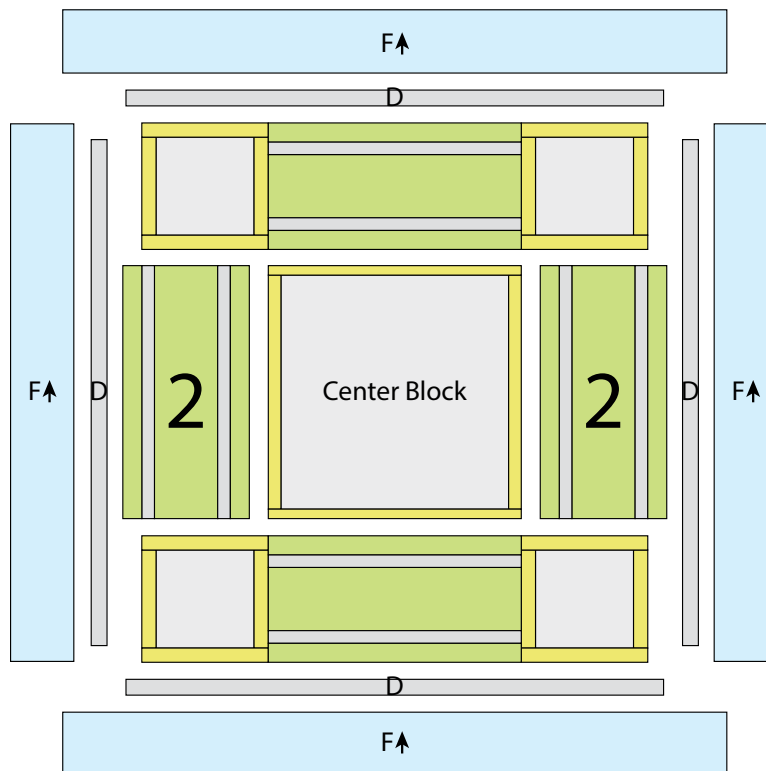
7. Sew (1) 1 3/4" x 40 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 3/4" x 43" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

8. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 43" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 53" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

9. Layer and quilt as desired.

10. Sew the (6) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

11. Bind as desired.
