# FLOWER MARKET <br> <br> Place Mats 

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## Materials (makes 4)

$2 / 3$ yard 13 In x 9 In Blocks - White Multi (A) 645-09
$1 / 3$ yard Tossed Flowers - Black Multi (B) 637-98
$5 / 8$ yard Folio - Red Hot (C) 7755-81*
$1 / 3$ yard Small Flower Packed - Black Multi (D) 640-89
1 yard Small Bicycles in a Row - White Multi (Backing) 643-09
*Includes binding

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

## From the 13 In x 9 In Blocks - White Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (4) $131 / 2 " \times 93 / 4$ " rectangles, each centered on a block.

From the Tossed Flowers - Black Multi (B), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $21 / 2 " \times 93 / 4 "$ strips.
- (2) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) $21 / 2 " \times 171 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Small Foulard - Red (C), cut:

- (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

From the Small Flower Packed - Black Multi (D), cut:

- (1) $10 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $93 / 4 " \times 21 / 2 "$ strips.
- From the remaining fabric cut (4) $21 / 2 " \times 171 / 2 "$ WOF strip.


## From the Small Bicycles in a Row - White Multi (Backing), cut:

- (2) 17 " $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 17 " $\times 21$ " rectangles for the backings.


## Place Mat Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 93 / 4 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $131 / 2 " \times 93 / 4 "$ Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) $2^{1 / 2 "} \times 17^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the botto $m$ of the Fabric A rectangle to make (1) Place Mat \#1 top (Fig. 1). The top should measure $17 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 133 / 4 "$. Repeat to make a second Place Mat \#1 top.

2. Sew (1) $93 / 4 " \times 21 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to each side of (1) $13^{1 / 2 "} \times 93 / 4 "$ Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 171 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make (1) Place Mat \#2 top (Fig. 2). The top should measure $171 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 133 / 4 "$. Repeat to make a second Place Mat \#2 top.

3. Layer and quilt as desired.
4. Sew the (7) $21 / 2$ " $x$ WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Cut the strip into (4) equal pieces.
5. Bind as desired.
