$11 / 4$ yards Folio - Black (B)
$3 / 4$ yard Plaid - Red (C)
$2 / 3$ yard Glass Ornaments - Cream (D)
1 panel Blocks - Red (E)
$5 / 8$ yard Pup Scenic - Cream (F) 7193-44
$1 / 2$ yard Pup Treats - Black (G) 7196-99
$1 / 2$ yard Pine Texture - Green $(\mathrm{H}) \quad$ 7197-66
$13 / 4$ yards Border Strip - Black (I) 7192-99
$41 / 2$ yards Stack of Puppies - Cream (Backing)
7194-44

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Banner Panel - Red (A):

- Fussy cut (1) $21 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 41$ " WOF panel.

From the Folio - Black (B), cut:
-(6) $13 / 4$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) $13 / 4$ " $\times 551 / 2 "$ strips.

- (4) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 241 / 2$ WOF strips.
- (4) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (7) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Plaid - Red (C), cut:

- (2) 3 " $\times 251 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (2) $21 / 2 " \times 41 "$ WOF strips.
- (3) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 2 "$ x $10 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strips.
- (4) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $1 \frac{1}{2} "$ x $11 "$ strips.

From the Glass Ornaments - Cream (D), cut:

- (1) 8 " $x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $8 "$ squares.
- (2) $4 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $4 " \times 101 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Blocks - Red (E):

- Fussy cut (6) 9" x 10 ½" panel blocks.


## From the Pup Scenic - Cream (F), fussy cut:

-(6) $4 " \times 6 \frac{1}{2} "$ strips, each centered on a scene.
From the Pup Treats - Black (G), cut:

- (2) $41 / 4 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $41 / 4 "$ squares.
- (1) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $31 / 2 " x 4 "$ strips.


## From the Pine Texture - Green ( H ), cut:

- (3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 551 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $2 " \times 521 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Border Strips - Black (I), cut:

- (2) 8 " $\times 581 / 2 "$ Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) $8^{\prime \prime} \times 521 / 2 "$ LOF strips.

From the Stack of Puppies - Cream (Backing), cut:
-(2) $81 "$ x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $75 " \times 81 "$ back.

## Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " x 41 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of the $21 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x $41 "$ Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 3 " $\times 251 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure $241 / 2 " \times 441 / 2 "$ to make (1) Unit 1 rectangle (Fig. 1).

The arrows in Figure 2, 3 and the Quilt Layout denote fabric print direction. Pay attention to the orientation of the fabrics and units.
2. Sew together (3) $6 \frac{1}{2} / 2^{\prime} \times 4 "$ Fabric F strips and (2) $31 / 2 " \times 4 "$ Fabric G strips, alternating them. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 241 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the new strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 2). Repeat to make a second Unit 2 strip.
3. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 3).

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## Quilt 1

4. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric $C$ strip to each side of (1) $9 " \times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 11 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E strip. Trim the block to measure $101 / 2 " \times 111 / 2 "$ to make (1) Unit 3 rectangle (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (6) Unit 3 rectangles total.

5. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the (1) 4 " $\times 101 / 2$ " Fabric D strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 4 strip (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (8) Unit 4 strips total.

6. Sew (4) Unit 4 strips and (3) Unit 3 rectangles together, alternating them, to make (1) Block Two rectangle (Fig. 6). Repeat to make a second Block Two rectangle.

7. Place (1) $41 / 4 "$ Fabric G square on the top left corner of (1) 8" Fabric D square, right sides together (Fig. 7). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 7). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 8). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn seam.

8. Follow Figure 9 for the seam direction to add a $41 / 4 "$

Fabric G square to each of the remaining corners of the 8 "
Fabric D square to make (1) Block Three square (Fig. 10).

Quilt Top Assembly
(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
10. Sew (1) $13 / 4$ " $\times 551 / 2$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) Block Two rectangle to each side of the Center Block.
12. Sew (1) $13 / 4 " \times 55^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block.
13. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 551 / 2$ " Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $521 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

## Pay attention to the fabric direction when adding the Fabric I borders.

14. Sew (1) 8 " $\times 58^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) Block Three square to each end of (1) 8 " $\times 521 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
15. Layer and quilt as desired.
16. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
17. Bind as desired.

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
