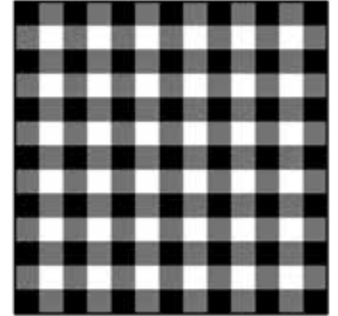

### Materials

$\frac{1}{3}$ yard	Snowflake - Multi (C)	F9268-89
$\frac{7}{8}$ yard	Snowflake - Red (D)	F9268-88
1 $\frac{1}{8}$ yards	Tossed Gnomes - Black (E)	F9273-99
$\frac{3}{8}$ yard	Stacked Gnomes - Multi (F)	F9271-89
1 $\frac{1}{8}$ yards	Bias Plaid - Multi (G)	F9276-89*
1 $\frac{2}{3}$ yards	Gnomes and Woodland Animals - Multi (H)	F9266-89
4 $\frac{1}{4}$ yards	Snowflake - Multi (Backing)	F9268-89

### Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Gnome Panel - Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 20  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 24  $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, centered on the panel.

#### From the Buffalo Check - Red/Black (B), cut:

- (4) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 24  $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.

#### From the Snowflake - Multi (C), cut:

- (2) 2" x 27  $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 26  $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.

#### From the Snowflake - Red (D), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 55  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 54  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 2" x 27  $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 23  $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 10  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

#### From the Tossed Gnomes - Black (E), cut:

- (2) 9" x 27  $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (2) 9" x 23  $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.

#### From the Stacked Gnomes - Multi (F), cut:

- (1) 10  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 10  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

#### From the Bias Plaid - Multi (G), cut:

- (3) 3" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3" x 50  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (3) 3" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3" x 51  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (7) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Gnomes and Woodland Animals - Multi (H), cut:

- (2) 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 58  $\frac{1}{2}$ " LOF strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 66  $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips, piece as needed.

#### From the Snowflake - Multi (Backing), cut:

- (2) 74" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 74" x 78" back.

### Block Assembly

*Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.*

1. Sew (1) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 24  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the 20  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 24  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 24  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 23  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 27  $\frac{1}{2}$ "**

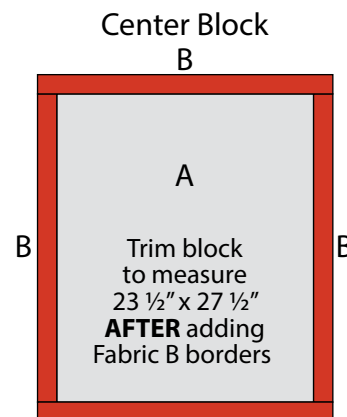

2. Sew (1) 2" x 27  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the right side of (1) 9" x 27  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip. Sew (1) 2" x 10  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the newly sewn strip to make (1) Side Border (Fig. 2). Repeat to make a second Side Border.

#### Side Border make 2

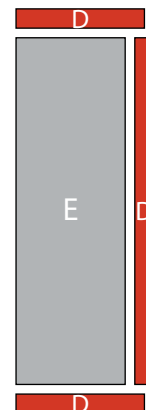

3. Sew (1) 2" x 23  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the bottom of (1) 9" x 23  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip. Sew (1) 2" x 10  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of the newly sewn strip. Sew (1) 10  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Top Border (Fig. 3).

#### Top Border

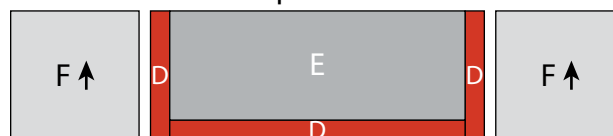

4. Sew (1) 2" x 23 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top of (1) 9" x 23 1/2" Fabric E strip. Sew (1) 2" x 10 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of the newly sewn strip. Sew (1) 10 1/2" Fabric F square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Bottom Border (Fig. 4).

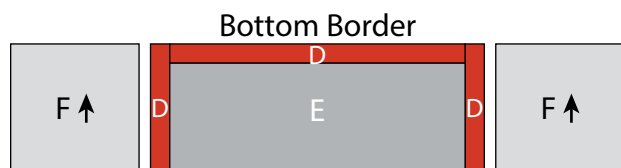

### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*

5. Sew (1) 2" x 27 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 26 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

6. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

7. Sew (1) 3" x 50 1/2" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3" x 51 1/2" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

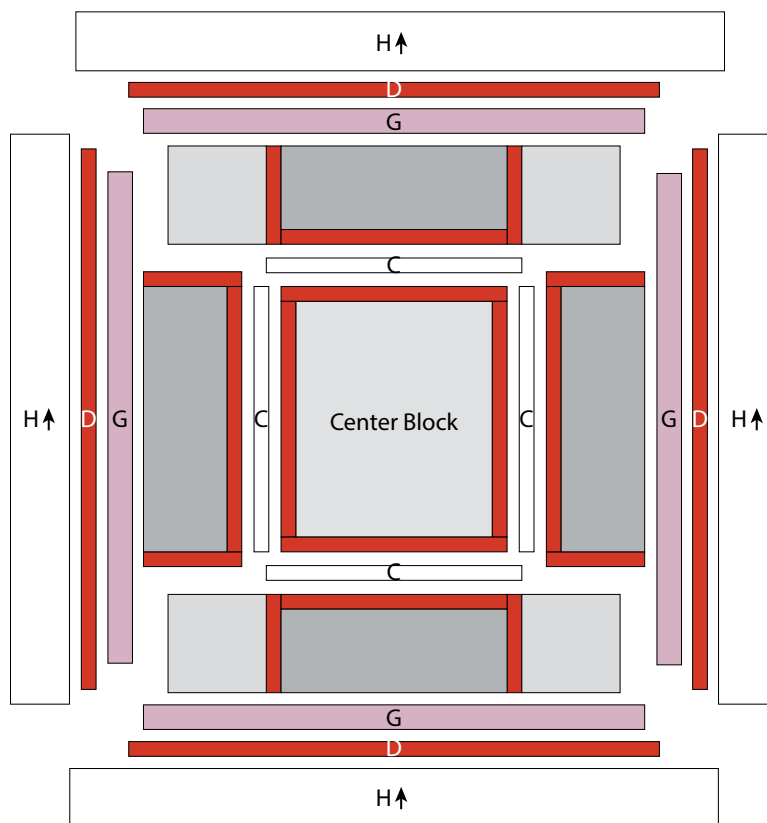
8. Sew (1) 2" x 55 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 54 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

9. Sew (1) 6 1/2" x 58 1/2" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 6 1/2" x 66 1/2" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

10. Layer and quilt as desired.

11. Sew the (7) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

12. Bind as desired.
