$\frac{3}{8}$ yard	Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (B)	1063-01W
$\frac{1}{2}$ yard	Tossed Dreidels - Royal (C)	9572-77
$1\frac{3}{8}$ yards	Star of David - Navy (D)	9574-77*
$\frac{7}{8}$ yard	Gelt - Gold (E)	9573-44
3 yards	Tossed Dreidels - Royal (Backing)	9572-77

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Menorah Panel - Navy (A):

- Fussy cut (1) $22\frac{1}{2}$ " x $41\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (B), cut:

- (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $25\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x $41\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.

From the Tossed Dreidels - Royal (C), cut:

- (3) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $44\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Star of David - Navy (D), cut:

- (3) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $44\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $36\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (96) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
- (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Gelt - Gold (E), cut:

- (6) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (46) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Tossed Dreidels - Royal (Backing), cut:

- (2) 52" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 52" x 64" back.

Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) 2 " x $41\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the $22\frac{1}{2}$ " x $41\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A panel. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $25\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure $24\frac{1}{2}$ " x $44\frac{1}{2}$ ".

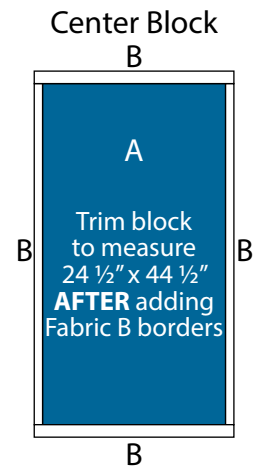

2. Place (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square on the top left corner of (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E square, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 3). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn seam.

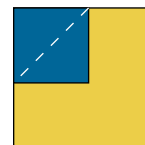

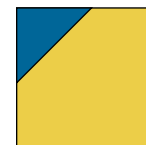

3. Follow Figure 4 for the seam direction to add a $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square to the lower left corner and to the upper right corner of the $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 5).

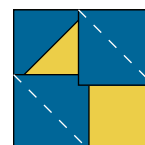

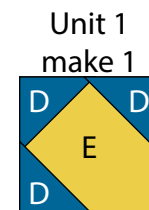

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4. Repeat Steps 2-3 and refer to Figures 6-12 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (1) Unit 2 square, (1) Unit 3 square, (1) Unit 4 square, (12) Unit 5 squares, (12) Unit 6 squares, (9) Unit 7 squares and (9) Unit 8 squares.

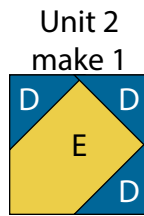

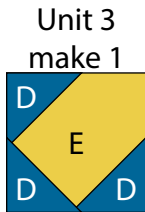

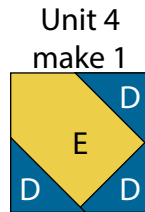

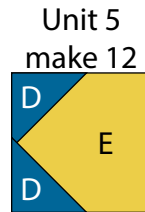

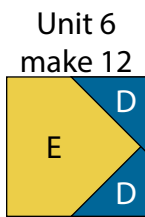

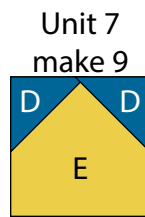

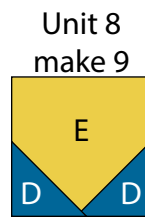

5. Sew together (12) Unit 5 squares to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 13).

6. Sew together (12) Unit 6 squares to make the Right Side Border (Fig. 14).

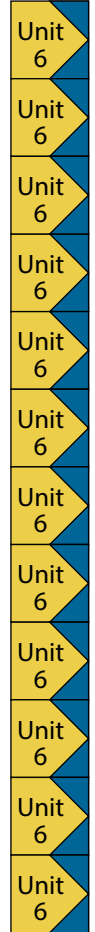

7. Sew (9) Unit 7 squares together. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to the left end of the newly sewn strip and (1) Unit 2 square to the right end to make the Top Border (Fig. 15 below).

8. Sew (9) Unit 8 squares together. Sew (1) Unit 3 square to the left end of the newly sewn strip and (1) Unit 4 square to the right end to make the Bottom Border (Fig. 16 below).

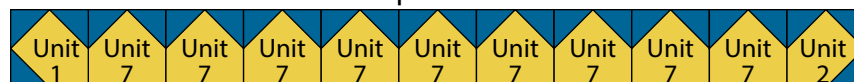

Bottom Border

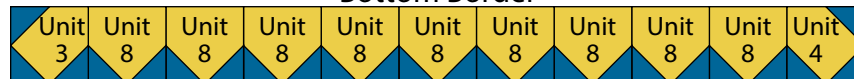

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Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

9. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block.

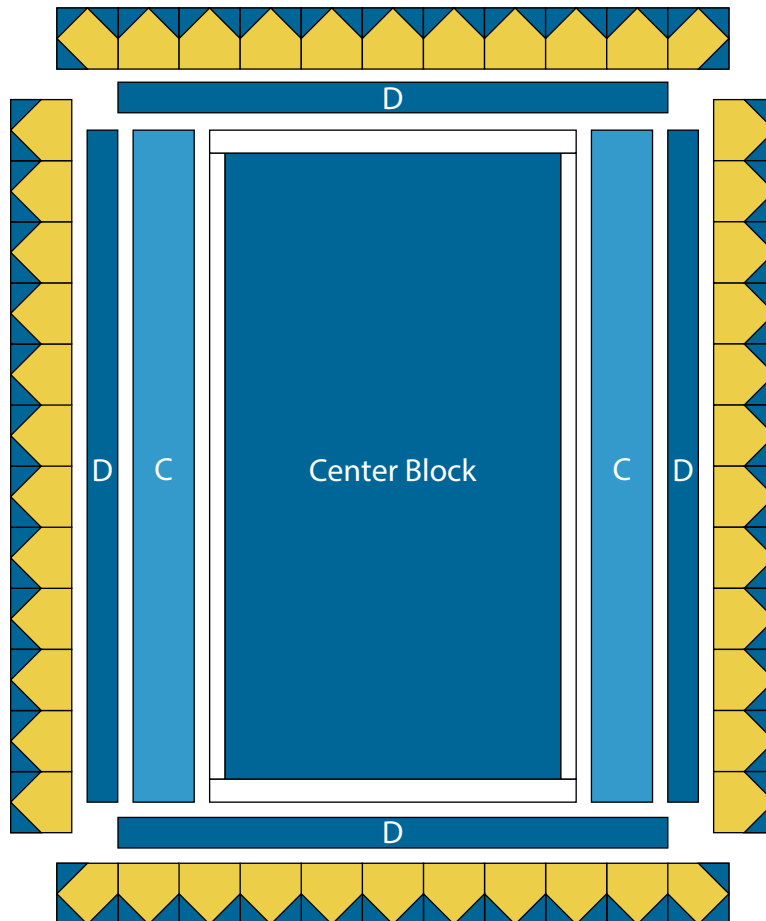
10. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 44 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 36 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

11. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

12. Layer and quilt as desired.

13. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

14. Bind as desired.
